ROBINSON ADDED TO OSPREY ROSTER

MISSOULA, MONT – In partnership with the Arizona Diamondbacks, the Missoula Osprey announced Thursday the addition of outfielder Kristian Robinson from the AZL D-backs. Robinson is in his first professional season after being signed in mid-July of 2017 out of the Bahamas.

After signing with the Diamondbacks organization as a 16-year-old, Robinson is ranked as the 12th best prospect in the organization according to MLB Pipeline. The outfielder was No. 15 on MLB Pipeline's Top 30 International Prospects heading into the July signed period due to the raw tools he possess along with a high ceiling.

With physicality and a chance to unleash his power potential, Robinson has already notched four home runs in 40 games this season in the AZL. With a .272 batting average, Robinson has been learning patience with 16 walks and 31 RBIs. With a 60-grade as a runner, Robinson has already scored 35 runs this year with seven stolen bases.

MIKE BENJAMIN -- MANAGER

PLAYING EXPERIENCE ... Played 13 seasons in the Majors with the Giants (1989-95), Phillies (1996), Red Sox (1997-98), and Pirates (1999-2000, 2002)... in 818 games, Benjamin hit .229 with 109 doubles, 24 homers and 169 RBI... was the Giants' 3rd-round pick in the 1987 draft. Previously drafted in the 7th round of the 1985 draft by the Twins out of Cerritos College in California... Played for the ASU Sun Devils in 1986-87... in 1987, helped lead ASU to the College World Series and earned First-Team All-America and All-Pac-10 honors (.327 AVG, 18 HR, 55 RBI, 30 SB)... 2011 inducted into the ASU Hall of Fame... in May 2014, was 1 of 30 Sun Devils named to the All-Packard Stadium Team, as selected by fans... His son, Michael, also played at Arizona State and last played in the Rockies' farm system in 2016 after being selected in the 13th-round of the 2013 draft.

COACHING EXPERIENCE ... 2017 marks his fourth season with the D-backs, second in Missoula and fourth in a managerial/coaching capacity... Assistant coach for Arizona State baseball from 2010-14... In 2003, coached son's Little League team that advanced to the Little League World Series in Williamsport, Pa.

PERSONAL ... Born November 22, 1965 (age 52) in Euclid, Ohio... He and his wife, Karen, reside in Queen Creek, Ariz... they have 3 kids, Michael, Briana, and Braylee... Attended Bellflower HS in Southern California.

PLAYING EXPERIENCE ... Played parts of 5 seasons with the Tigers (2002-03), Angels (2008-09), and Giants (2012), appearing in 58 games (13 starts)... overall, had 17-year playing career (1997-2004, 2006, 2008-15)... Tigers' 2nd-round pick (53 overall) in 1997 Draft... 103 career wins in affiliated Minor League Baseball (career-high 12 in 2000)... Once pitched a 10-inning shutout for the Toledo Mud Hens vs. Scranton/Wilkes Barre (AAA) in 2003... last pitched for the Sugar Land Skeeters of the Atlantic League (IND) in 2015, going 4-3 in 13 starts and posting a 2.92 ERA over 77.0 innings... repertoire included a sinker, fastball, curveball, slider, and changeup.

Osprey Take Series with 8-0 Shutout Win over Owlz

Osprey 1B Joe Robbins Drives in 3 with Homerun and Double

MISSOULA, MONT – Osprey pitchers Deyni Olivero, Jake Polancic, and Mailon Arroyo combined on a 4-hit shutout as the Osprey beat the Owlz 8-0 on Sunday. Osprey 1B Joe Robbins and C Zach Almond led an Osprey 10-hit attack to back the strong Osprey arms to the win. The Osprey took the rubber match of the three game series in the final regular season matchup of the year between the teams to improve their record to 12-9 in the half. The Missoula win coupled with the Billings Mustangs loss means that the second place Osprey gained a game to move only three games back.

The Osprey and Owlz traded zeros for the first two and a half innings of the game as Osprey starting pitcher Deyni Olivero and Orem starter John Swanda danced around base runners with key strikeouts. Olivero struck out 6 over the first three scoreless innings. The Osprey broke through on the scoreboard in the home half of the 3rd. With one out, SS Brandon Leyton singled and later scored on 3B Buddy Kennedy's single. Leyton originally stopped at third but advanced home on a throwing error by Orem's Justin Jones. C Zach Almond then promptly doubled home Kennedy with a blast off the wall in right center field to give Missoula a 2-0 lead after 3.

Olivero and the Osprey bullpen took command of the game at this point. He struck out the side in the 4th. He ran into a little trouble in the 5th after he hit C Griffin Barnes with a pitch. Barnes was later thrown out at the plate by Osprey RF David Sanchez after a Livan Soto single. In the 6th, reliever Jake Polancic came on and stranded two leadoff walks. Mailon Arroyo then completed the combined shutout by pitching a perfect 7th, 8th, and scoreless 9th.

Offensively, Missoula got some insurance in the bottom of the 4th with a solo homerun by 1B Joe Robbins and sac fly by Jesus Munoz. Then in the 7th, Leyton singled to open the inning and then stole second. Leyton was driven home by Almond via a single to right after Kennedy walked. CF Kristian Robinson then walked to bring up Robbins with the bases loaded. A wild pitch brought home the first run and then Robbins cleared the bases with a double to make it 8-0 Missoula.

With Orem leaving town, the Osprey welcome the Grand Junction Rockies for a 4-game set beginning Monday night at Ogren Park Allegiance Field. Monday is Family Night benefiting the Missoula Food Bank. MISSOULA'S OTHER PRO TEAM - THE TIMBERJACKS

Before the Missoula Osprey entered the Pioneer League in 1999, the city in Western Montana had been part of the history of the League, with the five-year run of the Missoula Timberjacks. The Timberjacks played in the Pioneer League from 1956-60, finishing second in the league in 1958. The Jacks played as an independent in 1956 before beginning a three-season run as an affiliate of the Washington Senators. The Cincinnati Reds were the parent club of the Timberjacks in their final season, 1960. The Timberjacks' best season was in 1958, when they finished second in the Pioneer League, thanks in part to the pitching of Jim Kaat, who would eventually break into the majors with the Senators. He would be the last of the Senators who moved with the team to Minnesota to retire, and also enjoyed a long career as a broadcaster.
