Fire Frogs Recap (All-Time)


LAST TIME OUT: TARPONS STEAL LATE TALLY IN 4-3 TRIUMPH: The Florida Fire Frogs climbed out of an early $3-0$ hole, but the Tarpons turned to Pablo Olivares whose prowess on the base paths guided Tampa to a $4-3$ win and a series victory on Wednesday evening at Osceola County Stadium. He stole two bases in the eighth and scored on a Logan Brown errant throw to give Tampa the lead. Olivares began his 2-4 night by doubling in the first against RHP Walter Borkovich to start Tampa's most productive offensive inning. He was plated by an Alexander Palma knock. Three consecutive hits from Diego Castillo, Wilkerman Garcia, and Steven Sensley brought in two more runs for a 3-0 lead after an inning. The Frogs answered with a run in the 2nd and two in the 4th to tie it. A fielder's choice from Garrison Schwartz scored Drew Lugbauer for the first run. Brown's base hit in the 4th brought it to within 3-2. A fielder's choice from Estrada tied it. Borkovich didn't factor in the decision, yielding six hits and three runs. RHP Troy Bacon and RHP Caleb Dirks threw two frames each, Dirks permitting an unearned run to take the loss. RHP Miguel Yajure didn't have a decision for Tampa, allowing three runs and six hits. RHP Jefry Valdez held the Fire Frogs off the board over the final three stanzas to snag the victory.

TORTURED BY TARPONS: The Fire Frogs continue their series against the Tarpons having lost seven one-run games this year and settling for a 2-12 mark. Florida is 5-13 against Tampa at the Pond since the beginning of 2017 (a campaign where they didn't beat the then Tampa Yankees) as opposed to 2-18 at Steinbrenner Field. A 6-1 win in Tampa on 6/29 stopped what was a nine-game winning streak for Tampa in the series. These teams haven't played in Kissimmee since May 3-5, when the Fire Frogs won the opener but dropped consecutive six-inning rain-shortened games to start the nine-game skid.

DELGADO DIVES ON: All-Star Riley Delgado has gotten on in 95 of the 122 games he has logged a plate appearance and has hits in 84 of those games. He has seperate 9 -game (4/12-4/22) and 10-game (4/27-5/7) on-base streaks and had a season-best 17-game streak that ended June 11. He holds the second longest away hitting streak in the FSL, recording at least a knock in 15 straight road contests dating back to May 23 at Dunedin and ending June 29 at Tampa: . 325 AVG, $15 \mathrm{RBI}, 7$ 2B, 3B, $10 \mathrm{R}, 6 \mathrm{BB}, 9 \mathrm{~K}, .358$ OBP. Delly still paces the circuit with 134 hits and is 2nd in the Braves organization trailing Drew Waters' 153 between Mississippi and Gwinnett. After hitting 223 in July, Delgado is swatting .259 through 21 August games. After a $6 \times 17$ Bradenton series, Delgado began the Clearwater series with a $5 \times 8$ effort at the dish on Saturday, picking up his 39th and 40th multi-hit efforts. Delly is currently in an $0 \times 13$ skid going back to Sunday in Clearwater.

STREAKING SCHWARTZ: Garrison Schwartz continues into the Tampa series having reached safely in 19 of his last 23 assignments dating back to game two of a $7 / 26$ with Daytona. He is hitting .266 ( $16 \times 60$ ) with 1 HR, $22 \mathrm{~B}, 8 \mathrm{RBls}, 7 \mathrm{BBs}$, and 21 Ks . Over his recent 7 -game on-base streak (since 8/14), he was $6 \times 18(.333)$ with $1 \mathrm{RBI}, 22 \mathrm{~B}, 3 \mathrm{BB}, 3 \mathrm{R}$, and 8 Ks. He was $4 \times 8$ in the Clearwater series alone. He has raised his season average with Florida from .218 to .239 over this 23-game stretch.

STARTING OFF RIGHT: Florida starting pitchers warmed up in July with three straight pitchers capping off the month with quality starts. Over a recent 18-game stretch, starters permitted just a 1.97 ERA (23 ER/105.0 IP) going back to game two of a Friday ( $7 / 26$ ) twin bill against Daytona. Taking this back further, 12 quality starts were fired over the previous 23 games and the pitchers have maintained a $2.38 \mathrm{ERA}(36 \mathrm{ER} / 136.1 \mathrm{IP})$. Combined with Wednesday's double header and the Thursday finale against Bradenton, the Fire Frogs staff had given up 12 ER in 15 innings, compiling a 7.20 ERA with one quality start. But, the Frogs rebounded with 30.1 innings thrown with four quality starts in their last five games, yielding a 2.37 ERA.

COMPLETE GAME KINGS: Florida fired its 10th complete game Saturday when Matt Hartman went the distance for the 2nd straight time. This total is 4 more than any other team in the MiLB, besting the Double-A Jackson Generals of the Southern League. The Cleveland Indians lead the MLB with five. The Fire Frogs also tossed their 16th shutout victory on Saturday in game two, a total that is T-9th in all of the MiLB. They are tied with the Mississippi Braves who also have 16.

Last Start: Broke out of a two-game skid with a win in GM 1 of 8/17 DH at Clearwater (Saturday): 6 IP, 5 H, 2 ER (Quality Start), 2 BB, 5 K, PC: 91/58. He is 2-2 with a 2.88 ERA in six starts (three quality) since returning from injury in mid-July: $34.1 \mathrm{IP}, 35 \mathrm{H}, 13 \mathrm{R}, 11 \mathrm{ER}, 2 \mathrm{HR}, 6$ BB, 31 K , has thrown 91 or more pitches over last four starts.

Notes: He played shortstop throughout his high school career and pitched the last two seasons. Prior to being drafted, went 12-1 with a 0.81 highschool ERA ( 9 ER/ 78 IP) across 22 games with Riverview HS. He started pitching because they needed some arms and they knew he threw pretty hard. Also hit for a .393 average with 11 doubles and 2 homers. His slot value was $\$ 709,000$, he signed to play with the Braves instead of attending D-II University of Tampa.
