FIGHTINS GIVE THEMSELVES A CHANCE WITH 2-1 WIN :

READING, PA) - After losing two of his last three starts, it was imperative that Bailey Falter get off to a fast start after falling in Akron in his first appearance against them just two weeks ago. In the top of the first, shortstop Ernie Clement started his busy night with an infield single, but Falter induced a 4-6-3 double play off the bat of Ka'ai Tom to help himself retire the side in order. In the home half, Josh Stephen swatted a one-out double to left center field, and Darick Hall brought in his team-leading 41st run with a single through the right side for a 1-0 lead. Hall later led off the third inning with another single, stole second base, and scored on a two-out bleeder from Cornelius Randolph that got into right field for a 2-0 advantage. Arquimedes Gamboa prolonged the inning with a walk, and Austin Bossart came through with the first big punch on a three-run homer to left for a 5-0 lead. The RubberDucks pecked away at the deficit in the top of the fifth, finally cashing in after getting the leadoff man on for the fourth time with Tyler Krieger's double getting the action started. Another in-between double from Mitch Longo put a pair of runners in scoring position, and number nine hitter Alexis Pantoja got Akron on the board with a groundout to short. Clement then guided his second triple down the right field line to make it 5-2, but Falter (5-4) closed out his night with a pair of flyouts to make it through five innings. Hall's 13th homer tacked on a pair in the bottom of the fifth, with his 43 RBIs pushing him into a tie for second in the Eastern League. With the lead back to five at 7-2, the R-Phils pushed across another run against reliever Jared Robinson when Stephen wacked his second double to score Mickey Moniak after a one-out single in the seventh inning. Lefthander Anthony Gose got the first out in the bottom of the eighth, but loaded the bases after a pair of walks and a single by Luke Williams. Moniak's second single made it 9-2, and Stephen's walk scored the 10th run to put the game away for good. Jeff Singer struck out three batters in the ninth to complement Connor Brogdon, who tossed three scoreless innings for the second time and also struck out three RubberDucks.

WE DID WHAT WE HAD TO, DESPITE THE SCHEDULE :

+ Needing a win last night, the Fightin Phils scored a season-high 10 runs to get to 11 games over .500 for the first time
 + It was their 4th win in the last 5 games, which put the pressure on Trenton to win at home against the Flying Squirrels
 + Reading wound up leading the Eastern Division with 39 wins (.582 winning %), but lost the tiebreaker by a few percentage points to the Thunder (38-27, .585 winning percentage)
 + According to @Gregg_Caserta on Twitter, the Fightins played 45 games outside the division compared to 22 within the division during the first-half. Of those 45 non-divisional games, 39 came against Harrisburg, Richmond, and Akron
 + Reading never faced Trenton (90-minute drive) or Binghamton (about a 3-hour drive), and therefore the head-to-head records were useless when factored in for tiebreaking purposes

THUNDER ROLL RICHMOND FOR FIRST-HALF TITLE :

+ Yankees #4 prospect Deivi Garcia tied MiLB's season-high this season with 15 strikeouts over six innings, allowing just a hit and a walk in Trenton's 6-0 shutout against Richmond
 + Garcia started the game with eight straight strikeouts, and tied the Thunder's single-game franchise record for strikeouts
 + With 100 total strikeouts this season, Garcia tied Reading's Damon Jones for fourth in all of Minor League Baseball

ON THE MOUND :

+ In his Double-A debut on Sunday against the Senators, Damon Jones struck out a career-high 12 batters over 6.0 innings in his 48th career game (34th start). He struck out 5 of the first 6 batters he faced, and 7 of the last 8, becoming the first Fightins starter to fan 12 since Ben Lively in a 7-2 win in Trenton on May 15, 2016 *Lively did it in 7.0 innings
 + Jones' Minor League Ranks : 1.54 ERA (3rd) / 100 Strikeouts (3rd) / .177 average against (4th)
 + JoJo Romero (1-3) delivered his best start of the season on Friday, setting new highs with 8 SO over 7.0 scoreless IP
 -> The Philllies #2 Pitching Prospect retired the last 13 Senators for his first 7-inning start since 7/14/18 in an 8-3 win vs BOW
 + LHP Jakob Hernandez has worked nine straight scoreless appearances since May 25th (12.0 IP, 2 H, 6 BB, 12 SO) and has not allowed any of his 10 inherited runners to score all season
 + Jeff Singer earned his first save in Harrisburg on Friday night since August 28, 2018 in Richmond. Right-handed hitters are batting just .096 (5-for-52) against him in 18 games this season
 + In his last 16 games since May 1, Addison Russ is 7-for-8 on saves and has allowed 1 ER in 17.1 IP (0.52 ERA) with 23 SO

+ In his last 21 games since May 27, Austin Listi is batting .328 (23-for-70) with 2 doubles, 6 HR, and 16 runs batted in
 + Mickey Moniak batted .290 in 27 games in May and is in the midst of a season-high 17-game on base streak since June 1st EL Ranks : 64 Hits (8th) / 34 Runs (T-7th) / 16 2B (T-5th) / 7 Triples (1st) / 26 XBH (7th) / 33 RBIs (T-11th)

Posted identical 3.72 earned run averages in 13 starts at Spectrum Field and nine on the road...Had his two best months in April (2-1, 1.62 ERA in 4 games, 3 starts) and August (4-0, 1.74 ERA in five starts)...Lost all seven decisions in a row from April 27-July 12, but dominated down the stretch by going 6-0 in his last eight starts... During that time, allowed 2 ER or less in seven of eight starts, and totaled 67 strikeouts in 48.2 innings...Started the third and deciding game of the FSL Semifinals against Daytona, taking a no decision in a season-ending 5-3 loss (6.0 IP, 3 H, 2 ER, 3 BB, 6 SO, HR)...Left the game with a 3-0 lead before the bullpen allowed two runs in the seventh and three in the eighth.
