#### General Notes

**This Series |** The Jackson Generals (Double-A, Arizona Diamondbacks) visit the Montgomery Biscuits (Tampa Bay Rays) at Riverwalk Stadium for the first time in 2018, meeting for the second time overall in the First Half. The Generals and Biscuits face each other 20 total times this season, with ten games in each half. The Generals dropped an early May series to Montgomery, 3-2. **SEASON SERIES:** AT JACKSON: 5/2-5/6, 8/14-8/18 AT MONTGOMERY: 5/29-6/2, 7/28-8/1

**About Last Game | MONTGOMERY, ALA.** - Despite another power surge by Jamie Westbrook and a strong opening effort at Double-A from Bo Takahashi, the Jackson Generals fell 5-4 on Wednesday to the Montgomery Biscuits. The Generals' loss assures that they will finish the month of May with a sub-.500 winning percentage, but they remain just 1.5 games out of first place in the Southern League's North Division.

Takahashi, the 21-year-old Brazilian right-hander, made his first-ever Double-A start with some growing pains, but he pitched into the sixth inning nonetheless. After putting the first two hitters on base with a hit batsman and a walk, Takahashi allowed only two runs through his first five frames of work. He struck out nine and walked only two, departing the sixth inning with two outs and two men on base. Bud Jeter was not able to strand those men, allowing a two-run single that gave Montgomery a 4-1 advantage. Still, the Generals fought back to tie the game at 4-4 entering the bottom of the eighth, but a Nick Solak home run off Yoan Lopez in the bottom half of the inning ended up being the difference in a one-run decision.

The team lead in home runs remains a toss-up between Jamie Westbrook and Rudy Flores, each of whom homered for the ninth time this season in Wednesday's game. Jackson's offense also got a two-hit night from Domingo Leyba (including a double), but they were held to just five hits overall on the evening. After stealing 13 bases in their past six games, the Generals were held without a swiped base for the first time since May 21 at Pensacola. They are now 3-4 against Montgomery this year.

 After starting 15-2, Jackson went 14-20, losing 5 of their next 6 series. Their scoring average fell from 5.6 (April) to 4.6 (May). If Jackson fielded a starting nine solely from their DL (as of May 31), they would bat .302 with a 1.72 ERA and .145 BAA.

**Get to Know Bo |** Pitcher Bo Takahashi joined the Generals on May 29 following the promotion of starter Alex Young to Triple-A Reno. The Brazilian-born 21-year-old was the D-backs' Minor League Pitcher of the Month in April at High-A Visalia, where he went 3-0 with a 1.73 ERA. **GET TO KNOW BO (at Jackson): 0-0, 6.35 ERA, 5.2 IP, 9 K, 1.06 WHIP**

**Leyba Let Loose |** On May 19, the D-backs activated infielder DOMINGO LEYBA from Jackson DL, and the 22-year-old prospect went right to work. In his 2018 debut vs. Pensacola, Leyba cracked an RBI double in his third at-bat off MLB rehabber Anthony DeSclafani and drove in a run, picking up a second hit later and stealing two bases. Leyba ranks among the D-backs' top dozen prospects according to Baseball America (No. 12) and MLBPipeline.com (No. 6), but he played only 23 games in 2017 due to injury. Leyba split 130 games between High-A Visalia & Double-A Mobile in 2016 with a .784 OPS. **"HOW IS DOMINGO DOING?": 37 AB, 0 HR, 3 RBI, 3 SB, .898 OPS**

**Pitchers of the Weeks |** Generals right-handers TAYLOR WIDENER and JON DUPLANTIER were each named Pitcher of the Week by the Southern League in back-to-back weeks (May 21 & May 29). The dynamic duo has combined for 23.2 IP in their last four starts, striking out 28 batters while allowing 4 earned runs. Both will skip starts for rest in late May.
