**MIRACLE MANGLE FIRE FROGS ON SATURDAY:** Three first inning tallies and a dynamic outing from LHP Lachlan Wells guided the Fort Myers Miracle to a 5-0 win versus the Florida Fire Frogs and a series victory on Saturday evening at Osceola County Stadium. Wells (1-1) faced 19 batters over six frames, firing first-pitch strikes to 17 and keeping Florida off-kilter all night. He allowed a hit and a walk with five punch outs to earn his first win of the season. The Miracle didn't let LHP Hayden Deal settle in, slamming four straight hits to open the ballgame. Ryan Jeffers doubled in Gabriel Maciel and Royce Lewis for the first two runs. Jose Miranda's base hit plated Jeffers for a 3-0 Fort Myers edge after an inning. David Banuelos scored two more runs with a two-out two-bagger in the third to bump the lead to 5-0. Offensively, Florida mustered just three hits in the ballgame. RHP Matt Hartman logged some important and effective innings for Florida, fanning two and giving up one hit while spinning five shutout. He retired the last ten Miracle hitters that he faced.

**FIRE FROGS FLINGING Ks:** Thursday night was the first time that the Fire Frogs had notched 17 Ks in a nine-inning game and second time in Florida's history racking up 17 strikeouts, joining the 14-inning contest played versus Jupiter on July 26, 2017 which was also played at Roger Dean Stadium. Philip Pfeifer is the first FSL pitcher post-2004 to achieve 17 strikeouts in the game. It is also the first 17-strikeout game from a team dating back to that time frame. Pfeifer bumped his strikeout total from 77 to 94 (T-17th to 5th in the circuit). Sid Fernandez of Vero Beach on May 14, 1982 set the all-time FSL punch out record of 21. The Fire Frogs lead the circuit by 5 strikeouts (Jupiter has 27) over the past three days, combining for 32, and are tied for second over the past week with 52 punch outs.

**DELGADO DIGGING OUT OF SLUMP:** All-Star Riley Delgado has been struggling through the month of July. He has gotten on in 73 of the 92 games he has logged a plate appearance and has hits in 64 of those games. He has separate 9-game (4/12-4/22) and 10-game (4/27-5/7) on-base streaks and had a season-best 17-game streak that ended June 11. He holds the second longest away hitting streak in the FSL, recording at least a knock in 15 straight road contests dating back to May 23 at Dunedin and ending June 29 at Tampa: .325 AVG, 15 RBI, 7 2B, 3B, 10 R, 6 BB, 9 K, .358 OBP. Dolly still paces the circuit with 104 hits and is third in the Braves organization behind Rafael Ortega's 105 (Gwinnett) and Drew Waters' 131 (Mississippi). Delgado is hitting just .176 (12-68) in his first 17 July ballgames.

**LEFT ON A LONELY ISLAND:** The Fire Frogs stranded a season-high 17 men on Tuesday, including leaving a runner on in each inning and leaving the sacks loaded twice in their 11-7 loss to the Cardinals. The most Fire Frogs left on base previously was 14 in game one of a double header in Kissimmee against St. Lucie on May 15. The Fire Frogs hit a respectable .382 (13x34) with runners in scoring position over their next three contests, but have gone 2x16 (.125) over the past two games. For the first time this season the Fire Frogs didn't have an at-bat with men in scoring position in Saturday's shutout loss to the Miracle. Over their previous nine contests (dating back to 7/4), Florida was 7x56 (.125) with men in scoring position.

**COMPLETED THE LONG-WINDING ROAD:** The Fire Frogs began a season-long ten-game road trip on June 28, playing nine games through July 6 with one rainout in Bradenton on July 7. Florida went home for a short four-game series against Charlotte before hitting the road for another six-game road trip. Florida just finished a stretch where they were scheduled to play 16 out of 20 contests away from the Pond, but opened a stretch where they play 10 of the next 13 within the friendly confines of Osceola County Stadium on Friday.

**FORT MYERS FEVER:** The Miracle and Fire Frogs began their final series of the 2019 campaign yesterday, with Fort Myers having won the first five games played at the Pond this season. The Miracle have fared very well at this ballpark, going 10-3 during the Fire Frogs existence. As a whole, Fort Myers is a better road team this season, going 31-18 away from home but only maintaining a 24-24 home record at Hammond Stadium.

Threw his third complete game nine-inning shutout at Daytona on June 18. Tied with Juan Pablo Oramas in the Mexican League in all of the MiLB with three CG shutouts.
