LEAKY CONDITIONS POSTPONE LAKELAND AND FLORIDA ON MONDAY: For the third time on a Monday this season, the Fire Frogs were postponed to play a Tuesday double header. Seemingly unending rain began to fall at Publix Field at Joker Marchant Stadium right before the regularly scheduled start time of 6:30 p.m. The game was called at 7:20 as rain continued to fall. The Fire Frogs and Flying Tigers will try to play their second double dip of the season in Lakeland today.

FORT MYERS HOLDS OFF FLORIDA BEFORE FIERCE RAIN, 3-2: RHP Nolan Kingham pitched at a high-level once again on Sunday afternoon, but rain halted a Fire Frogs charge as the Fort Myers Miracle edged Florida, 3-2, in eight innings at Osceola County Stadium to sweep the three-game series. Kingham (4-8) went the distance for the 4th time this season, yielding seven hits and two earned runs across eight innings of work while being saddled with the loss. Brett Langhorne went 2-3 at the plate with an RBI single in the 5th, notching his ninth multi-hit effort of the season and bringing Florida to within a run at 2-1 in the 5th. Ryan Jeffers delivered the winning run the eighth, following up a Jacob Pearson double with a base hit to push the Miracle lead to 3-1. Kevin Josephina got one back for the Fire Frogs to make it 3-2 in the bottom of the frame with steady rain falling, but then a downpour halted the game for good after eight innings.

PHILIP PUNCHES HIS WAY TO POW: The Florida State League announced that LHP Philip Pfeifer was crowned the Pitcher of the Week from the period of July 15-July 21. Philip set the franchise pitcher record and single-game team record for the Brevard County Manatees/Florida Fire Frogs franchise (post-2004) with 17 strikeouts in Florida's victory at Palm Beach last Thursday (7/18). Pfeifer permitted just three hits over eight innings, not surrendering a walk and throwing just 94 pitches to achieve the milestone. He becomes the third Fire Frogs pitcher this season, joining RHP Jassee De La Cruz and RHP Nolan Kingham, to win the award.

DELGADO DIGGING OUT OF SLUMP: All-Star Riley Delgado has been struggling through the month of July. He has gotten on in 73 of the 92 games he has logged a plate appearance and has hits in 64 of those games. He has separate 9-game (4/12-4/22) and 10-game (4/27-5/7) on-base streaks and had a season-best 17-game streak that ended June 11. He holds the second longest away hitting streak in the FSL, recording at least a knock in 15 straight road contests dating back to May 23 at Dunedin and ending June 29 at Tampa: .325 AVG, 15 RBI, 7 2B, 3B, 10 R, 6 BB, 9 K, .358 OBP. Delly still paces the circuit with 104 hits and is third in the Braves organization behind Rafael Ortega's 108 (Gwinnett) and Drew Waters' 127 (Mississippi). Delgado is hitting just .176 (12-68) in his first 17 July ballgames.

LEFT ON A LONELY ISLAND: The Fire Frogs stranded a season-high 17 men last Tuesday, including leaving a runner on in each inning and leaving the sacks loaded twice in their 11-7 loss to the Cardinals. The most Fire Frogs left on base previously was 14 in game one of a double header in Kissimmee against St. Lucie on May 15. The Fire Frogs hit a respectable .382 (13x34) with runners in scoring position over their next three contests, but have gone 4x23 (.174) over the past four games. For the first time this season the Fire Frogs didn't have an at-bat with men in scoring position in Saturday's shutout loss to the Miracle. Over their previous nine contests (dating back to 7/4), Florida was 7x56 (.125) with men in scoring position.

FINALLY FLYING WITH TIGERS: This encounter between the Flying Tigers and Fire Frogs is their first matchup since the first half, when these teams completed a four-game series over three days in Lakeland. The season series was originally supposed to comprise of 7 games at Osceola County Stadium and 6 at Publix Field. Due to a May 2 rainout in Kissimmee, that game was made up on May 6 in Lakeland as part of a twin bill. The Fire Frogs and Flying Tigers are meeting for the first of 7 times in the second half. Florida is 7-8 as the Fire Frogs in games played at Publix Field at Joker Marchant Stadium.

OPPOSING PITCHERS: RHP Tom de Blok, who was initially supposed to start yesterday, was pushed back to Wednesday night. RHP Spenser Watkins receives the ball for the Flying Tigers in game one, coming off of a near-no performance last Thursday with AA-Erie. LHP Jared Tobey makes his first start of the year and third appearance with Lakeland, having received the call-up from West Michigan on July 12. He's thrown 2.2 scoreless frames to begin his tenure.

Also hit for a .393 average with 11 doubles and 2 homers. His slot value was \$709,000, he signed to play with the Braves instead of attending D-II University of Tampa. Injured 6/3 in start at Fort Myers, missed a month, sent to GCL to make 3 rehab starts (7/2, 7/5, 7/10): 0-1, 3.38 ERA, 3 H, 2 HB, 1 BB, 9 K, went from 8 to 18 to 30 pitches.

Tonight's Start: 15th Advanced-A appearance in 2019, 13th start. This will be his 35th career Advanced-A game and 13th start at this level. He has pitched in 136 prior MiLB games and has started 15 games in his career. Pfeifer is making his second career start against Lakeland (5/8 at Publix Field): L (first decision with FLO), 5 IP, 4 H, 2 ER, 2 HR, 0 BB, 6 K. This was his second appearance with the Fire Frogs.

Last Start: Set franchise-record strikeout total on Thursday (7/18) at Palm Beach: W (second win as starter this season, has won two starts in a row), 8 IP, 27 BF, 3 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 17 K, WP, PC: 94/73. Has permitted just 2 ER over his previous 29.2 innings (0.61 ERA), dating back to the 2nd inning of his start against Palm Beach on June 25 at the Pond. He enters tonight's start 5th in the FSL in Ks with 94.

Notes: Pfeifer earned his first-ever Pitcher of the Week nomination for the period of July 15-21, tossing eight shutout innings of three-hit baseball with a franchise-record 17 strikeouts to earn the first weekly award of his career. His last start before this season came on April 25th, 2018 at Rochester while with Gwinnett: IP, 2 H, 2 ER, 2 HB, BB, 0 K, PC: 36/20 strikes. He permitted a run in six of his seven outings with Mississippi this season before being sent down on April 29th. This is the first time while with the Braves system that he's pitching for Florida and the first time he's been at Advanced-A since 2016, when he pitched in a combined 20 games between Rancho Cucamonga (Dodgers) and the Carolina Mudcats. Acquired from the Dodgers with RHP Caleb Dirks for RHP Bud Norris, OF Dian Toscano, PTBNL (RHP Alex Grosser), and cash on June 30, 2016. Drafted in the 3rd Round (101st overall) by the Dodgers back in 2015. Also was drafted in the 44th Round back in 2011 out of Farragut HS in Knoxville, TN.
