THURSDAY: A game that featured the highest drama levels the Fire Frogs have been a part of in 2019, St. Lucie yanked a victory out by a 10-9 final score thanks to a two-out, two-run home-run hit by Carlos Cortes in the bottom of the 9th. Both teams blew multi-run leads in the ballgame, with the Mets losing an early 3-0 lead and the Fire Frogs losing 7-4 and 9-7 advantages. It was the first walk-off loss Florida has accepted this year and the team fell to 6-1 when leading after eight innings in a game. It was just the 5th loss in franchise history when the Fire Frogs have scored 8-10 runs (16-5) or have collected 13-or-more hits (19-5).

Greyson Jenista hit his first homer since July of last year and first at Advanced-A, a two-run shot in the fourth. Riley Unroe's solo long ball in the eighth gave the Fire Frogs the lead again. Nolan Kingham worked around ten hits in 5.2 innings of four-run ball. He has a pickoff in both of his starts this season. Six players had multi-hit efforts, Contreras and Unroe had three knocks a piece as part of Florida's best output of the season in that category.

HITTING CHANGE: It was announced before the game on April 22nd at Clearwater that Danny Santiesteban, who was originally expected to be with Danville in 2019, has been moved up to Florida to become the team's hitting coach. This is Danny's second season in the organization, having been in the same role with the DSL Braves last year.

Danny was drafted by the Mariners (42nd, 2003) and the Twins (39th, 2004) organizations, playing four seasons in affiliated ball and three in independent leagues. He played 93 games for the Fort Myers Miracle back in 2008.

Former hitting coach, Doug DeVore, and the Florida Fire Frogs parted ways just two days prior after the doubleheader vs. Daytona finished up.
