TORTUGAS TRICKLE BACK TO TRIUMPH IN EXTRAS, 6-4: Florida went back-and-forth with the Daytona early, but the Tortugas erased a 4-2 deficit and went on to win, 6-4, in eleven innings on Sunday afternoon at Osceola County Stadium. RHP Freddy Tamok churned out his second straight quality start and has allowed just three earned runs over his last three starts since returning from injury. He yielded seven hits, two runs, and mixed in a career-best seven strikeouts across seven stanzas. The Fire Frogs took their first lead in the second inning. Three straight hits from Jeffrey Ramos and Drew Lugbauer off RHP Austin Orewiler set up Logan Brown to drill a two-run single up the middle for a 2-1 lead. Daytona tied it in the third, but then a two-out rally in the fourth pushed Florida ahead, 4-2. Brett Langhorne smacked his third homer of the year to right for the first tally. Shean Michel singled, stole a base, and would score on an Andrew Moritz base hit. Michel notched his third three-hit game as a Fire Frog while slashing 3-4. Moritz was 2-6 and drove in a run. Daytona scored once in the eighth and once in the ninth to force extras, then scored two in the eleventh to seal the victory. The Tortugas got seven shutout innings from their bullpen to ensure victory.

CLEARWATER COLLISION: The Fire Frogs are in a span where they play the Threshers 9 times out of 37 games. Florida hasn't played Clearwater at the Pond in well over three months, avoiding a sweep by winning 5-2 on April 17. The Threshers have a winning record at Osceola County Stadium since the Fire Frogs moved to Kissimmee, notching a 9-7 mark over the past two-plus seasons after going 3-3 in 2018. In the season series, Florida has won five of seven and three straight since losing the first two games of set against Clearwater on April 15 and 16.

DELGADO DIGGING OUT OF SLUMP: All-Star Riley Delgado struggled early in the month of July but has picked it back up lately. He has gotten on in 79 of the 99 games he has logged a plate appearance and has hits in 69 of those games. He has separate 9-game (4/12-4/22) and 10-game (4/27-5/7) on-base streaks and had a season-best 17-game streak that ended June 11. He holds the second longest away hitting streak in the FSL, recording at least a knock in 15 straight road contests dating back to May 23 at Dunedin and ending June 29 at Tampa: .325 AVG, 15 RBI, 7 2B, 3B, 10 R, 6 BB, 9 K, .358 OBP. Delly still paces the circuit with 113 hits and is third in the Braves organization behind Rafael Ortega's 114 (Gwinnett) and Drew Waters' 133 (Mississippi) and has more hits and a higher average than Cristian Pache (.276, 103). Delgado is hitting .228 (21-92) in 24 July ballgames, but has seven hits over his last five assignments (7x18, averaging .389) including a second-straight two-hit effort on Sunday.

JOSEPHINA JAMS IN JULY: The Fire Frogs utility man Kevin Josephina had his longest hitting streak of the season come to an end on Saturday. He had a hit in seven consecutive assignments, starting on July 19 and was averaging .429 (9x21) with a homer and 2 RBIs over that span. Kevin is slashing a very respectable .250 this month through 22 ballgames and has driven in 5 runs. He also began the month with a six-game hit streak. He has reached base in 16 of his 22 July games.

LANGHORNE LASHING: Brett Langhorne has been crushing the ball in particular over a span of his last 13 games. He's averaging .395 (16x41) with 2 HR, 7 RBIs, 2 BB, and 4 2B while putting together four multi-hit efforts. Since the start of the month, Langhorne is swatting .288 (17x59) with 4 2B, 2 HR, 8 RBIs, 6 BB, and 11 R. He hit his first homer at the Pond this season on Sunday against Daytona RHP Austin Orewiler, clearing the right field fence for a 4-2 Florida lead in the 4th.

THE MORITZ POND MASH: Andrew Moritz has enjoyed the friendly confines of Osceola County Stadium since being called up to the Fire Frogs mid-season, averaging .348 (24x69) with seven multi-hit efforts. He has hits in 15 of his 17 home assignments and is currently on an eight-game home hit streak which is the longest active streak in the FSL.

OPPOSING PITCHER: Rehabbing MLB pitcher RHP Jerad Eickhoff makes his first start since being placed on the Injured List by the Philadelphia Phillies with right biceps tendinitis on June 17. He was 3-4 with a 5.71 ERA over 12 appearances (10 starts) and 58.1 IP (37 ER, 18 BB, 51 K) with the Phillies before coming down with the ailment. He was initially acquired at the trade deadline by the Phillies in 2015 in a swap with the Texas Rangers, coming over with LHP Matt Harrison, C Jorge Alfaro, OF Nick Williams, RHP Alec Asher, and RHP Jake Thompson for LHP Jake Diekman, LHP Cole Hamels, and cash. Eickhoff was drafted in the 15th Round back in 2011 by the Rangers out of Olney Central College.

Tonight's Start: 16th Advanced-A appearance in 2019, 14th start. This will be his 36th career Advanced-A game and 14th start at this level. He has pitched in 137 prior MiLB games and has started 16 games in his career. Pfeifer is making his second career start against Clearwater (7/13 GM 1 at Spectrum Field): W (1st as starter this year), 7 IP (CG, 1st of career), 6 H, 2 ER, HR, BB, 7 K, PC: 101/71 (5th-time 100+ PC). This will be his first home start since 6/25 and second time getting the ball at the Pond in the second half.

Last Start: 7/24 (last Wednesday) at Lakeland: W (third win as starter this season, has won three starts in a row), 7 IP, 29 BF, 7 H, 2 ER, 1 BB, 8 K, WP, PC: 108/73 (career-high pitch count). Has permitted just 4 ER over his previous 36.2 innings (0.98 ERA), dating back to the 2nd inning of his start against Palm Beach on June 25 at the Pond. He enters tonight's start T-3rd in the FSL in Ks with 102.

Notes: Pfeifer earned his first-ever Pitcher of the Week nomination for the period of July 15-21, tossing eight shutout innings of three-hit baseball with a franchise-record 17 strikeouts to earn the first weekly award of his career. His last start before this season came on April 25th, 2018 at Rochester while with Gwinnett: IP, 2 H, 2 ER, 2 HB, BB, 0 K, PC: 36/20 strikes. He permitted a run in six of his seven outings with Mississippi this season before being sent down on April 29th. This is the first time while with the Braves system that he's pitching for Florida and the first time he's been at Advanced-A since 2016, when he pitched in a combined 20 games between Rancho Cucamonga (Dodgers) and the Carolina Mudcats. Acquired from the Dodgers with RHP Caleb Dirks for RHP Bud Norris, OF Dian Toscano, PTBNL (RHP Alex Grosser), and cash on June 30, 2016. Drafted in the 3rd Round (101st overall) by the Dodgers back in 2015. Also was drafted in the 44th Round back in 2011 out of Farragut HS in Knoxville, TN.
