**LAST TIME OUT: WILKINS WILLS FIRE FROGS TO TUESDAY TWIN BILL SWEEP:** Andy Wilkins delivered the winning runs in both games and phenomenal pitching efforts across the board ruled the day for the Florida Fire Frogs, who took two from the Bradenton Marauders, 6-0 and 2-1, to open up a five-game series on a high note on Tuesday evening at Osceola County Stadium. Florida pitching allowed no earned runs and fanned 21 Marauders over 15 innings. RHP Brooks Wilson and RHP Matt Withrow combined to throw 9 shutout innings as the starters of the contests. Wilson (4-2) grabbed the win in game one by firing 6.1 IP and tying his career-high 9-K total. Wilkins slammed a two-run HR in the first to open the scoring in game one. Florida began the fourth inning with four straight hits against RHP Gavin Wallace. Jeffrey Ramos and Drew Lugbauer notched singles. Logan Brown swatted a two-bagger to send both home. Kevin Josephina then hit a ground-rule double to plate Brown. Josephina would advance to third on a groundout and score on a wild pickup attempt from Bradenton catcher Raul Hernandez to round out the four-run frame, 6-0. After Travis Swaggerty put the Marauders ahead 1-0 in game two in the eighth, Riley Delgado and Wilkins swatted back-to-back bases loaded singles to lead the Frogs to their sixth walk-off triumph of the season.

**FIRE FROGS AND MARAUDERS MINGLE:** The Fire Frogs and Marauders begin their 8-game season series on the 4th of July, having played 17 prior games over the past two seasons. Florida is 5-6 at LECOM Park, having split a four-game series in 2017 and 2018. The Fire Frogs are 6-5 at the Pond against the Marauders, only playing five of eight scheduled games at the Pond last year with numerous postponements and three cancellations. Florida did get all four scheduled home games with Bradenton in 2017 but did have to play one doubleheader.

**DELGADO DIVES ON:** All-Star Riley Delgado has gotten on in 91 of the 114 games he has logged a plate appearance and has hits in 80 of those games. He has separate 9-game (4/12-4/22) and 10-game (4/27-5/7) on-base streaks and had a season-best 17-game streak that ended June 11. He holds the second longest away hitting streak in the FSL, recording at least a knock in 15 straight road contests dating back to May 23 at Dunedin and ending June 29 at Tampa: .325 AVG, 15 RBI, 7 2B, 3B, 10 R, 6 BB, 9 K, .358 OBP. Delly still paces the circuit with 126 hits and is 2nd in the Braves organization trailing Drew Waters' 144 between Mississippi and Gwinnett. Delgado hit .223 (21-94) in 25 July ballgames but has approached a more normal clip of .265 through 13 games. He is coming off of a slow series against the Flying Tigers where he went 1x13, but he combined to go 4x7 with the game-tying RBI in the 8th last night of game two which was a 2-1 Florida win.

**THE MORITZ POND MASH:** Andrew Moritz has enjoyed the friendly confines of the Pond since being called up to the Fire Frogs mid-season, averaging .360 (32x89) with nine multi-hit efforts. He has hits in 20 of his 22 home assignments and is currently on a twelve-game home hit streak, the longest active streak in the FSL. He is hitting just .205 away from home. Moritz has been nursing an injury and hasn't played since August 9th (last Friday) vs. Lakeland.

**LASHING LUGBAUER:** The last 11 games have seen the bat of Drew Lugbauer heat up, raising his average from .177 to .190 for the year. He is hitting .361 (13x36) with 3 HR, 2 2Bs, 8 RBIs, 3 BBs, and 7 runs scored. He has 5 multi-hit efforts during this stretch and has reached in nine of the contests. He has a very respectable .243 second half average and has slugged 11 HRs, 10 2Bs, has driven in 28 runs, and has scored 23 times while boosting his average from .151 to .190.

**STARTING OFF RIGHT:** Florida starting pitchers really started to warm up in July with three straight pitchers capping off the month with quality starts. Over the last 18 games, starters have permitted just a 1.97 ERA (23 ER/105.0 IP) going back to game two of a Friday (7/26) twin bill against Daytona. Taking this back further, 12 quality starts have been fired over the previous 23 games and the pitchers have maintained a 2.38 ERA (36 ER/136.1 IP), this span does include RHP Tristan Beck allowing 6 ER over 5.1 IP on Friday July 26 in game one of the twin bill against Daytona and RHP Freddy Tarnok permitting 5 ER Sunday 8/4 at Jupiter. Tarnok came up one out short of earning a quality start Saturday night vs. Lakeland.

**COMPLETE GAME KINGS:** Florida fired its ninth complete game Sunday when Matt Hartman went the distance. This total is three more than any other team in Minor League Baseball, besting the Double-A Jackson Generals of the Southern League who have six to their name. The Cleveland Indians lead Major League Baseball with five complete games.
