HARTMAN HEARTBROKEN: The Fire Frogs spoiled a great start by RHP Matt Hartman in a 6-4 loss to the St. Lucie Mets on Saturday evening. The Frogs led 2-0 going into the Top of the 7th with Hartman shutting out the Mets through 22 batters faced. He walked two before exiting in the frame, and then the Mets went on to score four times and added two in the eighth. Kevin Josephina had an RBI double in the third. Derian Cruz drew a bases loaded walk in his Advanced-A debut in the 5th to make it 2-0. The teams combined to throw 17 walks, with the Fire Frogs staff matching their season-high for the fifth time with 8. The Fire Frogs offense drew nine walks for the first time, besting the eight they drew in a win at Fort Myers on June 4.

DELGADO DIGS IN: The efficiency in which All-Star Riley Delgado has reached base is startling. He has gotten on in 58 of the 69 games he has logged a plate appearance and has hits in 51 of those games. He has separate 9-game (4/12-4/22) and 10-game (4/27-5/7) on-base streaks and was on a season-best 17-game streak going into the Dunedin series on June 11. Delly went 2x4 at the plate yesterday to notch his team-high 25th multi-hit effort. Since breaking out of an 0x12 slump on Monday, Delgado has still gone 10x23, raising his average from .289 to .303 which is second in the circuit.

FROGS AND METS MEET: This is the final series the Fire Frogs and Mets will play this season, 11 of the meetings coming in the first half. These two teams played four games (31 innings) in just under 24 hours as part of consecutive doubleheaders played during the afternoon/evening of May 15 and the morning/afternoon of May 16. The Fire Frogs are 9-9 at the Pond against the Mets in Kissimmee with three cancellations combined over the previous two years.

HAMMERING HARRIS: The former 32nd Round selection out of Missouri became the first Florida player this season to hit home runs in three consecutive games with his solo shot in the 1st on Thursday. Harris went 0x1 yesterday but drew two walks to move his on-base streak to 7. He has hits in 10 of his first 15 games at Advanced-A. The SAL Mid-Season All-Star has combined to slash .359/.431/.586 with 11 HR, 52 RBI, 92 H, 17 2B, 4 3B, and 5 SB between Low-A Rome and Florida.

OPPOSING STARTER: RHP Dedniel Nunez is ready to make his second start of the season against the Fire Frogs. He pitched four innings on May 15 at the Pond, receiving a no decision while allowing three hits, two earned runs, four walks and seven Ks. His last time out against Lakeland on June 18: ND, 5 IP, 4 H, 1 ER, 2 BB, 5 K, PC: 81/52 strikes. He is 0-2 with a 7.13 ERA over his last 4 starts, surrendering 14 ER in 17.2 IP. He was signed as an undrafted free agent by the Mets on October 21, 2016.

MIDSEASON MOVES: The Atlanta Braves announced a plethora of moves affecting the Fire Frogs roster on Wednesday, including the additions of Midseason All-Star C Logan Brown, INF Derian Cruz, and OF Andrew Moritz earning their first call to Advanced-A from Low-A Rome. RHP Troy Bacon was returned from Danville where he was for the past two-and-a-half weeks. RHP Bradley Roney was moved to Double-A for the first time since undergoing surgery in 2017 to repair right shoulder impingement syndrome. C Ruster Estrada was placed on the 7-day Injured List. OF Izzy Wilson was released from the organization, ending his five-year tenure as a Braves farmhand. In 299 career MiLB games, Izzy hit .222 with 28 home runs and 107 RBIs. He was averaging .177 over 45 games this season.

Today's Start: This will be the 12th Advanced-A start for Kingham. It will be his 26th career game and 18th start. His second appearance in his career against STL - 4/25 in Port St. Lucie: 2nd Advanced-A start, 5.2 IP, season-high 10 H against, 4 ER, HB, 2 BB, 3 K, PC: 92/59 strikes. It was the first time in his career he exceeded the 90-pitch mark.

Last Start: He threw his third complete game shutout of the season, bringing him even with Juan Pablo Oramas of the Mexican League who also has three complete games. He gave up just three hits, hit a batter, walked one, fanned seven (second-most this year) on Tuesday (6/18) at Daytona. He threw 91 pitches, 66 of which were for strikes.

Youth and Community Studies major at Texas... Reliever only back in his freshman year at Texas but was elevated to a starter during his sophomore season... 8-5 record with a 4.57 ERA and 3 saves during his Junior (final) year with the Longhorns: 81 K, 24 BB, 62 R, 51 ER in 100.1 IP... Three year starter and he pitched and played shortstop and first base at Desert Oasis HS in Las Vegas. He had his scoreless innings streak snapped at 19 in the 4th of his 5/15 start vs. St. Lucie. He then went on to allow 22 R (19 ER) over his previous 3 outings until he blanked Palm Beach on 5/31, bookending May with CG shutouts.
