Jackson Generals (78-57, North Division Series Champ) vs. Biloxi Shuckers (82-57, South Division Series Champ)

GENERAL NOTES

SERIES PRIMER: For the second year in a row, the Generals and Shuckers will square off with the Southern League title on the line. Jackson won last year's series, 3-1, by winning three straight games after being shut out in the opener. Two of Jackson's wins came on the road in that series (in games 3 and 4). The Generals and Shuckers played ten times in the 2019 regular season, with Jackson winning 7 of 10 meetings, including three on the road in July and four at home in June. Jackson won the North Division Series over Montgomery, three games to one, earning an extra day of rest before the SLCS, Biloxi won the South Division Series over Pensacola, three games to two, with help from a five-run outburst in the eighth inning of a Game 5 win, 8-4.

LAST GAME: Jackson, Tenn. - The Jackson Generals, the Double-A affiliate of Major League Baseball's Arizona Diamondbacks, fell behind early on Saturday and couldn't recover, stifled offensively in a 4-2 Biloxi Shuckers win at The Ballpark at Jackson. The Generals (2-2) and Shuckers (2-2) will meet on Sunday night at 6:05 p.m. in a decisive Game 5 to determine the winner of the 2019 BC Powder ® Southern League Championship Series. TODAY'S MATCHUP: This is it: no holds barred, for all the marbles, and all the other clichés. Emilio Vargas was the starting pitcher in last year's title-clinching game for the Generals, and he started in Game 4 of the North Division Series against Montgomery last Saturday (6.0 IP, 3 ER). Vargas threw five shutout frames against Biloxi during the regular season, and righties hit just .195 against him on the year. On Biloxi's side, **Drew Rasmussen** is in his first full pro season, pitching to a 3.54 ERA in 22 regular season appearances. He pitched poorly against Pensacola in the South Division Series (1.2 IP, 2 ER), and he's had mixed results against the Generals this year (2 games, 4.91 ERA, 3 2/3 IP). The Generals used three relievers last night, including two who threw more than 20 pitches and are likely unavailable tonight (**Junior Garcia and Cole Stapler**); by contrast, Biloxi used four relievers, with only two of them throwing 20+ pitches (**Tyler Spurlin and Daniel Brown**).

WHAT IT WOULD MEAN: If Jackson were to win, the Generals would become the third Southern League team since 2000 to win back-to-back championships, following the '06-'07 Montgomery Biscuits and the '11-'12 Mobile BayBears. The Generals would earn their fourth franchise title overall and second as an Arizona Diamondbacks affiliate; it would also be the first Southern League title for manager **Blake Lalli**, who made three SLCS appearances as a player with the Tennessee Smokies ('09-'11) without winning a ring. The Generals would become the third D-backs affiliate to win a title this year, joining the Visalia Rawhide of the California League (who snapped a championship drought of 40 years last night), and the Hillsboro Hops of the Northwest League who won earlier this week with 2018 Generals personnel Javier Colina and Barry Enright leading their coaching staff). Biloxi is seeking their first title in franchise history.

QUICK TURNAROUND: After starting the playoffs 9-for-72 (.125 BA), the top third of the Generals' batting order – Ben DeLuzio, Daulton Varsho, and Pavin Smith – have gone 9-for-24 (.375 BA), accounting for six runs scored and six RBI across Games 3 and 4 of the SLCS and their final at-bats in Game 2.

YOU FOUND MORE BEER? WHERE?: It's taken time for Seth Beer to get comfortable, but the Generals' first baseman seems to have found his stroke in the SLCS. He put together back-to-back multi-hit showings in Game 1 and 2 against Biloxi, and he leads Jackson this series in batting average (.429) entering Game 5.

MCCANNA CAN: Generals reliever Kevin McCanna appeared in Games 1, 2, and 3 in the LCS for the Generals without allowing an earned run, throwing 40 pitches over the course of Games 1 & 2 in two innings of work. No other Southern League reliever has appeared as often as McCanna in the postseason (5 times), and he and Miguel Aguilar are the only two Generals on Jackson's staff with multiple appearances and a 0.00 ERA.

N.D.S. STANDOUTS: Third baseman **Drew Ellis** finished the four-game North Division Series with team-highs in total bases (19), hits (7), and RBI (7), going 2-for-5 in the series-clinching Game 4. Ellis led the league with a whopping 1.659 OPS over 16 at-bats. On the hill, Jackson's **Kevin McCanna** appeared twice without allowing a run, a hit, or a walk to any of the eight men he faced. West Tunnell pitched on back-to-back days, closing out Game 3 and Game 4 wins for Jackson on 15 pitches and 26 pitches. Starters Bo Takahashi and Matt Peacock combined to throw 13 innings with just one run allowed and a 1.00 WHIP.

BEST IN THE COUNTRY: Generals right-handed pitchers Matt Peacock and Josh Green finished the regular season with groundball rates of 67.6% and 66.6%, respectively. According to FanGraphs.com, those are the two highest groundball rates of any MILB pitchers with at least 40 innings pitched in 2019. Green also led the nation with 25 groundball double plays, while Peacock lead the Southern League with 186 groundouts

PLAYER(S) OF THE MONTH: Catcher Daulton Varsho was named Southern League Player of the Month for August after leading the league in batting average (.391), OPS (1.143), runs (26), and total bases (65). Varsho is the second straight General to win a player of the month honor from the Southern League, joining July winner Pavin Smith. In addition, Seth Beer won Texas League POTM for July after being traded to Jackson

AND THE WINNERS ARE: Three Generals earned SL Postseason All-Star honors:

>>OF Pavin Smith (123 G) ranked among the league's top 10 in ten different categories: batting average (.291), OPS (.836), hits (128), extra-base hits (47), total bases (205), doubles (29), triples (6), RBI (67), walks (59), and runs (62). He also batted .329 in the Second Half and .360 in August.

Smith was the D-backs' first pick in the 2017 MLB Draft, going 7th overall.

>3B Drew Ellis (118 G) topped the circuit with 63 walks and ranked in the top 15 in the league for walks, RBI (63), HR (14), OBP (.344), and doubles (23). Ellis batted .273 in August, and he also played solid defense at third base, helping turn 27 double plays with a .960 fielding percentage on the year.

Ellis was the D-backs' second pick in the 2017 MLB Draft, qoing 44th overall.

>>C Daulton Varsho (108 G) led the SL in runs (85) and OPS (.898) while playing a premier defensive spot.

He also hit 18 homers & earned 21 stolen bases, batting .344 in the Second Half and .391 in August. He also caught a Jackson pitching staff that threw the fewest wild pitches in the league (56). Varsho was the D-backs' third pick in the 2017 MLB Draft, going 68th overall

MORE GENERAL NOTES

Pitching *Right-handers Matt Peacock and Josh Green are the best groundball pitchers in Minor League Baseball – that's a fact. They rank 1st (Peacock, 67.3%) and 2nd (Green, 66.6%) in groundball rate among all MILB pitchers with at least 70 innings thrown, per FanGraphs.com. Why that matters: 1) They're relatively low-cost investments for the Diamondbacks. Green was drafted in the 14th round, while Peacock was taken in the 23rd round. 2) Even after a humidor was installed at Chase Field, it's still an offense-

- friendly park: ESPN.com's Park Factor rating ranked Chase Field as MLB's 11thmost run-friendly stadium last season. (It ranked 3rd in 2017.) Additionally, the D-backs play at Colorado's Coors Field a lot, the most run-friendly park. 3) The Diamondbacks have ranked in the top 2 teams in baseball in each of the last 2 years in groundout-to-air-out ratio, outdone only by Colorado. That doesn't seem accidental, given the physical tendencies of their home environment (and the division). (August 28)
- *As the Generals prep for the playoffs, the best late-game options are: >>Right-hander **West Tunnell**, whose fastball-slider combination helped him save 13 games at High-A this year. He's saved 6 games for Jackson.
- Tunnell's last 10 games thru 9/2: 0-1, 0.82 ERA, 5 saves >>Southpaw Miguel Aguilar, the sneakiest fireman in the league. He's quietly compiled a league-high in saves & holds (13) since June 1. Aguilar's last 10, thru 9/2: 0-0, 1.86 ERA, 5 saves (Sept. 2)

- *Bowden Francis led all qualified SL pitchers in swinging strike rate (13.2%). He also allowed almost one homer per nine innings (0.98), while Matt **Peacock** (0.39) was on the far end of that spectrum.
- *Only Montgomery's Josh Fleming had a better strikeout-to-walk ratio (4.84) than Alec Bettinger (4.49).

Hitting

- *Daulton Varsho's homer-and-steal day on 8/2 against Mobile marked the sixth time in his career he's homered and stolen a base in one game, having accomplished the feat twice in 2018 & three times previously this year. Only four MLB catchers have ever recorded a HR-and-SB game 4+ times in a single season: Russell Martin (4, 2008), Carlton Fisk (4, 1983), Sandy Alomar (4, 1994), and Ivan Rodriguez (5, 1999). (August 2)
- *Seth Beer won July Player of the Month in the Texas League with Corpus Christi, leading all Double-A hitters with 24 runs scored, 63 total bases, and 9 home runs, and a 1.125 OPS before being 1 of 4 prospects swapped for Zack Greinke. (August 8)
