ABOUT LAST TIME...: With a season-high 13 runs and four homers, the New Hampshire Fisher Cats (Toronto Blue Jays Double-A affiliate) overpowered the Hartford Yard Goats (Colorado Rockies) 13-8 on Thursday night at Dunkin Donuts Park, securing their third consecutive win.

The Fisher Cats (8-13) scored five times in the second inning to open up a 5-0 advantage, starting with a sacrifice fly from top prospect Kevin Smith, who was reinstated from the injured list before the game. Brock Lundquist followed with a three-run homer to right field, and Vinny Capra went back-to-back with a solo elect to loft.

All-Star Nash Knight led off the top of the third inning with a home run to right to extend the lead to 6-0. The 'Cats added two more runs in the fourth with a bases-loaded single from Josh Palacios and a run-scoring error from Hartford.

The lead reached its apex in the top of the fifth at 10-0. Riley Adams and Chad Spanberger started the frame with singles, and a second sac fly from Smith scored Adams. Christian Williams then ripped an RBI triple to get New Hampshire to double digits.

Hartford (9-11) sent ten men to the plate in the bottom of the fifth inning and scored five runs. They added another in the sixth inning to cut the lead to 10-6.

Jackson McClelland had New Hampshire's best performance out of the bullpen, retiring all four batters he faced with one strikeout. Hector Perez started the game, and allowed four runs on five hits in four-plus innings.

Ty Culbreth (L, 3-7) took the loss for the Yard Goats, while William Ouellette (W, 1-0) earned his first Double-A win by recording three outs in the fifth inning.

MHT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: At Triple-A, the Buffalo Bisons scored four times in the top of the eighth inning for a 5-4 win at Pawtucket. Patrick Kivlehan hit his 16th home run, a three-run shot, that proved to be the game-winning hit. Ryan Borucki, working back from injury, allowed four runs, three earned, in his five inning start for the Bisons.

It was his first four RBI game since July 13, 2016 when playing for Vancouver. Catcher Riley Adams matched a season-best with his sixth game with three hits (three with New Hampshire- three with Dunedin).

HATCHLINGS: Tampa be0 at Dunedin twice---taking an 8-2 victory in the completion of a suspended game before taking the nightcap 2-1 in eight innings. Lansing edged Peoria 3-2. Sean Wymer allowed one run in his 6.1 innings to pick up his fifth win. Vancouver was a 7-3 winner at Everett and Pulaski stopped Bluefield 8-1.

BOB LIPMAN'S *THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY*: July 12, 2015 – The Fisher Cats reached the All-Star break with a 4-1 win at New Britain Stadium. Austin Bibens-Dirkx worked five scoreless innings to pick up the win. Offensively, Dalton Pompey and Jon Berti knocked in runs in the fifth inning--Berti with a triple. Matt Newman added a two-run shot in the eighth inning for his seventh home run.

ON THE HILL: The Fisher Cats turn to Yennsy Diaz tonight. He improved to 7-6 with a win on Sunday, coming on in relief of Patrick Murphy and pitching the final six innings in a 7-2 win over the Sea Dogs. Diaz did not allow a run while allowing two hits. He struck out seven. This will be the fourth start against the Yard Goats for the 22-year old from the Dominican Republic. Is 0-2, 5.61 against Hartford. Reigning EL Pitcher of the Week Jack Wynkoop starts for Hartford, his 58th career start for the Goats. This is his fifth start against New Hampshire in 2019---1-1, 4.09 ERA. He is just 1-6 in his career against the Fisher Cats (0-3 in 2018- 3 starts and 0-2 in 2017---3 starts).

ON DECK: The Fisher Cats head back home after this series to take on the Portland Sea Dogs Monday-Wednesday. The teams just faced off at Delta Dental Stadium for the first time right before the All-Star Break, ending in a four-game split. Monday's game will feature an autograph session w/ Chris Carpenter & Tim Schaller thanks to our friends at Primary Bank. Carpenter, who's now retired, and Schaller, who played last season for the Vancouver Canucks, both grew up in New Hampshire. Wednesday is Summer Camp Day at 12:05 p.m.

PLYMOUTH ROCK ASSURANCE CUP: Hartford has won 15 of the 20 games played between the teams this season, and claims the Plymouth Rock Assurance Cup for the first time in the three seasons it has been awarded to the winner of the season series. After sweeping all 11 games at Dunkin Donuts Park last season, New Hampshire is 3-6 in Hartford this season.
