GENERAL NOTES

SERIES PRIMER: The Generals host the Tennessee Smokies (AA, Chicago Cubs) for the second and final time in 2019. This is the only time these teams have met in the Second Half, their first series in three months. The Smokies have been eliminated from playoff contention; the Generals are 4 V_2 games behind Montgomery in the Second Half divisional race, and they lead Birmingham in the overall record race by 13 V_2 games with 15 games remaining (through August 17). **CHC Top-30 Prospects at TNS (with rank):** IF Nico Hoerner (#1), SS Zack Short (#9), RHP Cory Abbott (#16), RHP Oscar De La Cruz (#22), RHP Erich Uelmen (#24)

LAST GAME: Jackson, Tenn. – The Jackson Generals, the Double-A affiliate of Major League Baseball's Arizona Diamondbacks, saw their game against the Tennessee Smokies on Tuesday suspended due to inclement weather at The Ballpark at Jackson. The game was suspended in a scoreless tie after three innings of play, and it will be resumed as part of a double-header on Wednesday, August 21 at 5:05pm CT. **Full Recap: JacksonGeneralsBaseball.com**

TODAY'S PITCHERS: Right-hander **Cole Stapler** will throw in the resumed game for Jackson, while **Michael Rucker** works for Tennessee. Both Rucker and Stapler have previously been a part of their teams' starting rotations, but neither has worked more than two innings in their last two outings. For the nightcap, **Jeff Bain** will represent the Generals, while **Erich Uelmen** takes the ball for the Smokies. Both were 2017 draft picks out of California schools (Cal Poly Pomona, and Cal Poly San Luis Obispo); between them, they are winless over four combined Southern League starts this year, both new to the level.

PLAYOFF WATCH: The Generals have the inside track to earning the second playoff spot for the North Division, with Montgomery having already qualified for a berth after winning the North Division in the First Half. Here's the deal:

>>Runners-Up For Sure: Entering August 20, the Generals' overall record (71-53) was 14.5 games ahead of Birmingham (56-67) with 13 games to go, ensuring that the Barons would not overtake Jackson for the second-best overall record in the North Division in 2019.

>>Magic Number Falling: Birmingham's only path to a playoff berth—which would keep the Generals out of the playoffs—is to win the Second Half North Division title. Entering August 21, the Barons' magic number is 4 – that's the combined number of Barons losses and Montgomery wins going forward that would officially eliminate the Barons from the playoff race. If that number falls to 0 --- which could happen as soon as Thursday night, August 22, but is not guaranteed --- Jackson will be assured of a playoff spot. As season-long divisional

runners up, the Generals would host only 1 guaranteed playoff game, Game 3 of the North Division Series, with Montgomery hosting the other four games. Game 3 would happen on Friday, September 6 at 6:05pm at The Ballpark at Jackson.

>>The "But What If We Get Hot?" Option: Jackson still has a chance to host 3 games in the North Division Series, but it's small. Entering August 21, the Generals are 5.0 games behind Montgomery in the Second Half, with 13 games to go. If the Generals win enough games to overtake the Biscuits in the Second Half standings, they would earn the right to host Games 3, 4, and 5 of the North Division Series at The Ballpark at Jackson on September

6, 7, and 8 at 6:05pm. Games 4 and 5 would be necessary if neither side sweeps Games 1-3.

AND THE NOMINEES ARE: As voting time nears for the Southern League's Postseason All-Stars, the Generals have some strong cases for inclusion (August 21):

>>C Daulton Varsho (99 G) leads the SL in runs (75) and OPS (.884) while playing a premier defensive position. He also has 16 homers and 20 stolen bases, and he leads the league since the All-Star Break in batting average (.338).

>>**1B/OF Pavin Smith (113 G)** ranks among the league's top 10 in batting average (.287), hits (117), total bases (185), doubles (26), triples (6), RBI (59), walks (54), and OPS (.819). He leads the league in batting average since June 1 (.329).

>>**3B Drew Ellis (111 G)** tops the circuit with 60 walks and is the only player in the top 10 in the league for walks, RBI (60), and runs scored (56). He's also sixth in doubles (23).

>>RHP Matt Peacock (18 G) ranks in the league's top 10 in ERA (2.74), wins (8), complete games (2), WHIP (1.20), and opponent batting average (.231). Peacock also leads the league in total groundouts (172, through 105.0 IP) and groundball double-plays induced (20) while leading all of MILB in groundball rate (67.9%).

>>LHP Miguel Aguilar (25 G) has the most holds (7) in the SL since his arrival on June 1. He's the only active SL pitcher with at least 12 combined holds and saves in that span, and he's posted a 2.20 ERA while throwing in a league-high 25 games in that time.

LESS THAN SEVEN: After their win on August 19, the Generals have gone 13 consecutive games without a starting pitcher throwing seven innings, their longest drought this year between seven-inning starts. The Generals are 19-6 this year when a starter completes the seventh inning. Jackson has gone 8-5 since their last seven-inning start (on August 3).

MORE GENERAL NOTES

Pitching	Hitting
 *Right-handers Matt Peacock and Josh Green are arguably the best groundball pitchers in Minor League Baseball right now. They rank 1st (Peacock, 68.7%) and 3rd (Green, 66%) in groundball rate among all MILB pitchers with at least 70 innings thrown, per FanGraphs.com. Three reasons why that matters: 1) They're relatively low-cost investments for the Diamondbacks. Green was drafted in the 14th round, while Peacock was taken in the 23rd round, both as college seniors. 2) Even after a humidor was installed at Chase Field, it's still an offense-friendly park: ESPN.com's Park Factor rating ranked Chase Field as MLB's 11th-most run-friendly stadium last season. (It ranked 3rd in 2017.) Additionally, the D-backs play at Colorado's Coors Field a lot, the most run-friendly park in MLB. 3) The Diamondbacks have ranked in the top 2 teams in baseball in each of the last 2 years in groundout-to-air-out ratio, outdone only by Colorado. That doesn't seem accidental, given the physical tendencies of their home environment (and the division). (August 8) 	 *Daulton Varsho's homer-and-steal day on 8/2 against Mobile marked the sixth time in his career he's homered and stolen a base in one game, having accomplished the feat twice in 2018 & three times previously this year. Only four MLB catchers have ever recorded a HR-and-SB game 4+ times in a single season: Russell Martin (4, 2008), Carlton Fisk (4, 1983), Sandy Alomar (4, 1994), and Ivan Rodriguez (5, 1999). (August 2) *Seth Beer won July Player of the Month in the Texas League with Corpus Christi, leading all Double-A hitters with 24 runs scored, 63 total bases, and 9 home runs, and a 1.125 OPS before being 1 of 4 prospects swapped for Zack Greinke. (August 8) *Drew Ellis, Daulton Varsho, and Jeffrey Baez have all embraced the launch angle revolution in baseball, as evidenced by the fact that over 45% of their batted balls this year have been fly balls. Prior to the departures of Jazz Chisholm and Jamie Westbrook, the Generals had five players on their roster with fly-ball rates above 44%, the most of any Double-A team. (August 9)
 *Nine different Generals have saved games for Jackson this year, but their two most reliable options (Michael Kohn and Kevin Ginkel) have both been promoted. As the Generals prep for the playoffs, the most reliable late-game options look to be: >>Veteran Damien Magnifico, who has made a team-high 31 scoreless appearances despite allowing lefties to hit .333 off him. >Newcomer West Tunnell, whose fastball-slider combination mimics Magnifico's. Tunnell saved 13 games at High-A this year. >Southpaw Miguel Aguilar, the sneakiest fireman in the league. He's quietly compiled the best K/BB ratio (8:1) of any lefty in the Southern League over 20 games (24 K, 3 BB), and since the All-Star Break, nobody has more combined saves and holds (3 saves, 4 holds).
