**LAST TIME OUT: DUNEDIN DARTS PAST FLORIDA:** The Fire Frogs held a 7-1 edge through the first four frames, but the Dunedin Blue Jays rallied to score eight runs over the final five innings, surpassing Florida, 9-8, to even the series on Saturday night at Osceola County Stadium. Florida jumped all over RHP Kyle Johnston early. A Riley Delgado double was sandwiched by walks to Brett Langhorne and Andy Wilkins. Drew Lugauber brought home Langhorne with a sacrifice fly for the lead. A wild pitch during Jeffrey Ramos at-bat plated the second run; 2-0 Fire Frogs. Garrison Schwartz coaxed a one-out walk to climb aboard in the bottom half of the frame. Two batters later, Langhorne's RBI two-bagger to the gap in right-center sent Schwartz scampering around the bases for a 3-1 Fire Frogs edge. Langhorne picked up his second straight multi-hit effort and 14th of the season. He was 2-3 with a double, an RBI, a run, and he was issued two free passes. Florida seemingly broke the game open with a four-run third as six consecutive hitters reached with one down. Rusber Estrada smacked a two-run single. Schwartz and Shean Michel followed with RBI knocks of their own to balloon the lead to 7-1. RHP Brooks Wilson didn't factor in the decision for the Fire Frogs, permitting four earned runs and two walks with four strikeouts in six innings of seven-hit baseball. Florida was ahead 8-5 upon Wilson's removal from the game before the seventh inning began. The Fire Frogs scratched across a run on a Delgado double play ball in the bottom of the sixth. A three-run eighth, headlined by a two-run double from Chavez Young, tied the game for Dunedin. A bases loaded walk to Samad Taylor in the 9th put them ahead for good, 9-8.

**BATTLE WITH THE BLUE JAYS:** The Fire Frogs began a three-game series with the D-Jays on Friday, who they have played twice in Kissimmee in 2019, starting with the last first half series in June. The Fire Frogs were swept in three games during the rain-shortened series. The D-Jays brought a six-game series winning streak into Kissimmee. Florida went 4-6 against Dunedin a year ago, 0-4 at the Pond with two cancellations at the end of May shortening the season series by two contests. The D-Jays are now 10-5 in games played at Osceola County Stadium after last night's win.

**DELGADO DIVES ON:** All-Star Riley Delgado has gotten on in 98 of the 125 games he has logged a plate appearance and has hits in 87 of those games. He has separate 9-game (4/12-4/22) and 10-game (4/27-5/7) on-base streaks and had a season-best 17-game streak that ended June 11. He holds the second longest away hitting streak in the FSL, recording at least a knock in 15 straight road contests dating back to May 23 at Dunedin and ending June 29 at Tampa: .325 AVG, 15 RBI, 7 2B, 3B, 10 R, 6 BB, 9 K, .358 OBP. Dolly still paces the circuit with 138 hits and is 2nd in the Braves organization trailing Drew Waters' 156 between Mississippi and Gwinnett. After hitting .223 in July, Delgado is swatting .263 through 24 August games. Delgado was on a 1x18 skid going into Friday's game, but rebounded with his 41st multi-hit effort, slashing 2-4, to break out of that stretch on Friday and also had a hit yesterday.

**RAMOS GETS REPETITIVE:** Essentially every night over the past two weeks, Jeffrey Ramos has notched a hit, including having hits in 11 of his last 13 assignments entering today's action. Dating back to a double header with Bradenton on 8/13, Ramos is mashing .304 (14x46) with 1 HR, 6 RBIs, 5 R, 4 BB, and just 6 K. He has three-multi hit efforts during this span. He was hitting .300 (6x20) over his five-game hitting streak that was snapped yesterday. Ramos is swatting .292 for the month of August with 2 HR and 14 RBIs. His 55 RBI total for the season leads the Fire Frogs and is T-12th in the FSL.

**STARTING OFF RIGHT:** Florida starting pitchers warmed up in July with three straight pitchers capping off the month with quality starts. Over a recent 18-game stretch, starters permitted just a 1.97 ERA (23 ER/105.0 IP) going back to game two of a Friday (7/26) twin bill against Daytona. Taking this back further, 12 quality starts were fired over the previous 23 games and the pitchers have maintained a 2.38 ERA (36 ER/136.1 IP). Combined with last Wednesday's double header and the Thursday finale against Bradenton, the Fire Frogs staff had given up 12 ER in 15 innings, compiling a 7.20 ERA with one quality start. But, the Frogs have rebounded with 49.1 innings thrown with six quality starts in their last eight games, yielding just 14 earned runs and a 2.55 ERA.

**COMPLETE GAME KINGS:** Florida fired its 10th complete game last Saturday when Matt Hartman went the distance for the 2nd straight time. This total is 4 more than any other team in the MiLB, besting the Double-A Jackson Generals of the Southern League. The Cleveland Indians and the Chicago White Sox lead the MLB with five. The Fire Frogs also tossed their 16th shutout victory on Saturday in game two, a total that is T-8th in all of the MiLB. They are tied with the Mississippi Braves who also have 16. Montgomery (Double-A, Rays) and Quad Cities (Low-A, Astros) lead MiLB with 19 shutouts.
