Today's Preview: The LumberKings (A, Marlins) continue their longest road trip of the year in both innings played and miles traveled with the second game of a three-game series with the Dayton Dragons (A, Reds). This is the LumberKings first trip to Dayton since 2016 after Clinton hosted all of the meeting in 2017 and 2018. Last season, they dropped the first two games of the series with Dayton before rebounding to win the series finale on a Jack Larsen walk-off home run. Thus far in the head-to-head meetings the LumberKings trail the Dragons 51 games to 55.

LumberKing Starter: Humberto Mejia, 22, makes his seventh appearance and fifth start of the year with the LumberKings. The Panama native earned the win his last time out for a five-inning outing at home against the South Bend Cubs. The start was his strongest of the year allowing just a bloop single during his time out as the LumberKings went on to take the series opener 3-1. In addition, Mejia issued just one walk while striking out five. Mejia has yo-yoed between starter and reliever this year typically piggy backing a start when he comes out from the bullpen. The Miami Marlins signed him as an international free agent on September 16th, 2013 out of Panama who he then pitched for in the World Baseball Classic (WBC) in 2016. Mejia's WBC memories are still his favorite of his professional baseball career

Dragons Starter: Jared Solomon, 21, makes his sixth appearance and start of the season for the Dayton Dragons. The Lackawanna, Pennsylvania native was given a no decision his last time out for five innings of work in which he allowed two runs on four hits while walking one and striking out six against the Peoria Chiefs at Dozer Park. A hard throwing right-hander he regularly touched 96 MPH with his fastball while pitching for as Lackawanna Community College. The high velocity led to him being selected by the Cincinnati Reds in the 11th round of the 2017 MLB Draft. He spent his first season of pro ball with the AZL Reds before splitting his 2018 season between Billings Mustangs and Dayton Dragon. While pitching in the Midwest League last season he did not face the LumberKings.

The Sheriff: Will Banfield continues to stifle any running game opponents attempt to have against him. During Monday's loss to the Dragons he caught all three of Dayton's would be base stealers with perfect throws to second base. Twice he caught Shard Monroe to become the first batcher in the Midwest League to throw him out on steal attempt this year. This year 64 stolen base attempts have been tired against Banfield with only 22 succeeding – a success rate of just 34%.

That Damn Horn: The fog horn – which follows every Dragons home run at Fifth Third Field – was featured prominently in Monday night's series opener with Dayton slugging four home runs. The home runs surrendered by Clinton pitching were the most allowed in a game this year an accounted for all five of the runs surrendered. LumberKings starter George Soriano – who had begun the year without allowing a home run over his 17.2 innings – has now allowed five home runs over his last 4.2 innings of work.

Down by Way Of the K: The offense for Clinton this season has been one built on the home run -25 as a team ranks as the second most in the league – and the strikeout. The K has been a factor in stalling several of the LumberKings rallies this year and showed itself in Monday night's loss. Clinton batters struck out nine times in the game seven of them occurring over the final three innings. As a team they have now struck out 370 times most in the league and 37 more times than the next closest team the Burlington Bees.

Home Cooking with the Spinach: The Clinton LumberKings are now on the road and away from their power base. They enter the action with the second most home runs in the Midwest League with 25 with 17 of those coming at home. Clinton failed to hit a home run in until a week into the season. Their most recent opponents, the South Bend Cubs brought up the rear with just eight home runs as a team.

League Leaders: The Clinton LumberKings have several players at or among the league leaders. Christopher Torres, placed on the injured list on April 28th, is currently tied for sixth in the league - along with teammate Sean Reynolds - in walks with 19. Jerar Encarnacion finds himself on many lists – he currently owns the most RBIs 25, most total bases, 60, hits, 38, and his .336 average is the fourth highest in the league. Bubba Hollins was ranked second in the league in average with a .358 mark at the time of his injury but no longer is qualified after having sat out since May 2nd.

Quality Returns: The Clinton LumberKings closed out their series with the South Bend Cubs with a pair of quality starts. Marking the first time in 2019 that Clinton received back-to-back quality starts. The quality starts were just the fourth and fifth of the season for LumberKings pitching and their first since April 25th.
