SERIES PRIMER: The Generals visit the Mississippi Braves (AA, Atlanta Braves) for the first and only time in 2019, playing a five-game series at Trustmark Park. The two teams will meet in 15 games over three separate series in 2019, with 10 of those games happening in the Second Half.

LAST GAME: Pearl, Miss. – The Jackson Generals, the Double-A affiliate of Major League Baseball's Arizona Diamondbacks, halved a double-header against the Mississippi Braves on Thursday, winning the first game at Trustmark Park in a shutout before being held to one run in the second game. Jackson (42-36) still trails Mississippi (38-39) in the series, 2-1, at night's end.

TODAY'S PITCHING MATCHUP: In search of a series-equalizing win, Jackson will throw Bo Takahashi on Friday against talented Mississippi right-hander Ian Anderson. Both players earned 2019 Southern League Midseason All-Star acclaim. Takahashi's previous start against the M-Braves was shortened due to rain, and in the three innings he worked, he allowed 4 earned runs. Anderson's previous start against the Generals was a nail-biter, with Jackson falling 2-1 in a seven-inning contest where Anderson allowed one run on five hits.

ANOTHER ONE TAKES THE BUS: On Thursday, former General **Alex Young** made his major league debut, throwing five innings against the San Francisco Giants to help the D-backs to a 5-1 victory at Oracle Park. Young, who pitched at Jackson in 2017 & 2018, is the third General of the Diamondbacks era to debut in Major League Baseball this month, and the eighth to make his debut this season.

A ROTATION THAT'S NOT: Due to weather impacting the Generals' series opener at Mississippi, Jackson has maintained an unusual streak with their pitching rotation. Since the final series in April against Pensacola, the Generals' five-man starting rotation has not been consistent in back-to-back series, a span of 11 series without the same five players rotating in the same order against consecutive opponents.

JAZZ TRYING TO LEAVE FUNK BEHIND: Shortstop Jazz Chisholm whacked a season-high 3 hits on June 23 at Mobile, his third multi-hit game of the Second Half. In 59 First Half Games, Chisholm only registered 7 multi-hit games while batting a humbling .173. If Chisholm can put up a Second Half that more closely resembles his career batting average of .251, there's no telling what the Generals' ceiling will be.

DV, JAZZ, AND JEFF: In the week since the Southern League's All-Star Break, Jackson's leading hitters have been **Daulton Varsho, Jazz Chisholm, and Jeffrey Baez**. The resurgence of Baez's bat has been particularly useful, considering he batted .220 in May and started June with a 7-for-44 slump (.159 BA).

ROCKY RELIEF: After losing lefty **Lucas Luetge** to Triple-A on May 30, the Generals' relief corps has looked thinner. Luetge was promoted after appearing in a league-high 22 games with a 1.08 ERA and 20 scoreless appearances. Since Luetge's exit, 20 of Jackson's last 57 calls to the 'pen have resulted in runs allowed.

*Right-hander Matt Peacock, when healthy, has a rare
talent for keeping the ball on the ground. Using an
excellent sinking fastball that he developed after being
drafted, Peacock's groundball rate of 75% ranks second
among all Minor League pitchers nationwide (through June
20) with at least 30 innings. There are currently only a
handful of other pitchers in the pro ranks throwing with
the groundball success that Peacock has enjoyed: Yankees
reliever Zack Britton (77%), Pensacola lefty Sam Clay
(76% GB, AA), Rockies reliever Chad Bettis (68%, MLB),
Braves reliever Luke Jackson (68%, MLB), former General
and current Orioles reliever Paul Fry (64%), Cardinals
starter Dakota Hudson (61%, MLB). Except for Fry, a 17 th
round pick, all of those pitchers were drafted in the first
four rounds and received signing bonuses of \$400,000 or
higher. Peacock was a 23 rd -round pick in 2017. (June 21)

*The **Jackson bullpen** ERA stands at 3.82, the fourth-worst mark in the SL. However, when you measure how many relief appearances their relievers have made against how many runs they've allowed, they look much better. Jackson ranks 3rd with 1.77 relief appearances per run, meaning the Generals have rostered a higher number of reliable relievers over the course of the First Half than 7 other teams in the league. (The worst mark is Tennessee, at 1.34.) **(June 21)**

- *Daulton Varsho's homer-and-steal day on 5/23 at Montgomery marked the fifth time in his career he's homered and stolen a base in one game, having accomplished the feat twice in 2018 & twice previously this year. Only four MLB catchers have ever recorded a HR-and-SB game 4+ times in a single season: Russell Martin (4, 2008), Carlton Fisk (4, 1983), Sandy Alomar (4, 1994), and Ivan Rodriguez (5, 1999). (May 23)
- *If you're looking for guys who won't swing their way out of an at-bat, look at **Daulton Varsho** and **Pavin Smith**. Both feature swinging strike rates below 8%, top 10 marks in the league. (**June 21**)
- *Jeffrey Baez and Ben DeLuzio will have to find ways to survive defensive shifts if they continue to pull the ball more than 50% of the time. (Currently, they rank 5th & 8th in the league in pull percentage; only 11 SL players hold 50% pull rates or higher.) Both are faster right-handed hitters and can leg out the occasional infield hit, but life figures to get harder if they don't adjust to the defense. (June 21)
