## TODAY'S MATCHUP

The Winnipeg Goldeyes will travel to Newman Outdoor Field for the first time this season after calling the field home during 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The Goldeyes and RedHawks will begin a series tonight at 7:02 p.m. and will play 11 games over the next 21 days. Fargo-Moorhead is hoping to turn things around on this important seven-game homestand after getting swept by the division leading Milwaukee Milkmen. The Goldeyes have won three of their last four games but lost 15-11 to the Houston Apollos in game two of a doubleheader on Saturday. RHP Gage Hinsz (3-2, 5.82 ERA) will make his eight start of the season for the RedHawks. So far this season Fargo-Moorhead has scored 72 runs in games that Hinsz has started, an average of 10.4 runs per game. The Goldeyes are expected to start RHP Pete Perez (1-1, 6.15 ERA).

## WINNIPEG MAKES RETURN TO NEWMAN OUTDOOR FIELD

The Winnipeg Goldeyes make their return to Fargo for the first time since September 10, 2020 after hosting their home games at Newman Outdoor Field last summer due to travel restrictions caused by the COVID-19 pandemic. The Goldeyes were 15-15 in home games last season and were 13-11 against the Fargo-Moorhead RedHawks.

The Goldeyes are still unable to host games at Shaw Park and are currently playing their home games at The Ballpark in Jackson, Tenn. So far this season Winnipeg is 7-10 in home games at The Ballpark. The Goldeyes have a winning percentage of .572 at Shaw Park in their nine seasons in the American Association.

Gage Hinsz arrives with the RedHawks in 2021 for his sixth season of professional baseball and first in independent baseball. Hinsz played four seasons in the Pittsburgh Pirates organization after they took him in the 11th Round of the 2014 MLB Amateur Draft. He reached the Advanced-A level in 2017 with the Bradenton Marauders, going 5-5 with a 5.61 ERA in 20 appearances (19 starts). He struck out 52 batters and gave up 31 walks in 94.2 innings pitched in 2017, his most recent season of summer baseball, despite missing parts of the season with a shoulder injury that was eventually diagnosed as a scapular stress fracture. He was listed as the Pirates' 20th-ranked prospect on MLB.com's 2018 prospect watch list.

After undergoing open heart surgery to repair a failing aortic valve in May 2018, Hinsz returned to baseball during the instructional league in Florida and then at Pittsburgh's academy in the Dominican Republic, where he pitched simulated games before joining Gigantes de Carolina in the Puerto Rican Winter League. Hinsz made his first official appearance since his surgery Nov. 17, 2018, when he struck out five over four scoreless innings and allowed one hit and one walk. He went 0-1 with a 1.08 ERA in five starts for Carolina in 2018-19, striking out 23 batters and walking seven in 25.0 innings of work. He was placed on the injured list just prior to the start of the 2019 season with a right forearm strain and did not make any appearances that season.

Hinsz pitched for the Billings Scarlets American Legion team — his high school did not have a baseball team — before being drafted by the Pirates. He committed to Oregon State while he was in high school, but decided on playing minor league baseball after being offered a \$580,000 signing bonus in 2014. Models his mechanics after Roy Halladay.
