TRIBE TIPS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: For a third consecutive game the Indians played extra innings, but the Tribe were finally defeated in 10 frames, losing 4-3 last night. Adam Rosales had the game-winning knock with an RBI single in the 10th, and the Indians left the tying run at third base in the home half. Alex McRae (L, 3-10) was tagged with the tough-luck loss, despite throwing 4.0 innings in relief. He allowed two runs -- one earned -- on four hits and one walk with three strikeouts. Columbus built a 3-0 lead thanks to an error, Bobby Bradley solo homer and Rosales' first RBI single, but Indy rallied for three runs after the stretch to tie the game. Pablo Reyes hit an RBI double ahead of run-scoring singles by Max Moroff and Jose Osuna. Josh Martin (W, 4-0) fired two perfect innings in relief to keep his perfect record intact.

JOS-3333333: Jose Osuna logged three hits in five at-bats last night to match his season high for hits in a game. It was his seventh three-hit game of 2018 and second in a nine-game span (also: August 12 vs. PAW). His .317 average would be second in the league if he had enough at-bats to qualify.

EIGHT STRAIGHT FOR PABLO: Pablo Reyes has hit safely in eight consecutive games dating back to August 14, one shy of matching his season-high nine-game hitting streak from May 2-11. During the streak, he's batting .310 (9-for-29) with one triple, four doubles, one RBI and five runs scored.

RYAN FLYIN': Ryan Lavarney has hit safely in 19 of his last 23 games, batting .410 (32-for-78) with four homers, 10 doubles, 12 RBI and 12 runs scored dating back to July 21. He has reached base safely in 25 of his last 27 games. He is also batting .385 (20-for-52) with three dingers, five doubles, eight RBI and a 1.121 OPS in 14 games vs. Columbus this year.

wRC+: The Indians have five position players on their active roster who are among the top 33 players (min. 250 PAs) in wRC+ in the International League. Ryan Lavarney (1st, 160 wRC+), Jose Osuna (8th, 137 wRC+), Kevin Kramer (T-13th, 132 wRC+), Pablo Reyes (24th, 123 wRC+) and Max Moroff (33rd, 118 wRC+) are those on the list. Jordan Luplow (6th, 144 wRC+) is expected to join the club in the coming days after being optioned by Pittsburgh yesterday, and Kevin Newman is also among the top 50 (48th, 113 wRC+) but is currently with the Pirates.

MITCH VS. MITCH: Last night's game pitted starters Mitch Keller and Mitch Talbot against one another. Keller, 22, tossed 5.0 innings and gave up one unearned run on two hits, three walks and two strikeouts. Talbot, 34, scattered six hits and two walks with four punchouts over 5.0 shutout frames. Keller is now 2-0 with a 1.59 ERA (3 ER/17.0) over his last three starts.

CALL IT A RIVALRY: The Indians and Clippers are tied atop the IL West with 13 games to play. Norfolk and Scranton/W-B each sit 1.5 games back of the Tribe and Columbus in the IL Wild Card race. Each of the last seven seasons dating back to 2010 have featured either Indy or Columbus as division champs. The breakdown of where Columbus and Indy have finished in the IL West standings since that 2010 campaign is below:

2011: Columbus 1st, Indy 2nd
2012: Indy 1st, Columbus 2nd
2013: Indy 1st, Columbus 2nd
2014: Columbus 1st, Indy 2nd

TIEBREAKER STILL IN PLAY: Columbus' win last night gave them a 12-11 advantage over Indy in the head-to-head series this year. The series has been dominated by the home team, with Indy going 7-3 at The Vic while Columbus went 9-4 against the Tribe at Huntington Park. The winner of this three-game series will win the season series and would host a one-game playoff IF both teams finished tied for the division lead at the end of the regular season AND only one of them would make the playoffs. If both teams finished tied and each would reach the postseason as either division champs or wild card champs, then the winner of this series would enter the playoffs as IL West champions.

SUCCESS AGAINST THE IL NORTH: The Indians' 15-6 win on Sunday at Lehigh Valley concluded a 23-15 record against IL North opponents for the Tribe in 2018. From 1998-2004, the Indians were sub-.500 against the IL North in six of seven seasons, the lone winning campaign coming in 1999 (28-20). Since 2005, the Indians have finished at or above .500 vs. the IL North in 12 of 14 seasons, going 343-289 (.543) during that stretch.

DOUBLE DOUBLE: The Indians have racked up 286 doubles through 127 games this season (2.25 doubles per game), the most in all of professional baseball. The Tribe are on pace for 315 doubles and have seven players with 20-plus doubles so far this year. Indy's highest doubles count as a team since 1996 is 299, done in both 1998 and 2000. The Indians have led the IL in doubles four times previously (2017, 2013, 1998 and 1963).

REMEMBERING THAT '95 OFFENSE: On top of leading the IL in doubles (286) and batting average (.272), Indy paces all IL teams in OBP (.337), SLG (.419), hits (1138) and total bases (1755). The .337 OBP would be Indy's highest since 2010 (.340), and they last led their respective league in OBP in 1995, when the Tribe were part of the American Association. Indy's .420 SLG would be the best mark by a Tribe team since 2005 (.440). Indy also last led the league in SLG in 1995. Indy hasn't led its league in hits or total bases since that 1995 season, as well.

MAGNIFICENT MAGNIFICO: Damien Magnifico stranded two baserunners in the 10th last night thanks to a perfect throw to the plate by right fielder Jerrick Suiter that kept Indy's deficit at one. The outfield assist was Suiter's fifth of the season and fourth at the plate. Since the All-Star break, Magnifico is 1-0 with a 4.0 ERA (1 ER/22.2 IP).

Tonight's Starter: Left-hander Brandon Waddell will take the mound tonight in the second game of the series vs. Columbus. The 24-year-old began his 2018 campaign with Double-A Altoona, where he went 2-1 with a 2.68 ERA (16 ER/53.2 IP) in nine games (eight starts). He entered the season ranked as Pittsburgh's No. 19 prospect by *Baseball America*, who also tabbed him as having the "Best Changeup" among Pirates farmhands prior to both the 2017 and 2018 seasons.

Last Outing: Waddell posted his fourth quality start in 12 starts at the Triple-A level and first since July 24 vs. Rochester last Thursday at Lehigh Valley, allowing three earned runs on four hits in 6.0 innings pitched. He walked three and struck out four but had to settle for a no-decision as Danny Ortiz belted a two-run, walk-off homer in the ninth off Jesus Liranzo to give the IronPigs a 6-5 victory.

Against the Clippers: Waddell has faced Columbus three times this year, going 0-1 with a 5.40 ERA (4 ER/6.2 IP). All three appearances (one start) vs. the Clippers came at Huntington Park, the most recent being a June 29 start where he allowed seven runs -- four earned -- on nine hits in 3.2 innings of work. The Tribe lost that game, 10-6. He has never faced Columbus at Victory Field.

Miscellaneous: Waddell pitched three years at the University of Virginia (2013-15) and won a NCAA National Championship with the Cavaliers his junior season. At UVA, he holds the program records in career starts with 53; the Cavaliers went 39-14 in those starts. He made five College World Series starts in his career, and UVA went 5-0 in those games. He attended Clear Lake High School in Houston, Texas. During his pro career, he was an MLB.com Organization All-Star in 2016 and has won three Pitcher of the Week Awards, two in 2016 (Florida State League, 5/2/16; Eastern League, 6/27/16) and one this season (International League, 7/16/18).
