TUESDAY: Two three-run frames were too much to handle for the Fire Frogs last night, as the Miracle won, 7-5, in ten innings to take the set opener. The teams traded runs in the first before Fort Myers grabbed three in the top of the 4th. William Contreras and Greyson Jenista went back-to-back in the 6th to trim it to 4-3. Kevin Josephina singled to lead off the 9th and would score on a wild pitch with two outs to force extras. A three-run frame from the Miracle in the 10th would prove to be too much to overcome. Riley Delgado brought in the only run in the bottom of the 10th to provide the final margin. Philip Pfeifer allowed four earned runs in six innings, the longest outing of his career. Kurt Hoekstra tossed two scoreless frames as well. Sean McLaughlin was saddled with his second loss of the season.

POWER ERUPTION: The Fire Frogs hadn't hit a homer over their last 8 games entering play last night, the last one coming on May 18th vs. Jupiter (Ramos) in a 12-0 win. Since April 25th, the night of its last multi-homer game, Florida had hit just 10 long balls as a team in the last 29 games. BUT, William Contreras and Greyson Jenista went back-to-back last night in the 6 th, becoming the first Fire Frogs duo to hit consecutive home runs in a game since August 8th last season at the Pond against Palm Beach. Braxton Davidson and Lucas Herbert touched them all in the 7th.

CONTRERAS CUTTING: The Braves \#9 prospect became the 3rd Fire Frog to record a hitting streak of at least 7 games this season last week, joining Jefrey Ramos (7) and Riley Unroe (10). He bumped that hit streak to nine with a hit in the finale of the Tampa series. He has hit safely in 13 of his last 15 games and has a homer and 9 RBIs during this stretch. He hit his first long ball since April 9th against Jupiter in last night's win over the Miracle. His 13 game on-base streak is now tied for second-longest this year with Greyson Jenista's, which elapsed from May 6th-18th.

DELGADO DIGS IN: The efficiency in which Riley Delgado has reached base this year is startling. He has gotten on in 41 of the 48 games he has logged a plate appearance and he has hits in 36 of those contests. He has seperate 9 -game (4/12-4/22) and 10-game (4/27-5/7) on-base streaks to his credit. After going hitless last Wednesday in Tampa, he has recorded at least a knock in each of his last five games, collecting his third such streak of at least a hit in five consecutive games this season.

THE HOME STAND: The Fire Frogs play the Fort Myers Miracle (Advanced-A Twins) and the Palm Beach Cardinals (Ad-vanced-A Cardinals) in three-game sets. Two of the next three Fire Frogs sets are against Fort Myers as Florida will head down to Hammond Stadium Monday-Thursday next week for a four-game set. The Fire Frogs and Miracle matchup at the Pond six times this season with another series coming in the second half. Florida is $3-6$ at home against the reigning FSL champions.

TODAY'S STARTER: 20-year-old Freddy Tarnok makes his 10th Advanced-A start and 29th of his career tonight against Fort Myers. He was selected in the 3rd Round back in 2017 out of Riverview HS in the Tampa area. He played shortstop throughout his high school career and pitched the last two seasons. He went $7-0$ with a 0.66 ERA in 53 innings with 63 strikeouts and 11 walks. He started pitching because they needed some arms and they knew he threw pretty hard. Also hit for a .393 average with 11 doubles and 2 homers. His slot value was $\$ 709,000$, he signed to play with the Braves instead of attending D-II University of Tampa. Can touch 95-97 occasionally with his fastball, but usually sits around 92-93.
