SUNDAY: The Tampa Tarpons shutout the Fire Frogs for the second time in a three-game weekend series while prevailing 5-0 at Steinbrenner Field, LHP Hayden Deal, who surrendered a two-run homer to Dermis Garcia in the first, wasn't able to return after a rain delay that lasted 32 minutes. RHP Lukas Young, RHP Daysbel Hernandez, and RHP Brandon White combined to pitch the final seven innings out of the pen. Trey Harris had two more hits and Riley Delgado continued his recent tear.

DELGADO DIGS IN: The efficiency in which Riley Delgado has reached base this year is startling. He has gotten on in 53 of the 60 games he has logged a plate appearance and he has hits in 46 of those contests. He has seperate 9-game (4/12-4/22) and 10-game (4/27-5/7) on-base streaks to his credit and is currently on a season-best 17 game streak, which is tied for second in the league with Trevor Larnach's from Fort Myers and two behind Alejo Lopez of Daytona. Delgado's .303 average is 6th in the FSL and he has three more hits (72) than anyone else in the league. Larnach is second with 69.

POND BONANZA WITH THE BLUE JAYS: The Fire Frogs return home after a seven-game road trip that saw them go 2-5 and drop their final four games. The Fire Frogs begin a four-game series with the D-Jays, who they will play twice in Kissimmee in 2019, starting with this series and the final home series of the season (8/23-8/25). Florida went 4-6 against Dunedin a year ago, 0-4 at the Pond with two cancellations at the end of May shortening the season series by two contests. The D-Jays are 6-4 in games played at Osceola County Stadium over the past two seasons

FREE THE FROGS: Florida has been outscored 20-7 over the span of their four-game losing streak. The Fire Frogs have stranded 31 runners on base (averaging almost 8/game) and have gone 3x29 (.103) with runners in scoring position. Since May 28th, Florida has swatted .191 with men in scoring position (22x115) over its last 13 games.

TODAY'S STARTER: RHP Matt Withrow will make the start today for the Frogs. He missed 2018 to injury, made first appearance since 9/3/17 on May 3rd vs. Tampa: W, 3.1 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 3 K, PC: 49/33. 2017: Appeared in 10 games for the Mississippi Braves (AA)...Went 1-3 with a 4.47era (24er/48.1ip) with 22 walks and 44 strikeouts...Placed on the 7-Day disabled list on 6/7...Assigned to GCL Braves for rehab assignment on 6/28...Tossed five scoreless frames at the GCL level, picking up five strikeouts...Transferred to the Florida on 8/7. 2016: Played the entirety of his second professional season with High-A Carolina and went 9-6 with a 3.80 ERA (51 ER/120.2 IP) and 131 strikeouts in 25 games (24 starts) to earn the Mudcats' Pitcher of the Year honors from the organization...Paced Carolina in wins (9) and led all Mudcats starters with a 3.80 ERA (51 ER/120.2 IP), while his 131 strikeouts on the season were second most in the Carolina League and fifth most among Braves farmhands... Also ranked in the Top 10 among Atlanta pros-pects in wins (T3rd, 9), starters ERA (8th, 3.80) and innings (10th, 120.2).... Surrendered 3 or fewer earned runs in 21 of his 25 games, and aside from a 3.0-inning start in which he gave up 11 runs on 7/23, he pitched to a 3.06 ERA...Earned his first pro W in his 4th start of the season on 5/1 (vs. LYN)... Fanned career-best 11 in his final start of the season, 8/31 vs. Wilmington. 2015: Made his professional debut with rookie-level Danville after being selected by the Braves in the sixth round of the 2015 June free agent draft...Allowed two earned runs or fewer in 12 of his 13 starts...Pitched primarily in relief during his junior season at Texas Tech and turned in a career-best 3.63 ERA (9 ER/22.1 IP) over 13 games (1 start).

With Unroe being promoted in Mid-May to AA-Mississippi, it was announced that Riley Delgado would replace him. The Fire Frogs have 5 total selections, 3 All-Stars participating in the game, one more than a year ago. William Contreras also got promoted to AA last week so he will not participate.
