DELGADO DIGS IN: The efficiency in which All-Star Riley Delgado has reached base is startling. He has gotten on in 62 of the 74 games he has logged a plate appearance and has hits in 55 of those games. He has seperate 9-game (4/12-4/22) and 10-game (4/27-5/7) on-base streaks and was on a season-best 17-game streak that ended June 11. Delly went 1x5 to extend his hitting streak to four straight. Delgado is also swatting .386 (17x44) over his past ten games after breaking out of an 0x12 slump in Daytona on June 17. He holds the second longest away hitting streak in the FSL, recording at least a knock in 15 straight road contests dating back to May 23 at Dunedin: .325 AVG, 15 RBI, 7 2B, 3B, 10 R, 6 BB, 9 K, .358 OBP.

ROAD READY ?: The Fire Frogs begin a season-long ten-game road trip on Friday, returning to Tampa for the third time. Florida will also play three in Dunedin Monday-Wednesday (7/1-7/3) and four in Bradenton next weekend (7/4-7/7). Florida has struggled on the road this year with a 12-25 mark. The Fire Frogs enter this set having won backto-back road games just three times this season (4/4-4/5 at Daytona, 5/9-5/10 at Jupiter, 6/4-6/5 at FTM). Florida is 1-8-1 in 2019 road series.

TIME FOR A TAMPA TURNAROUND: The Fire Frogs are 1-17 over the past two seasons at Steinbrenner Field with their only win coming on May 10th last year. They were swept in a three-game set the first time they played here May 20-22, being outscored 19-3 and being shutout by Sunday's upcoming starter, RHP Miguel Yajure, on May 22. The Tarpons outscored the Frogs 13-3 in another sweep June 7-9. Tampa has won nine straight from Florida.

HARRIS HOPPING ON: Harris went 1x2 with a double on Friday, drawing three walks to climb on-base four times and move his personal Advanced-A best on-base streak to 11. He has hits in 13 of his first 19 games at Advanced-A. The SAL Mid-Season All-Star has combined to slash .354/.433/.575 with 11 HR, 53 RBI, 95 H, 18 2B, 4 3B, 50 R, 29 BB, 44 K and 5 SB between Low-A Rome and Florida.

OPPOSING STARTER: RHP Janson Junk is ready to make his 7th Advanced-A start of the season and his second career start against the Fire Frogs. He went the distance in a rain-shortened contest in Kissimmee on 5/5: W, 5.1 IP, 3 H, ER, BB, career-high 8 K, PC: 82/59 strikes. His last start was at Bradenton (6/22): ND, 6.1 IP, 4 H, ER, HR, 0 BB, 3 K, PC: 81/54. He was a 22nd Round pick of the Yankees out of Seattle University in 2017.

JEFREY JUMPS ABOARD: The 20-year-old slugger has rebounded nicely from an 0x18 slump he was suffering through at the beginning of the Daytona series on Monday June 17. He has climbed aboard in twelve straight games. He had a four-game hitting streak end on Wednesday, but he went 1x4 yesterday with 2 RBI and has now hit in two straight.
