Game \#63 - Away Game \#33 (11-21)


SATURDAY: The Tarpons used three-run home runs from Oswaldo Cabrera and Tyler Hill to top the Fire Frogs, 7-3. The Fire Frogs got on the board courtesy of a Riley Delgado single and a throwing error from Angel Aguilar that brought in the first run. Trailing 3-1 in the 4th after Cabrera's bomb, Brett Langhorne laced a clutch two-out two-run single to center to tie the game. A four-run fourth for Tampa put the game away. RHP Matt Hartman had just two mistakes in his first ever Advanced-A start, giving up seven runs on six hits. RHP Jio Orozco earned his first Advanced-A win for the Tarpons. Drew Lugbauer had two hits. Trey Harris and Zack Soria reached three times each for the Frogs

DELGADO DIGS IN: The efficiency in which Riley Delgado has reached base this year is startling. He has gotten on in 52 of the 59 games he has logged a plate appearance and he has hits in 45 of those contests. He has seperate 9-game (4/12-4/22) and 10 -game (4/27-5/7) on-base streaks to his credit and is currently on a season-best 16 game streak, which is tied for second in the league with Trevor Larnach's from Fort Myers. Delgado's .302 average is 5 th in the FSL and he has three more hits (71) than anyone else in the league. Larnach is second with 68.

ROAD WEARY: The Fire Frogs began a seven-game road trip on Monday with a four-game series in Fort Myers followed by a weekend three-game set in Tampa. Florida has struggled on the road this year with a 11-21 mark. The Fire Frogs won back-to-back road games on Tuesday and Wednesday for the third time this season (4/4-4/5 at Daytona, $5 / 9-5 / 10$ at Jupiter). But with Florida dropping the set finale to Fort Myers on Thursday and yesterday's middle game to Tampa, they are 1-7-1 in 2019 road series. Tampa took 2-of-3 in Kissimmee, winning one-run six-inning contests on consecutive days to take the series.

TAMPA WEARY: The Fire Frogs are 1-15 over the past two seasons at Steinbrenner Field with their only win coming on May 10th last year. They were swept in a three-game set the first time they played here a couple weeks ago, being outscored 19-3 and being shutout by Friday's starter, RHP Miguel Yajure, on May 22. Tampa has won seven straight from Florida.

TODAY'S STARTER: 24 -year-old LHP Hayden Deal is ready to make his 12 th Advanced-A start on the hill today, and will be starting against the Tarpons for the first time... He was lights out for the Rome Braves last season, 9-1 record, 2.17 ERA, 27 G ( 5 starts), $78.2 \mathrm{IP}, 62 \mathrm{H}, 17 \mathrm{BB}, 82 \mathrm{~K}$... With his performance, he was named Rome' Pitcher of the Year by the Braves organization... His wins were the second-most in the Braves system and his ERA was second-lowest among Atlanta farmhands with at least 75 innings thrown... His 4.82 strikeout-to-walk ratio was second in the organization in 2018... He was undrafted out of a small DI school (Presbyterian) in South Carolina... Royals said their Minor League roster was full, hence Billy Best and the Braves were able to sign him instead on June 23rd, 2017... Led the Big South conference in appearances (31) out of the bullpen during 2016 season and finished a league-high $26 \ldots$.. Held opponents to a .242 BAA in 2015 while making 29 appearances, beat Clemson on April 1st... Played baseball for four years at Bandys HS in Catawba, N.C... his father also was in athletics there.

ALL-STAR FROGS: The FSL announced that Four Fire Frogs had earned bids to play in this year's 58th FSL All-Star Game at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium for the North Division in Jupiter on June 15th. William Contreras, Brandon White, Hayden Deal, and Riley Unroe are all worthy candidates. With Unroe being promoted in Mid-May to AA-Mississippi, it was announced that Riley Delgado would replace him. The Fire Frogs have 5 total selections, 3 All-Stars participating in the game, one more than a year ago. William Contreras also got promoted to AA earlier this week so he will not participate
