TUESDAY: The Fire Frogs were shutout for the fifth time this season and the first time since May 6th at Lakeland in a 3-0 setback to the Tampa Tarpons. Florida outhit Tampa, 6-4, suffering just their 3rd setback in 17 games this season when having more knocks than the opposition (14-3). William Contreras notched another multi-hit effort with two singles. The bullpen was dynamic for the Fire Frogs, shutting out the Tarpons over 5.1 frames. RHP Bradley Roney was great in his first appearance of the season, tossing two scoreless frames.

RHP Miguel Yajure kept the Fire Frogs off balance all night, scattering six hits and a walk but striking out eight and not allowing a run. It was the first time in his career that he pitched longer than 6 innings.

CONTRERAS CUTTING: The Braves #9 prospect became the 3rd Fire Frog to record a hitting streak of at least 7 games this season yesterday, joining Jefrey Ramos (7) and Riley Unroe (10). He bumped that hit streak to eight with a two-hit performance yesterday. He has hit .303 with 7 RBIs over this stretch. He has at least one RBI in each of his last five games before not recording one last evening.

DELGADO DIGS IN: The efficiency in which Riley Delgado has reached base this year is startling. He has gotten on in 36 of the 42 games he has logged a plate appearance and he has hits in 31 of those contests. He has seperate 9-game (4/12-4/22) and 10-game (4/27-5/7) on-base streaks to his credit. He had his 14th multi-hit game on Sunday. He has 49 hits this season which is tied for 3rd in the circuit.

THE SERIES: Third game of a seven-game road trip for the Fire Frogs with games in Tampa (3) and Dunedin (4). Tampa took 2-of-3 in Kissimmee, winning one-run six-inning contests on consecutive days to take the series. The Fire Frogs are 1-12 over the past two seasons at Steinbrenner Field with their only win coming on May 10th last year.

PITCHING IMPROVEMENT: The Fire Frogs team ERA has been trending down since it got up to almost 5 at the end of April. Heading into the series opener in Tampa, the Fire Frogs had their team ERA below 4 for the first time since April 13th in the middle of the St. Lucie series when it was 3.73. Even with the 9-2 loss on Monday, only six runs were earned so the Fire Frogs ERA stayed under 4.

TODAY'S STARTER: LHP Philip Pfeifer will be making the 6th start of his career tonight. His last start before this season came on April 25th, 2018 at Rochester while with Gwinnett: IP, 2 H, 2 ER, 2 HB, BB, 0 K, PC: 36/20 strikes. He permitted a run in six of his seven outings with Mississippi this season before being sent down on April 29th. This is the first time while with the Braves system that he's pitching for the Fire Frogs and the first time he's been at the Advanced-A level since 2016, when he pitched in a combined 20 games between Rancho Cucamonga (Dodgers) and the Carolina Mudcats. Acquired from the Dodgers with RHP Caleb Dirks for RHP Bud Norris, OF Dian Toscano, PTBNL (RHP Alex Grosser), and cash on June 30, 2016. Drafted in the 3rd Round (101st overall) by the Dodgers back in 2015. Also was drafted in the 44th Round back in 2011 out of Farragut HS in Knoxville, TN
