LAST TIME OUT: Romero picked up his second win of the season in his last outing. Over 5.2 innings, he held the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers scoreless, not issuing a walk for the first time this season and struck out six. The one blemish on Romero's line was hitting two batters, but he worked around the base runners as the LumberKings went on to win 7-3 to split a four-game series with the Timber Rattlers.

AGAINST THE HOT RODS: This will be Romero's first career start against the Bowling Green Hot Rods.
