TONIGHT'S GAME

The Round Rock Express hit the road to begin a five-game series against the Iowa Cubs on Thursday night. E-Train RHP Jose Urquidy is slated to start opposite I-Cubs RHP Matt Swarmer. First pitch at Principal Park is scheduled for 7:08 p.m.

BROADCAST INFORMATION

Tonight's game can be heard live on the flagship home of the Round Rock Express, AM 1300 The Zone. Online audio is also available at am1300thezone.iheart.com and via the iHeartRadio app. Express Director of Broadcasting Mike Capps handles play-by-play duties.

LAST TIME OUT

The Round Rock Express settled for a series split with the Tacoma Rainiers after dropping Tuesday night's finale by a final score of 3-1. In the opening frame, Rainiers 3B Shed Long opened the scoring with a solo home run. However, Round Rock quickly leveled the score in the home half when SS Alex De Goti and RF Derek Fisher teamed up for a pair of singles. De Goti then advanced to third when 2B Josh Rojas worked a walk. DH Kyle Tucker then grounded into a double play that allowed De Goti to touch home plate. The tie remained until the fourth inning, when Tacoma DH Robert Perez shot a line drive into center field, a hit that resulted in an inside-the-park home run. In the seventh, Rainiers SS Kelby Tomlinson tallied a single before a Billy Cooke fielder's choice. On the play, a Reynin Guduan throwing error allowed Cooke to reach safely while Tomlinson advanced to third. An ensuing Kristopher Negron sacrifice fly extended the final score to 3-1. Express starter RHP Akeem Bostick allowed only three hits and two runs while striking out seven, but the righty suffered a tough-luck loss in the series finale.

URQUIDY DAY

Round Rock RHP Jose Urquidy is set to start opposite Cubs RHP Matt Swarmer on Thursday night. The starter has been solid for Round Rock in six appearances, averaging 13.6 strikeouts-per-nine innings to only 2.3 walks. Urquidy has punched out 48 hitters in his six outings, trailing only LHP Ryan Hartman (58) and RHP Cy Sneed (53). The righty holds an impressive 3.41 ERA ahead of Thursday night's contest. In games that Urquidy pitches, the Express have outscored opponents 41-34.

OFF TO IOWA!

The Round Rock Express kick off a nine-game road trip with a five-game series against the Iowa Cubs. The foes split their first series in Round Rock as Iowa won the series opener and finale, while the E-Train took games two and three. In the series, Express C Lorenzo Quintana went 4-12 (.333) with two home runs and four RBI. Additionally, RHP Ralph Garza holds a perfect 0.00 ERA against the Chicago Cubs' top affiliate after holding the team without a run in 3.2 innings of relief.

A RARE NIGHT FOR ROUND ROCK

On Tuesday night, Round Rock suffered a 3-1 loss to the Tacoma Rainiers, a performance in which the E-Train recorded only three hits. In 71 games on the season, the team has notched less than five hits only seven times. When tallying less than five hits, the Express hold a 1-6 record. However, Round Rock has piled on 15 or more hits in eight games, including three in June: June 6 at Las Vegas (24), June 8 at Salt Lake (23) and June 15 vs Tacoma (24).

AMONG THE BEST

Round Rock OF Kyle Tucker is currently tied for the most home runs in all of Minor League Baseball with 23. The outfielder sits atop the list with former teammate and current Houston Astros OF Yordan Alvarez. One more shot would push Tucker to the top of the standings. Not surprisingly, the left-handed hitter performs far better against right-handed pitchers, with 15 of his homers coming against righties.

RECENT TRANSACTIONS

Express INF Austin Dennis rejoins the team from Class A Quad Cities ahead of tonight's series opener. Dennis is seeking his Triple-A debut in his second stint with Round Rock. In a corresponding move, RHP Justin Ferrell was reassigned to Double-A Corpus Christi. On Wednesday's off-day, rehabbing Houston Astros 2B Jose Altuve returned to the majors while OF Derek Fisher was added to the Temporary Inactive List.

The Round Rock Express are celebrating their 20th anniversary season in 2019. The club was originally founded in 2000 as the Double-A affiliate of the Houston Astros, winning the Texas League in their inaugural season. The Express advanced to the Triple-A Pacific Coast League in 2005.

NO STRANGERS TO THE PCL GAME

Eighteen players have made their Triple-A debut with the Express in 2019: RHP Brandon Bielak, RHP Ronel Blanco, RHP Jose Bravo, RHP Humberto Castellanos, C Oscar Campos, RHP Tanner Duncan, RHP Justin Ferrell, LHP Ryan Hartman, RHP Corbin Martin, RHP Hunter Martin, C Lorenzo Quintana, INF Josh Rojas, RHP Kit Scheetz, INF Anibal Sierra, RHP Jose Urquidy, RHP Gabriel Valdez, RHP Forrest Whitley and OF Stephen Wrenn. The remaining 25 players that have suited up for Round Rock in 2019 all appeared for the Fresno Grizzlies at some point in 2018. The Grizzlies, who served as Houston's Triple-A affiliate from 2015-2018, fell to the Memphis Redbirds 3-1 in the best-of-five Pacific Coast League Championship Series a year ago.

STATING THE FACTS

American-born players on Round Rock's roster hail from 17 different states: Alabama, Arizona, California, Florida, Georgia, Indiana, Massachusetts, Missouri, Nevada, New Jersey, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, Virginia and Washington. The squad features four players from the State of Texas: RHP Ralph Garza (Edinburg), RHP Corbin Martin (Houston), RHP Brady Rodgers (Richmond) and RHP Forrest Whitley (San Antonio).

AROUND THE WORLD

Six different nations are represented on the Express roster. In addition to the 19 players from the United States, C Lorenzo Quintana hails from Cuba while LHP Reymin Guduan and RHP Ronel Blanco are natives of the Dominican Republic, RHP Gabriel Valdez is from Panama, RHP Humberto Castellanos and RHP Jose Urquidy are from Mexico and rehabbing Houston Astros INF Jose Altuve is from Venezuela.

IN THE TRAINING ROOM

There are currently five players on the injured list: RHP Forrest Whitley (5/29), RHP Gabriel Valdez (6/3), RHP Dean Deetz (6/6), RHP Ronel Blanco (6/15) and RHP Brady Rodgers (6/16).

EXPRESS MANAGER MICKEY STOREY

Mickey Storey joins the Express from the Class-A Quad Cities River Bandits, where he began his managerial career in 2018. The 32-year-old skipper led the River Bandits to an 81-59 record in 2018, the second-best mark in the Midwest League and the club's highest win total since 2015. Prior to his time in Quad Cities, Storey served as the Development Coach at Class-A Advanced Buies Creek in 2017. The former right-handed pitcher had a nine-year professional playing career that included one season with the Astros in 2012 in which he posted a 3.86 ERA in 26 appearances with the Major League club.



Storey was born in Fort Lauderdale, Florida, where he attended nearby Deerfield Beach High School before moving on to Florida Atlantic University in Boca Raton. He was drafted twice in his career, first by the Minnesota Twins in the 22nd round of the 2007 MLB Draft and again by the Oakland Athletics in the 31st round of the 2008 MLB Draft. During his nine-year professional career, Storey pitched at every level of affiliated baseball, including stints with Sacramento and Oklahoma City in the Pacific Coast League. He also posted winter ball stints in the Dominican Republic, Mexico and Venezuela. He finished his playing career in 2016 following two seasons with the Somerset Patriots of the independent Atlantic League. In total, the righty amassed a career 3.52 ERA in 385 games.
