Hartford is seeking its first three-game win streak after taking three of four against New Hampshire... The Yard Goats are batting .308 with seven homers and scored 24 runs in first four home games... Hartford batted .154 with three homers and scored 10 runs in seven road games...

YARD GOATS STARTING PITCHER:

LHP **Jack Wynkoop** makes his third start of the season and second against Richmond... Opening Day starter for Yard Goats for second straight season... Ranks 2nd All-Time with Yard Goats in starts (42), innings (240.2), 7th in K's (125).

DUNKIN' DONUTS PARK

The Yard Goats attracted 22,297 fans to Dunkin' Donuts Park over the opening four games of the season setting a new franchise record... Last season, the Yard Goats became the first minor league baseball club in Connecticut history to attract over 400,000 fans and led entire Eastern League in total attendance (408,942), including a club-record 47 sellouts and 28 maximum capacity standing room crowds... Hartford sold out the final 19 home games (July 18th-August 30th) and 35 of the last 39, starting May 30th... For the second straight season Dunkin' Donuts Park was selected by Ballpark Digest as the "Best Double-A ballpark in America"...

YARD GOATS 2019 ROSTER

The Yard Goats roster has 13 pitchers and 12 position players, including seven of the Rockies top 30 prospects as listed by MLB.com. The Yard Goats have 14 newcomers along with 11 returning players. Infielder **Colton Welker**, who won the Class-A California League batting title last year and is listed as the Rockies #2 overall prospect, will start the season with the Yard Goats. He will be joined in the Hartford infield with #7 prospect **Tyler Nevin**, who is the son of New York Yankees third base coach and former 12-year Major League veteran Phil Nevin. The Rockies set the roster and are responsible for all the player transactions during the season.

YARD GOATS COACHING STAFF

Warren Schaeffer returns as manager for the Yard Goats in 2019, making him the first ever Yard Goats manager to return for consecutive seasons in Hartford. Schaeffer's coaching staff includes returning Hitting Coach and former MLB player **Lee Stevens**, and newcomer **Steve Merriman**, who will serve as Pitching Coach. **Hoshito Mizutani** returns to the Yard Goats as Head Athletic Trainer and **Phil Bailey** returns as the Physical Performance Coach... Last season under Schaeffer, six Yard Goats players were named to the Eastern League All-Star Team, two players were selected to the Major League Futures Game, and two players were chosen as Eastern League award winners. Schaeffer and Stevens helped develop infielder Garrett Hampson, who began the season with the Yard Goats, and finished the season on the Colorado Rockies playoff roster. The Yard Goats went 65-72 and finished in third place in the Eastern League's Eastern Division.

DUNKIN' DONUTS PARK NAMED 2018 "BEST DOUBLE-A BALLPARK"

For the second straight season Dunkin' Donuts Park was selected by Ballpark Digest as the "Best Double-A ballpark in America"... It is the first time that a minor league ballpark won the award in consecutive seasons... PNC Park (Pittsburgh Pirates) won the award in back-to-back seasons in 2015 and 2016... Last season, the Yard Goats became the first minor league baseball club in Connecticut history to attract over 400,000 fans and led entire Eastern League in total attendance (408,942), including a club-record 47 sellouts and 28 maximum standing room capacity crowds... In its first two seasons Dunkin' Donuts Park has attracted over 800,000 fans and had 88 sellouts... In 2017, Dunkin' Donuts Park was named "**2017 BaseballParks.com Ballpark of the Year**" and was featured in the August 9-15 edition of USA TODAY SPORTS WEEKLY... Dunkin' Donuts Park was voted as the "**Best Double-A Ballpark in America**" in an online voting contest held by Ballpark Digest... Dunkin' Donuts Park was also named a TRIPLE winner in the Hartford Business Journal's Best of Business poll, taking honors for "**Best Corporate Event Venue**," "**Best Business Meeting Venue**," and "**Best Employee Outing Venue**" categories... In addition, Dunkin' Donuts Park won "**Best Place to See a Game**" for 2017 from Connecticut Magazine...

YARD GOATS IN THE BIG LEAGUES

Over the past three plus seasons, 19 former Yard Goats have made their Major League debuts, 18 with the Rockies... Tuesday, **Yonathan Daza**, who spent last season at Hartford, was called up to Rockies and on April 7 Yard Goats 2017 MVP **Josh Fuentes** was called up to the Rockies and had a hit in his first MLB at-bat vs Dodgers... Last season, INF **Garrett Hampson**, who was the Yard Goats opening day 2B and leadoff hitter, was called up to Rockies on July 21, becoming the first 2018 Yard Goats player to reach the Majors... In 2018, Eight former Yard Goats were promoted to the Major Leagues for the first time in 2018 (INF **Garrett Hampson** '18), (RHP **Yency Almonte** '17), (LHP **Sam Howard** '17), (OF **Noel Cuevas** '16), (LHP **Harrison Musgrave** '16), (LHP **Jerry Vasto** '16), (OF **Rosell Herrera** '16), (RHP **D.J. Johnson** '17)... Almonte started the first game ever at Dunkin' Donuts Park.. INF **Ryan McMahon**, who was the first Yard Goats player to hit a home run at Dunkin' Donuts Park, made the Colorado Rockies 2018 Opening Day roster... He made his MLB debut in 2017 and was one of two Yard Goats to play in both Hartford and Colorado that year... LHP **Tyler Anderson**, LHP **Kyle Freeland**, RHP **German Marquez**, RHP **Antonio Senzatela** and INF **Pat Valaika** are currently with the Major League club after playing on the first ever Yard Goats team in 2016... In 2016 six players went from the Yard Goats to the Rockies during the same season... (Anderson, RHP **Matt Carasiti**, **David Dahl**, Marquez, OF **Raimel Tapia**)... The Yard Goats franchise has sent 30 players to its Major League affiliate in just four plus seasons since the affiliation began in 2015... SS **Trevor Story**, C **Tom Murphy**, OF **Mike Tauchman**, RHP **Shane Carle** (Atlanta Braves) and LHP **Ryan Carpenter** (Detroit Tigers), RHP **Carlos Estevez**, OF **Jordan Patterson**, LHP **Yohan Flande**, LHP **Jason Gurka**, RHP **Jeff Hoffman**, RHP **Justin Miller**, and LHP **Sam Moll** (Oakland Athletics 2017) who played on the last ever Rock Cats team in 2015 made it to MLB...

YARD GOATS STARTING ROTATION

The Yard Goats announced starting rotation to begin the season: LHP **Jack Wynkoop**, RHP **Brandon Gold**, LHP **Ty Culbreth**, RHP **Rico Garcia**, and RHP **Ashton Goudeau**... Wynkoop and Garcia return to the Yard Goats rotation while Gold and Culbreth are at the Double-A level for the first time... Holman pitched for the Yard Goats in 2017 and spent last season at Triple-A...

PEANUT FREE BALLPARK

In February, the Yard Goats announced they will **no longer sell shelled peanuts and Cracker Jack at Dunkin' Donuts Park in an effort to make the venue more accessible for those with peanut and tree nut allergies**. This announcement gained national attention and was featured in articles in Time Magazine, USA Today, NY Daily News and Washington Post, and talked about on several national television and radio shows across America... While many teams throughout professional sports have peanut-free sections, and/or peanut-free games, the Yard Goats are the first to stop selling the common allergen completely at their home venue in order to create a safe environment for individuals with peanut and tree nut allergies. The idea to go peanut-free arose after a series of meetings with concerned parents of children with peanut and tree nut allergies. "Everyone should have the opportunity to experience the atmosphere at Dunkin' Donuts Park," Yard Goats President Tim Restall said. "With more than 200 food items available, it makes sense to eliminate just two that allows fans with peanut allergies to attend games." Reactions to peanuts and tree nuts can be life-threatening. One in 13 children, or roughly two in every classroom, has a food allergy, according to Food Allergy Research & Education (FARE). Studies show that the number of children with food allergies in the United States grew by 50 percent between 1997 and 2011, and the number of children living with a peanut allergy tripled between 1997 and 2008.

EASTERN LEAGUE WILL DIVIDE SEASON INTO TWO HALVES

The Eastern League will be changing its playoff format from a full season format to a split season format. Under the new format **the first place team from each division during both the first and second halves of the season will qualify for the postseason**. The first half of the season will end on the 76th day of the regular season and the second half of the season will begin on the 77th day of the regular season. For the 2019 season, the **final day of the first half of the season will be on Tuesday, June 18th, with the second half of the season kicking off on Wednesday, June 19th**. The second half of the season will conclude on Monday, September 2nd, the final day of the regular season. Postseason berths will be awarded to the first place teams in both the Eastern Division and the Western Division during the first half and second half of the season. In the event the same team finishes in first place in their division in both halves of the season, the second playoff spot for that division would be awarded to the team from that division that had the best full season record. The first round of the postseason will feature the first half winner from each division facing the second half winner from their respective division. The team that finishes in first place in the first half will host games three through five of the best-of-five opening round series. Winners from each opening round series will advance to the Eastern League Championship Series, which will feature a 2-3 format, with the series beginning in the Eastern Division this season.

SEVEN DIVISION I COLLEGE BASEBALL GAMES SCHEDULED AT DUNKIN' DONUTS PARK

The Yard Goats have scheduled seven Division I college baseball games at Dunkin' Donuts Park this spring. It is the third straight season that college baseball has been featured at the Yard Goats award winning ballpark. This spring, three local Division I programs will be on display as the **University of Connecticut Huskies**, **University of Hartford Hawks**, and **Central Connecticut State University Blue Devils** will play games at Dunkin' Donuts Park. The college baseball schedule at Dunkin' Donuts Park begins on Saturday, April 6th as the UConn Huskies host the **Cincinnati Bearcats** at 2:05 PM. The two teams will play again the following day on Sunday, April 7th at 12:00 PM. The Huskies will play two other games at Dunkin' Donuts Park and host the **Wichita State Shockers** on consecutive days, Friday, May 3rd at 7:05 PM and Saturday, May 4th at 2:05 PM. The Hartford Hawks host the **University of Rhode Island Rams** on Wednesday, April 17th at 6:05 PM, the **Central Connecticut State University Blue Devils** on Tuesday, May 7th at 10:35 AM, and the **LIU Brooklyn Blackbirds** on Tuesday, May 14th at 6:05 PM.

CONNECTICUT CAPE COD CLASSIC RETURNS TO DUNKIN' DONUTS PARK IN JULY

The Hartford Yard Goats will once again host a Cape Cod League baseball game at Dunkin' Donuts Park... The Wareham Gatemen and Yarmouth-Dennis Red Sox will play a league game at Dunkin' Donuts Park on Tuesday July 23rd, at 12:30pm. The "Connecticut Cape Cod Classic" will feature the defending league champion (Wareham) and the team that had the best overall record in the CCBL last season (Yarmouth-Dennis). Wareham is coached by former Yard Goats manager **Jerry Weinstein**. The prestigious Cape Cod League features some of the top amateur players in the country... Last season's game at Dunkin' Donuts Park was the first ever Cape Cod League Game played in Connecticut. From 2009-2011, the Cape Cod League All Star Game was played at Fenway Park.
