#### GENERAL NOTES

**SERIES PRIMER:** The Generals host the Montgomery Biscuits (AA, Tampa Bay Rays) for the first time in 2019. The two North Division playoff entrants from 2018 will play only 18 games this season, with thirteen of them coming in the Second Half. The Generals were the only team to win four games against the Biscuits in the First Half, but Montgomery took home the North Division title to earn a playoff bid.

**LAST GAME:** Jackson, Tenn. – The Jackson Generals, the Double-A affiliate of Major League Baseball's Arizona Diamondbacks, used a first-inning surge to beat Montgomery 3-2 on Tuesday night, holding off the Biscuits to gain a 2-1 series lead. The win for the Generals (45-38) at The Ballpark at Jackson is their sixth against Montgomery (50-33) this season in eight meetings.

**TODAY'S PITCHING MATCHUP:** Since arriving in Jackson in 2017, **Joel Payamps** has had a few moments a brilliance, and one of them came last Thursday. Pitching the first half of a double-header, Payamps fired his second complete-game shutout as a General (and first since 2017), holding Mississippi to one hit with one walk while striking out nine batters over seven innings. Payamps will try to keep that roll going against Montgomery's **Kenny Rosenberg**, who has only lost once this season. Rosenberg took no decision in his previous outing against Jackson on May 25, allowing three runs on five hits while striking out eight men in five innings.

**MAN IN THE MOMENT:** With a two-out, three-run double in the first inning of July 2's game against Montgomery, **Jazz Chisholm** posted his team-leading 13<sup>th</sup> multi-RBI game of the year. Despite hitting just .189 on the year, Chisholm is batting .262 when the score is tied, one of the top 4 marks on the Jackson roster.

**PAVIN PACKING A PUNCH:** Jackson first baseman **Pavin Smith** led the team in hits (26) in June, batting .292 with 6 doubles, 5 RBI, and eight walks. Smith's five-RBI effort against Montgomery on July 1 was a career-high.

**MIGHTY MIGGY:** Lefty **Miguel Aguilar** continues to demonstrate his worth to the Generals bullpen, recording his seventh scoreless appearance in eight outings on July 1 against Montgomery. Aguilar's two-inning relief appearance against the Biscuits was his fourth appearance of more than an inning this year. In the Second Half, Aguilar has pitched in five games, with the Generals going 3-2; the two losses occurred once when Jackson was shutout and another time in a one-run defeat.

**A ROTATION THAT'S NOT:** Jackson has maintained an unusual streak with their pitching rotation. Since the final series in April against Pensacola, the Generals' five-man starting rotation has not been consistent in back-to-back series, a span of 12 series without the same five guys facing consecutive opponents in the same order.

**ALL-STAR ALUMNUS:** Former Generals infielder **Ketel Marte** won a three-way voting race this week over Ozzie Albies and Mike Moustakas to earn the starting nod at second base for the National League in the 2019 MLB All-Star Game. The D-backs' switch-hitter is the first former Jackson position player to earn an MLB ASG bid since Seattle third baseman **Kyle Seager** in 2014, and he joins former Mariners closer **Edwin Diaz** as the second ex-General in as many seasons to gain All-Star status. Marte is batting .320 through his first 79 games with 20 homers & 51 RBI.

**FUTURES GAMER:** Generals catcher **Daulton Varsho** was one of two D-backs prospects to earn a selection to the 2019 MLB Futures Game, joining Kane County outfielder **Alek Thomas** on the National League roster. The honor is the second to roll in for Varsho this season after his Midseason All-Star election in the Southern League. Last year, Jackson closer **Yoan Lopez** was Arizona's Futures Game pick.

<p><b>*Right-hander Matt Peacock</b>, when healthy, has a rare talent for keeping the ball on the ground. Using an excellent sinking fastball that he developed after being drafted, Peacock's groundball rate of 71.9% ranked second among all Minor League pitchers nationwide through June with at least 30 innings. There's an important difference between Peacock and most of the MLB groundball pitchers you know. Think of Yankees reliever Zack Britton, Rockies reliever Chad Bettis, Braves reliever Luke Jackson, Reds reliever Jared Hughes, and Cardinals starter Dakota Hudson: What do they all have in common? All of those pitchers were drafted in the first four rounds and received signing bonuses of \$300,000 or higher. Peacock was a 23<sup>rd</sup>-round pick in 2017. <b>(July 1)</b></p> <p><b>*The Generals' bullpen</b> has just five saves since Memorial Day, the lowest number in the Southern League. Part of that is due to poor overall performance, but the relief corps hasn't had a go-to reliever since Lucas Luetge was promoted in May. Smith won the entire month of June without hitting a home run, but his six doubles were as many as he hit in May. <b>(July 1)</b></p> <p><b>*Ben DeLuzio</b> is leading the Generals with a .361 on-base percentage, just as you would hope for a lead-off hitter. His 14 stolen bases are also a team high, though he has yet to steal multiple bases in a game, something he did nine times last year. <b>(July 1)</b></p> <p><b>*Daulton Varsho's</b> homer-and-steal day on 5/23 at Montgomery marked the fifth time in his career he's homered and stolen a base in one game, having accomplished the feat twice in 2018 &amp; twice previously this year. Only four MLB catchers have ever recorded a HR-and-SB game 4+ times in a single season: Russell Martin (4, 2008), Carlton Fisk (4, 1983), Sandy Alomar (4, 1994), and Ivan Rodriguez (5, 1999). <b>(May 23)</b></p>
