TREMENDOUS THURSDAY: A hot start from the Fire Frogs, scoring four times over the first two innings led them to a 4-2 triumph over the St. Lucie Mets in the set opener. Jeremy Vasquez had the first of his two RBI singles to get the Mets on the board first in the first. However, Trey Harris nailed a 403-foot solo homer to left off LHP Kevin Smith to tie it. Logan Brown and Andrew Moritz picked up their first Advanced-A knocks in the second as part of a three-run frame. RBI hits from Jordan Rodgers, Moritz, and a double from Riley Delgado capped the frame. The Fire Frogs left just four on base and went 3-6 with men in scoring position.

DELGADO DIGS IN: The efficiency in which All-Star Riley Delgado has reached base is startling. He has gotten on in 57 of the 67 games he has logged a plate appearance and has hits in 50 of those games. He has seperate 9-game (4/12-4/22) and 10-game (4/27-5/7) on-base streaks and was on a season-best 17-game streak going into the Dunedin series on June 11. Delly recorded his team-best 24th multi-hit game yesterday, going 2-4 with a double and a RBI. Since breaking out of an 0x12 slump on Monday, Delgado has gone 8x15, raising his average from .289 to .305.

FROGS AND METS MEET: This is the final series the Fire Frogs and Mets will play this season, 11 of the meetings coming in the first half. These two teams played four games (31 innings) in just under 24 hours as part of consecutive doubleheaders played during the afternoon/evening of May 15 and the morning/afternoon of May 16. The Fire Frogs are 9-7 at the Pond against the Mets in Kissimmee with three cancellations combined over the previous two years.

HAMMERING HARRIS: The former 32nd Round selection out of Missouri became the first Florida player this season to hit home runs in three-consecutive games with his solo shot in the 1st yesterday. Harris has hits in 9 of his first 13 games at Advanced-A. The SAL Mid-Season All-Star has combined to slash .364/.433/.596 with 11 HR, 52 RBI, 91 H, 17 2B, 4 3B, and 5 SB between Low-A Rome and Florida. He ensured that the Fire Frogs hit a long ball in their fourth straight game after going homer-less over the previous 11 games dating back to June 2nd.

MIDSEASON MOVES: The Atlanta Braves announced a pleathora of moves affecting the Fire Frogs roster on Wednesday, including the additions of Midseason All-Star C Logan Brown, INF Derian Cruz, and OF Andrew Moritz earning their first call to Advanced-A from Low-A Rome. RHP Troy Bacon was returned from Danville where he was for the past two-and-a-half weeks. RHP Bradley Roney was moved to Double-A for the first time since undergoing surgery in 2017 to repair right shoulder impingement syndrome. C Ruster Estrada was placed on the 7-day Injured List. OF Izzy Wilson was released from the organization, ending his five-year tenure as a Braves farmhand. In 299 career MiLB games, Izzy hit .222 with 28 home runs and 107 RBIs. He was averaging .177 over 45 games this season.

Last Start: Deal was not able to return on June 9th at Tampa after a 32-minute rain delay that halted play in the second inning of an eventual 5-0 setback to the Tarpons. L, IP, H, 2 ER, HR (to Dermis Garcia), BB, 2 K, PC: 22/16 strikes. This halted his stretch where he threw five-straight quality starts and went 6 innings or more in all of them.

With his performance, he was named Rome's Pitcher of the Year by the Braves organization...
