SUNDAY: The Fire Frogs broke a six-game losing streak by dispatching the Blue Jays, 6-2, on Sunday afternoon at Jack Russell Memorial Stadium. Dunedin broke out in front for the fourth straight game, but Florida rallied with three runs in the fourth and two in the fifth to grab the lead. Greyson Jenista had RBI doubles in both frames. Contreras notched a run-scoring two-bagger in the fourth. Izzy Wilson and Riley Delgado both went 2-5 with 2 runs scored. RHP Matt Withrow allowed an earned run in 3 and 1/3's innings. RHP Walter Borkovich got five scoreless outs. RHP Troy Bacon allowed a solo homer over 1 and 1/3's. RHP Brandon White notched a seven-out save.

POWER OUTAGE: The Fire Frogs haven't hit a homer over their last eight ballgames, the last one coming on May 18th vs. Jupiter (Ramos) in a 12-0 win. Since April 25th, the night of its last multi-homer game, Florida has hit just 10 long balls as a team in the last 29 games.

CONTRERAS CUTTING: The Braves #9 prospect became the 3rd Fire Frog to record a hitting streak of at least 7 games this season last week, joining Jefrey Ramos (7) and Riley Unroe (10). He bumped that hit streak to nine with a hit in the finale of the Tampa series. He has hit safely in 12 of his last 14 games and has 7 RBIs during this stretch.

DELGADO DIGS IN: The efficiency in which Riley Delgado has reached base this year is startling. He has gotten on in 40 of the 47 games he has logged a plate appearance and he has hits in 35 of those contests. He has separate 9-game (4/12-4/22) and 10-game (4/27-5/7) on-base streaks to his credit. After going hitless last Wednesday in Tampa, he has recorded at least a knock in each of the games against Dunedin.

THE HOME STAND: The Fire Frogs play the Fort Myers Miracle (Advanced-A Twins) and the Palm Beach Cardinals (Advanced-A Cardinals) in three-game sets. Two of the next three Fire Frogs sets are against Fort Myers as Florida will head down to Hammond Stadium Monday-Thursday next week for a four-game set. The Fire Frogs and Miracle matchup at the Pond six times this season with another series coming in the second half. Florida is 3-5 at home against the reigning FSL champions.

TODAY'S STARTER: LHP Philip Pfeifer will be making the 7th start of his career tonight. His last start before this season came on April 25th, 2018 at Rochester while with Gwinnett: IP, 2 H, 2 ER, 2 HB, BB, 0 K, PC: 36/20 strikes. He permitted a run in six of his seven outings with Mississippi this season before being sent down on April 29th. This is the first time while with the Braves system that he's pitching for the Fire Frogs and the first time he's been at the Advanced-A level since 2016, when he pitched in a combined 20 games between Rancho Cucamonga (Dodgers) and the Carolina Mudcats. Acquired from the Dodgers with RHP Caleb Dirks for RHP Bud Norris, OF Dian Toscano, PTBNL (RHP Alex Grosser), and cash on June 30, 2016. Drafted in the 3rd Round (101st overall) by the Dodgers back in 2015. Also was drafted in the 44th Round back in 2011 out of Farragut HS in Knoxville, TN.

ALL-STAR FROGS: The Florida State League announced on Friday that Four Fire Frogs had earned bids to play in this year's 58th FSL All-Star Game at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium in Jupiter on June 15th. William Contreras, Brandon White, Hayden Deal, and Riley Unroe were all worthy candidates to make the team. With Unroe being promoted almost two weeks ago to AA-Mississippi, it was announced that Riley Delgado would replace him on the team. Delgado was initially a snub, seeing as that he is the FSL season-leader with 56 hits and holds a Top-6 batting average in the league, entering the Miracle series at a .301 clip. The Fire Frogs have five total selections, four All-Star participating in the game, one more than a year ago.
