TOUGH ONE ON SUNDAY: C **Austin Bossart** clubbed a two-run, walk-off homer to give Reading a 3-2 win on Sunday afternoon...Bossart knocked in all three runs, delivering an RBI single in the fifth...Portland took a 2-0 lead in the second inning on a two-run homer by 3B **Bobby Dalbec**....LHP **Matthew Kent** tied a career-high with eight innings pitched on just one run...RHP **Durbin Feltman** (2-2) retired the first two in the ninth before a walk to LF **Luke Williams** and the homer to Bossart.

STARS SHINING BRIGHT: On June 24th, the Eastern League, in conjunction with the Richmond Flying Squirrels announced the rosters for the All-Star Game...Portland sends Dalbec, Houck, LHP **Dedgar Jimenez**, and C **Jhon Nunez** to the annual mid-summer classic.

DON'T FORGET ABOUT DURAN: Last Friday, OF **Jarren Duran**, was named to the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game...Duran is hitting .330 in 74 games between Portland and High-A Salem.

THEY HAD TWO: Kent and RHP **Denyi Reyes** each had eight-inning pitching performances last series but did not figure in the decision...Reading won games on a walk-off.

MAY 31ST IN THE MEDIA GUIDE: Portland established a franchise record for runs (20), hits (26), and total bases (48) in their 20-2 win on May 31 over the Binghamton Rumble Ponies at NYSEG Stadium.

2019 SEASON: *Last 6 starts: 4-2, 2.75 ERA (11 ER/36.0 IP), 29 H, 12 BB, 39 SO...*Career-high 11 K's on 6/6 vs. Richmond...Won a career-high three straight starts from 4/15-27...Season-high 14 scoreless innings from 4/15-5/3...Named to the Eastern League All-Star Team.

FACING TRENTON: Second career start...Took the loss on 5/20 in Trenton - Game 2 of a doubleheader.

DID YOU KNOW: Enters the 2019 season ranked by *Baseball America* as Boston's #7 prospect...Ranked by *MLB.com* as Boston's #6 prospect.

LOOK BACK AT 2018: Spent the entire season with High-A Salem...Ranked among club leaders with 111 SO (2nd), 119.0 IP (2nd), 23 starts (T-2nd), and 7 wins (3rd)...Limited opponents to a .203 AVG with RISP during the campaign...Posted a 2.86 ERA (22 ER/69.1 IP) over his final 12 starts (6/14-8/14)...Logged 5.0+ IP in each of his last 8 starts, 6.0+ IP in 6, and 7.0+ IP in 2...Placed on the DL on 8/18 with left chest/ back/spine/ribcage inflammation and missed the rest of the season.

CAREER/PERSONAL NOTES: Was named by *Baseball America* as the No. 8 college prospect available in the 2017 June Draft...Received American Baseball Coaches Association All-Region honors in 2016 and was selected to the All-SEC Freshman Team in 2015...Was drafted by the Toronto Blue Jays out of high school in 2014 but elected to attend the University of Missouri...Ranked 2nd among 3-year players in school history with 292 SO, trailing Kyle Gibson (304 from 2007-09)...Became the 2nd pitcher to throw at least 300 innings in 3 seasons at Missouri...Graduated from Collinsville (IL) High School.
