**FLOODED POND:** The Fire Frogs will play their tenth twin bill of the season, second this week, and second this season in Kissimmee against Daytona on Friday after Thursday's postponement due to persistent rain. The Tortugas swept the Fire Frogs on Saturday, April 20 in their double header. Florida has at least earned a split in 5 of its 9 double dips this season.

**PFEIFER PUTS FLYING TIGERS TO BED AFTER FAST START WEDNESDAY, 3-2:** Reigning FSL Pitcher of the Week LHP Philip Pfeifer churned out seven innings for the third-time in his last four starts and the Fire Frogs plated three runs in the fourth to hold off the Lakeland Flying Tigers, 3-2, and secure their third straight road series on Wednesday night at Publix Field at Joker-Marchant Stadium. Lakeland flew out in front early. Brock Deatherage and Cole Peterson swatted hits to start off the first against Pfeifer. Kody Clemens then blooped a two-run single to center for a 2-0 Flying Tigers lead. Pfeifer allowed nothing further across seven innings, surrendering two earned runs and seven hits with eight strikeouts while tossing a career-high 108 pitches, 73 for strikes. The Fire Frogs attacked RHP Tom de Blok in the fourth. Jeffrey Ramos led off with a double. Drew Lugbauer tripled to deep right-center to score Ramos. Two batters later, Jordan Rodgers smacked his third homer of the season to left, placing Florida in front for good, 3-2.

**TORTUGA TUSSLE:** The North Division rivals square off for the final time in Kissimmee, with Daytona having captured the first five games played at the Pond this season. Daytona is 14-6 in games played at Osceola County Stadium during the Fire Frogs history. After Florida took the first two games in Daytona to open the 2019 season, the Tortugas have won seven of eight. RHP Nolan Kingham's complete game shutout on June 18 was the only triumph during this span.

**DELGADO DIGGING OUT OF SLUMP:** All-Star Riley Delgado struggled early in the month of July but has picked it back up lately with hits in his last three assignments. He has gotten on in 76 of the 95 games he has logged a plate appearance and has hits in 67 of those games. He has separate 9-game (4/12-4/22) and 10-game (4/27-5/7) on-base streaks and had a season-best 17-game streak that ended June 11. He holds the second longest away hitting streak in the FSL, recording at least a knock in 15 straight road contests dating back to May 23 at Dunedin and ending June 29 at Tampa: .325 AVG, 15 RBI, 7 2B, 3B, 10 R, 6 BB, 9 K, .358 OBP. Dolly still paces the circuit with 109 hits and is third in the Braves organization behind Rafael Ortega's 112 (Gwinnett) and Drew Waters' 130 (Mississippi) and has a higher average and more hits than Cristian Pache (.283, 102). Delgado is hitting .215 (17-79) in his first 20 July ballgames, but notched his second three-hit effort of the month by swatting 3x5 in the series finale at Lakeland.

**THE 'FIVE' GUYS:** Kevin Josephina and Shean Michel are on five-game hitting streaks entering play today. They both had hits on Tuesday and played in both halves of the twin bill in Lakeland. For Josephina, this is his fourth streak of five games or more in 2019. For Michel this is his longest knock streak of the season in a Fire Frogs uniform. There have now been 21 unique five-game or longer hitting streaks for Florida batters this season. Andrew Moritz had his five-gamer come to an end on Wednesday evening, going 0x5.

**LANGHORNE LASHING:** Brett Langhorne has been crushing the ball in particular over his last 10 games. He's averaging .452 (14x31) with 1 HR, 6 RBIs, 2 BB, and 3 2B while putting together four multi-hit efforts. Since the start of the month, Langhorne is swatting .306 (15x49) with 3 2B, 1 HR, 7 RBIs, 6 BB, and 9 R. He is leading off in game one of the double header today for just the second-time this season.

**WALKER WALKS TO THE ATL:** RHP Jeremy Walker became the 14th Fire Frog to receive the call to the majors and it appears will be the 6th former Florida player this season to make his MLB debut. The 24-year-old former 5th Round selection in 2016 out of Gardner-Webb was 5-11 over 25 starts for the Fire Frogs back in 2018, maintaining at 4.07 ERA, throwing one complete game over 135 innings with 46 walks and 95 Ks. He was 2-6 with a 2.84 ERA across 26 appearances (one start) and made 7 saves in 69.2 innings with just 8 walks and 71 strikeouts and a .251 opposing batting average.

**Today's Start:** Beck's 13th appearance of the season, 11th start, 8th with the Fire Frogs. He is going to be starting an Advanced-A game for the fourth time since April 26 in Port St. Lucie, where he suffered a groin injury and was then placed on the Injured List the next day.

**Last Start:** Beck didn't draw a decision last Friday (7/19) vs. Fort Myers at the Pond: 4.2 IP, 8 H, 5 ER, 3 BB, 5 K, PC: 94/60 strikes (largest pitch count of career). Had allowed 1 ER in his previous 14 IP with FLO (11 ER in first 12.2 IP) before his start against the Miracle.

**Notes:** While making his fourth start of the 2019 season on 4/26, Beck injured his groin after 1.1 innings and missed two months before being activated to the roster on 7/3... Combined to throw nine rehab innings over two starts with the GCL Braves on 6/26 and 7/1: 0-0, 9 H, 6 R, 4 ER, 4 BB, 14 K (career-high 11 on 7/1), scaled up from 29 to 52 pitches... He threw 4.2 frames over 3 appearances (1 start) with the GCL Braves last year, striking out 7 and walking 2... Had a stress fracture in his back during his sophomore season at Stanford in 2017 so he didn't pitch... this injury pushed him back to the 29th round (Yankees) of the draft... Was the Opening Day Starter for the Cardinal as a Junior in 2018 (8-4, 2.98 ERA, 90.2 IP, 73 K, 31 BB)... Also taken in the 34th Round by the Brewers in 2015... His grandfather, Donald Piper, was in the Welsh Cup for Rugby (Equivalent to National All-American)... Threw two no-hitters in high school and a 10-inning one-hitter... His mother and sister graduated from Stanford.

**Notes:** Deal was lights out for the Rome Braves last season, 9-1 record, 2.17 ERA, 27 G (5 starts), 78.2 IP, 62 H, 17 BB, 82 K... With his performance, he was named Rome's Pitcher of the Year by the Braves organization... His wins were the second-most in the Braves system and his ERA was second-lowest among Atlanta farmhands with at least 75 innings thrown... His 4.82 strikeout-to-walk ratio was second in the organization in 2018... He was undrafted out of a small DI school (Presbyterian) in South Carolina... Royals said their Minor League roster was full, hence Billy Best and the Braves were able to sign him instead on June 23rd, 2017... Led the Big South conference in appearances (31) out of the bullpen during 2016 season and finished a league-high 26... Held opponents to a .242 BAA in 2015 while making 29 appearances, beat Clemson on April 1st... Played baseball for four years at Bandys HS in Catawba, N.C... his father also was in athletics there.
