**BROWN'S WALK-OFF DOUBLE DEVASTATES DAYTONA, 2-1:** Logan Brown's one-out, two-run double in the bottom of the ninth erased a 1-0 deficit and propelled the Florida Fire Frogs to an exciting 2-1 victory over the Daytona Tortugas on Saturday evening at Osceola County Stadium. Florida wasted no time getting the rally going in the ninth down 1-0. Jeffrey Ramos singled and Drew Lugbauer coaxed a walk from LHP Andy Cox to put two on. Kevin Josephina attempted to move pinch runners Shean Michel and Brett Langhorne up via a bunt but couldn't. Brown then came up and smacked an 0-1 pitch into the left-center field alleyway to score both runners and ensure victory. Brown ended up 2-4 on the night with hits in his last two at-bats.

Daytona grabbed an unearned run in the 8th. Drew Mount struck out but reached on a wild pitch from RHP Nolan Kingham. He advanced to second on a fielder's choice and to third on a throwing error from Josephina. Andy Sugilio sent him to the plate on a sacrifice fly. Kingham was spectacular once again, tossing 8 innings or more for the 6th time this season. He scattered 7 hits and 9 strikeouts, his second-highest of the year, across 8 and 2/3's innings.

**TORTUGA TUSSLE:** The North Division rivals square off for the final time in Kissimmee, with Daytona capturing the first six games played at the Pond this season before Florida won the past two. Daytona is 15-8 in games played at Osceola County Stadium during the Fire Frogs history. After Florida took the first two games in Daytona to open the 2019 season, the Tortugas have won eight of eleven, but Florida has won back-to-back for the second time in this season series.

**DELGADO DIGGING OUT OF SLUMP:** All-Star Riley Delgado struggled early in the month of July but has picked it back up lately. He has gotten on in 78 of the 98 games he has logged a plate appearance and has hits in 68 of those games.

He has separate 9-game (4/12-4/22) and 10-game (4/27-5/7) on-base streaks and had a season-best 17-game streak that ended June 11. He holds the second longest away hitting streak in the FSL, recording at least a knock in 15 straight road contests dating back to May 23 at Dunedin and ending June 29 at Tampa: .325 AVG, 15 RBI, 7 2B, 3B, 10 R, 6 BB, 9 K, .358 OBP. Delly still paces the circuit with 111 hits and is third in the Braves organization behind Rafael Ortega's 113 (Gwinnett) and Drew Waters' 131 (Mississippi) and has more hits than Cristian Pache (103). Delgado is hitting .216 (19-88) in 23 July ballgames, but has five hits over his last four assignments including a two-hit effort last night.

**JOSEPHINA JAMS IN JULY:** The Fire Frogs utility man Kevin Josephina had his longest hitting streak of the season come to an end yesterday. He had a hit in seven consecutive assignments, starting on July 19 and was averaging .429 (9x21) with a homer and 2 RBIs over that span. Kevin is slushing a very respectable .250 this month through 22 ballgames and has driven in 5 runs. He also began the month with a six-game hit streak. He has reached base in 16 of his 22 July games.

**LANGHORNE LASHING:** Brett Langhorne has been crushing the ball in particular over a span of 12 games. He's averaging .417 (15x36) with 1 HR, 6 RBIs, 2 BB, and 4 2B while putting together four multi-hit efforts. Since the start of the month, Langhorne is swatting .296 (16x54) with 4 2B, 1 HR, 7 RBIs, 6 BB, and 10 R. He led off in game one of the double header yesterday for just the second-time this season. He pinch-ran and scored the winning run in last night's victory against Daytona.

**WALKER WALKS TO THE ATL:** RHP Jeremy Walker became the 14th Fire Frog to receive the call to the majors and is the 6th former Florida player this season to make his MLB debut for Atlanta. The 24-year-old former 5th Round selection in 2016 out of Gardner-Webb was 5-11 over 25 starts for the Fire Frogs back in 2018, maintaining at 4.07 ERA, throwing one complete game over 135 innings with 46 walks and 95 Ks. He was 2-6 with a 2.84 ERA across 26 appearances (one start) and made 7 saves in 69.2 innings with just 8 walks and 71 strikeouts and a .251 opposing batting average. On Friday night, Walker made his debut in the 9th of a 9-2 Braves victory in Philadelphia over the Phillies, working around a hit and tossing a scoreless frame. He also tossed a scoreless stanza in another Braves victory, 15-7, over Philly last night.

Injured 6/3 in start at Fort Myers, missed a month, sent to GCL to make 3 rehab starts (7/2, 7/5, 7/10): 0-1, 3.38 ERA, 3 H, 2 HB, 1 BB, 9 K, went from 8 to 18 to 30 pitches.
