WEDNESDAY: The Daytona Tortugas used a three-run fifth inning to get by the Fire Frogs, 5-4, at the Jack. The Tortugas jumped in front with two two-out runs (compiling three for the game) early before Trey Harris smacked his second homer in as many days to tie it in the fourth. Stuart Fairchild's RBI knock in the 5th was the difference. Riley Delgado notched an RBI groundout in the seventh and Harris swatted an RBI double to bring Florida within a run. LHP Philip Pfeifer took the loss, surrendering five earned runs over five innings. RHP Daysbel Hernandez, RHP Bradley Roney, and RHP Sean McLaughlin all contributed scoreless innings on the mound. Drew Lugbauer went 2-4, going 6-12 in the series in Daytona with multiple hits in every game.

DELGADO DIGS IN: The efficiency in which All-Star Riley Delgado has reached base is startling. He has gotten on in 56 of the 66 games he has logged a plate appearance and has hits in 49 of those games. He has separate 9-game (4/12-4/22) and 10-game (4/27-5/7) on-base streaks and was on a season-best 17 game streak going into the Dunedin series on June 11. Delly recorded his team-best 23rd multi-hit game yesterday, going 2-5 with an RBI and a run. Since breaking out of an 0x12 slump on Monday, Delgado has gone 7x12, raising his average from .289 to .302.

FROGS AND METS MEET: This is the final series the Fire Frogs and Mets will play this season, 11 of the meetings coming in the first half. These two teams played four games (31 innings) in just under 24 hours as part of consecutive doubleheaders played during the afternoon/evening of May 15 and the morning/afternoon of May 16. The Fire Frogs are 8-7 at the Pond against the Mets in Kissimmee with three cancellations combined over the previous two years.

HAMMERING HARRIS: The former 32nd Round selection out of Missouri became the third player this season to hit home runs in consecutive games with his two-run shot in the 4th yesterday, joining Gresyon Jenista (4/25-4/26 at STL) and Drew Lugbauer (6/17-6/18 at DBT). Harris also picked up his 7th multi-hit game and 3rd multi-RBI effort already as a member of the Fire Frogs in just 12 games. The SAL Mid-Season All-Star has combined to slash .366/.435/.589 with 10 HR, 51 RBI, 90 H, 17 2B, 4 3B, and 5 SB between Low-A Rome and Florida.

MIDSEASON MOVES: The Atlanta Braves announced a plethora of moves affecting the Fire Frogs roster on Wednesday, including the additions of Midseason All-Star C Logan Brown, INF Derian Cruz, and OF Andrew Moritz earning their first call to Advanced-A from Low-A Rome. RHP Troy Bacon was returned from Danville where he was for the past two-and-a-half weeks. RHP Bradley Roney was moved to Double-A for the first time since undergoing surgery in 2017 to repair right shoulder impingement syndrome. C Ruster Estrada was placed on the 7-day Injured List. OF Izzy Wilson was released from the organization, ending his five-year tenure as a Braves farmhand. In 299 career MiLB games, Izzy hit .222 with 28 home runs and 107 RBIs. He was averaging .177 over 45 games this season.
