LA NOCHE DEL RENNIE: The St. Lucie Mets got a spectacular performance once again out of RHP Luc Rennie in a 5-1 win over the Coquis on Friday evening. The right-hander surrendered eight hits, but just one run and one walk over 6.1 frames. LHP Hayden Deal came up an out short of a quality start for the Fire Frogs, scattering ten hits and three runs over 5.2 stanzas. RHP Brooks Wilson got four outs out of the pen but allowed two runs. All-Star RHP Brandon White notched another scoreless outing, throwing two shutout innings. Andrew Moritz swatted 3-4 with and RBI double in the fifth. Jacob Zanon went off for the Mets, knocking a solo homer in the first and then a critical two-run bad hop single over the head of Brett Langhorne at second that ended up being the difference.

DELGADO DIGS IN: The efficiency in which All-Star Riley Delgado has reached base is startling. He has gotten on in 57 of the 68 games he has logged a plate appearance and has hits in 50 of those games. He has seperate 9-game (4/12-4/22) and 10-game (4/27-5/7) on-base streaks and was on a season-best 17-game streak going into the Dunedin series on June 11. Delly went 0x4 at the plate yesterday, but since breaking out of an 0x12 slump on Monday, Delgado has still gone 8x19, raising his average from .289 to .300.

FROGS AND METS MEET: This is the final series the Fire Frogs and Mets will play this season, 11 of the meetings coming in the first half. These two teams played four games (31 innings) in just under 24 hours as part of consecutive doubleheaders played during the afternoon/evening of May 15 and the morning/afternoon of May 16. The Fire Frogs are 9-8 at the Pond against the Mets in Kissimmee with three cancellations combined over the previous two years.

HAMMERING HARRIS: The former 32nd Round selection out of Missouri became the first Florida player this season to hit home runs in three-consecutive games with his solo shot in the 1st on Thursday. Harris notched an infield single yesterday to extend his current hitting streak to 4 and his on-base streak to 6. He has hits in 10 of his first 14 games at Advanced-A. The SAL Mid-Season All-Star has combined to slash .362/.430/.591 with 11 HR, 52 RBI, 92 H, 17 2B, 4 3B, and 5 SB between Low-A Rome and Florida.

OPPOSING STARTER: RHP Kyle Wilson is ready to make his fourth start of the season against the Fire Frogs. He is 0-3 with a 10.32 ERA (13 ER in 11.1 IP) and has not pitched over four frames this season in a start against Florida. His last time out against Lakeland on June 17, he tossed his fourth quality start of the season: W, 6 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 0 ER, BB, 4 K, PC: 81/56 strikes. He hasn't allowed an earned run in his last 15.2 IP (3 starts). He was drafted in the 35th Round by the Mets in the 2017 Draft from Crowder College in Missouri. He was also selected in the 19th Round by the Twins out of Raymore Peculiar HS in Missouri. He was originally born in Canton, OH.

MIDSEASON MOVES: The Atlanta Braves announced a pleathora of moves affecting the Fire Frogs roster on Wednesday, including the additions of Midseason All-Star C Logan Brown, INF Derian Cruz, and OF Andrew Moritz earning their first call to Advanced-A from Low-A Rome. RHP Troy Bacon was returned from Danville where he was for the past two-and-a-half weeks. RHP Bradley Roney was moved to Double-A for the first time since undergoing surgery in 2017 to repair right shoulder impingement syndrome. C Ruster Estrada was placed on the 7-day Injured List. OF Izzy Wilson was released from the organization, ending his five-year tenure as a Braves farmhand. In 299 career MiLB games, Izzy hit .222 with 28 home runs and 107 RBIs. He was averaging .177 over 45 games this season.
