COQUIS CRUSH CARDINALS FRIDAY: RHP Nolan Kingham bookended the month of May by throwing complete game shutouts, doing so on May 1st vs. Lakeland and achieving the same feat on Friday at the Pond in a 7-0 win over Palm Beach. He threw 103 pitches, walked just one, yielded two hits, struck out four, and retired the last 16 batters he faced. The offense backed him up by banging out 11 hits and 7 runs. Four players had multiple hits, Jeffrey Ramos scored three runs, and William Contreras smashed his third homer of the season off the scoreboard in right-center, his second jack in the last four games.

JOSEPHINA JUMPING: The Fire Frogs infielder may have not wanted the month of May to end. In 22 contests, he hit .337 (26-77) with five doubles, eight RBIs, and 10 runs scored. He's the only Florida hitter to be averaging over .271 (Delgado) for the month with at least 22 games played. 7 of his 9 multi-hit efforts came last month, including a 2-4 night yesterday at the dish. He raised his batting average from .196 at the end of April to the current .278.

RAMOS RAKING: With his single yesterday, Jeffrey Ramos passed his seven-game hit streak that started the season. He's hitting .364 with a homer and 2 RBIs over this eight-game stretch. Going further back however, the Dominican Republic native has recorded a knock in 11 of his last 12 ballgames, raising his average from .237 to .254.

DELGADO DIGS IN: The efficiency in which Riley Delgado has reached base this year is startling. He has gotten on in 44 of the 51 games he has logged a plate appearance and he has hits in 38 of those contests. He has separate 9-game (4/12-4/22) and 10-game (4/27-5/7) on-base streaks to his credit. Delgado extended his current on-base streak to eight games by singling twice yesterday. He became the first player to reach the 60-hit plateau in the FSL. He leads the league in hits and his .297 average is 6th in the circuit.

THE HOME STAND: The Fire Frogs play the Fort Myers Miracle (Advanced-A Twins) and the Palm Beach Cardinals (Advanced-A Cardinals) in consecutive three-game sets. Fort Myers handed the Fire Frogs their second home sweep of the year, joining Daytona who took all three games from Florida at the Pond from April 18th-20th. The Fire Frogs are 4-9 against the Cardinals at Osceola County Stadium. They won 22-2 over the Cardinals in the first matchup played here on April 25, 2017 but proceeded to go 1-4 at the Pond against the Cardinals affiliate the rest of the season. Palm Beach took 7 of 12 from Florida last year, including a season-series clinching 16-10 win on August 8.

He missed all of 2018 due to injury... Pitched 6 games (4 starts) with the Fire Frogs in 2017: 0-1, 3.08 ERA, 26.1 IP, 21 H, 9 ER, HR, HB, 9 BB, 21 K, .228 BAA. This will be his first appearance against Palm Beach in his career. ALL-STAR FROGS: The Florida State League announced last week that Four Fire Frogs had earned bids to play in this year's 58th FSL All-Star Game at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium in Jupiter on June 15th. William Contreras, Brandon White, Hayden Deal, and Riley Unroe were all worthy candidates to make the team. With Unroe being promoted two weeks ago to AA-Mississippi, it was announced that Riley Delgado would replace him on the team. The Fire Frogs have five total selections, four All-Stars participating in the game, one more than a year ago.
