Today's Preview: The Clinton LumberKings (A, Mariners) meet the Burlington Bees (A, Angels) for the fourth time this season with the second game of a three-game series. This will be the Bees final trip to Ashford University Field this season. The LumberKings swept a rain shortened two-game series in Clinton April 17-19 and then took three out of five from Burlington in Clinton May 21-23. Clinton made their first trip to Burlington June 5-7 and took two of three. The LumberKings trail the all-time series, dating back to 1962, 420 to 433. Since Clinton has been affiliated with the Seattle Mariners (2009) they are tied in the head-to-head matchups 83 games to 83 games.

LumberKings Starter: Randy Bell, 23, makes his 14th start and appearance of the season. The Louisiana native is making his LumberKings season debut after making 13 appearances and starts with the Modesto Nuts. Bell was assigned to Clinton to open the second half as part of the 12 roster moves to open the half. During his time in Modesto he went 3-4 with a 4.95 ERA walking 14 and striking out 49. The Seattle Mariners drafted Bell in the 10th round of the 2017 draft of the South Alabama University. In high school, lettered in football, baseball, and track, while helping the baseball team to capture two state championships. While in college the winning ways continued as he helped the Eagles to a NJCAA Division II College World Series in Enid, Oklahoma.

Bees Starter: Jose Soriano, 19, makes his third start and appearance of the season for the Burlington Bees. The Dominican native received a no decision his last time out for a four-inning outing in which he allowed no runs to the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers while walking one and striking out three. His season debut came against the Clinton LumberKings on June 7th and he was given the loss for a brief three inning start in which he allowed three runs on three hits while walking two and striking out none. Soriano was signed by the Los Angeles Angels as an international free agent on March 4th, 2016 for \$70,000 and was assigned to the Dominican Summer League Angels three days later. After a dominate 2014 season in the DSL, where he went 3-5 with a 1.58 ERA as a starting pitcher, he made his state side debut with the Arizona League Angels. He spent the majority of his 2017 season in the AZL working primarily as a starter and going 2-2 with a 2.94 ERA in the offensively driven Arizona League. His work at the Angles complex earned him a brief promotion to the Orem Owlz. He made one start for the Angels Pioneer League affiliate going just 3.1 innings while allowing one run on four hits while walking four and striking out two. Soriano is a pitcher that has struggled with his control thus far in his pro career. Over his 109.1 innings worked in his professional career he has issued 48 walks while striking out 84. The Angles have been excited with his literally growth over the last two years, adding three inches in height. His fastball will sit 95-96 MPH which works off a slider in the mid 80's. MLB.com has ranked him as the 13th best prospect in the Angles organization coming into this start.

Last Time Out: Two hits were all the Clinton LumberKings could muster in a 7-3 loss to the Burlington Bees on Monday night at Ashford University Field. Despite drawing 10 walks, the LumberKings (3-2, 42-33) could not overcome a five-run sixth inning by the Bees (1-4, 31-43). Burlington started the scoring in the top of the third inning on a two-out RBI single by Franklin Torres and added their second run of the night on a two-out RBI single in the top of the fourth by Connor Fitzsimmons. LumberKings starting pitcher Oliver Jaskie kept the deficit at two through the fifth inning but failed to make it through the sixth. The lefty turned in 5.1 innings allowing five runs on seven hits while walking four and striking out four. The LumberKings did not record their first hit of the night until the bottom of the seventh, when Joseph Rosa rolled an RBI single through the right side of the infield as part of a two-run rally. Clinton rallied again in the bottom of the ninth putting two men on and bringing the tying run into the on-deck circle when Rosa bounced into a game ending double play.

Walk This Way: The LumberKings only had two hits to show for their night against the Burlington Bees, not collecting their first hit until Joseph Rosa singled through the right side of the infield with two out in the bottom of the seventh. Still, the LumberKings had their chances drawing 10 walks, the second most drawn this season. All but two of the LumberKings batters drew walks in the game with Dimas Ojeda walking twice and Billy Cooke drawing three walks.

A Sinking Slam: The five-run rally by the Burlington Bees in the sixth inning on Monday night was the game's deciding rally. The outburst was led by Jimmy Barnes who slugged a grand slam for his second home run of the year. The slam was the second allowed by LumberKings pitching. Despite the Bees having the second fewest home runs in the Midwest League this season the Bees now have three grand slams.

Making it Count: Monday night's game for Bees outfielder Jimmy Barnes was his fourth game of the season against the LumberKings. Clinton pitching had handled Barnes well until his grand slam in the sixth inning, his only hit against the LumberKings this season. He is now 1-for-14 with a .071 over his time against Clinton.

Leading the Farm: Ryan Costello was out of the starting lineup for the LumberKings on Monday night but he still leads all Mariners minor leaguers in home runs with 13 and RBI with 55. The home runs are tied for the most in the Midwest League and he has the second most RBI in the league trailing, the now promoted Alex Kiriloff, by one RBI for the league lead.

Look Out He's Hot: The Burlington Bees registered 12 hits against the LumberKings on Monday night. One of the biggest may have been Kevin Williams sixth inning single which extended his hitting streak to 18 games. The streak is the second longest in the Midwest League this season, trailing only Jordan Devencenzi of Beloit who had a 19-game streak May 7 through June 6th. Over the stretch, Williams is batting .348 for a streak that began on June 3rd.

This date in baseball history: On this date in 1906, Herbert M. Whitney, a catcher for the Burlington Pathfinders, becomes the first professional baseball player to die as a result of being hit by a pitch. The beheading occurred two days ago in an Iowa State League contest against the Waterloo Microbes.
