## CHIHUAHUA BITES

### CHIHUAHUAS SPLIT DAYTIME DOUBLEHEADER WITH IOWA

■ The El Paso Chihuahuas split a doubleheader on Monday afternoon, losing game one 6-5 and winning game two 3-0, to take the four-game series from the Iowa Cubs 3-1. The Chihuahuas chased Iowa starter Jen-Ho Tseng from game one after 0.2 innings pitched, thanks to a three-run first. El Paso held leads of 3-1 and 4-3 and tied the game at five in the fifth, before eventually losing 6-5 on a sixth inning sacrifice fly. Game two featured a pitchers duel between El Paso's Seth Simmons and Iowa's Alec Mills, with the game remaining scoreless into the fourth. Javy Guerra then delivered the big blow with his seventh home run of the season, a two-run shot to give the Chihuahuas a 2-0 lead. Shane Peterson would plate a seventh inning insurance run with a pinch-hit RBI single, while Simmons, Colten Brewer and Robert Stock did the rest, keeping Iowa off the board in the 3-0 win.

### FIRST DOUBLE DIP OF 2018

■ El Paso split their first doubleheader of the season on Monday afternoon. The doubleheader was El Paso's first since 8/26/17 against Sacramento (also split) and their first on the road since 8/6/17 at New Orleans.

### ALLEN CRAIG HITS HIS STRIDE

■ Allen Crag hit .229 in 14 games during the month of April and has hit .302 in 29 games since. Six of his eight home runs and 20 of his 26 RBIs have come since the month of May began. Craig is currently riding a season high eight-game hitting streak and is hitting .278 on the season.

### SHUTDOWN INNINGS

■ Coming into the May 10th game El Paso pitchers had only secured a "shutdown inning" in 14 of 27 (52%) innings that the offense had scored during the first nine game of May. In the past 31 games, El Paso is 45-for-62 in such opportunities, raising the conversion percentage to 66% (59-for-89).

### QUICK HITS

■ Colten Brewer picked up his first win of the season in game two on Monday afternoon...El Paso has the least home wins (10) and the most road wins (22) in the PCL...the Chihuahuas went eight days (6/5-6/13) without a roster move, the longest period of time without one this season.

### ROSTER MOVES

■ Today, RHP Miguel Diaz was assigned to Double-A San Antonio. There will be no corresponding moves, putting the active roster at 24 players.

### CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

**2018:** Began the season on El Paso's opening day roster...hit his first career HR on 4/21 at LV...made his MLB debut on 6/1 vs the Reds, pitching 3.2 innings and giving up four earned runs.

**2017:** Went 5-2, with a 4.39 ERA in 10 starts with the Chihuahuas...was on the disabled list from 6/2-8/18...made four rehab starts with the AZL Padres, going 0-1, with a 5.40 ERA.

**2016:** Hit four levels of the Padres system (Fort Wayne, Lake Elsinore, San Antonio, El Paso), combining for a 10-9 record, with a 2.96 ERA...struck out 123, compared to 24 walks in 28 appearances...made three postseason starts for El Paso, including the Triple-A Championship game, in which he was tagged with the loss.

**2015:** Split the season between Fort Wayne, Tri-City and the AZL Padres, going 4-4, with a 4.14 ERA...was named to the Northwest League Postseason All-Star team for Tri-City.

**2014:** Appeared in five games between Short-A Eugene and Single-A Fort Wayne, going 0-2, with an 11.70 ERA.

**2013:** Made three relief appearances for the AZL Padres, going 0-0, with an 11.57 ERA. **2012:** Began his professional career with the AZL Padres, going 0-1, with a 4.34 ERA in 10 appearances.

**Personal** – Full name Andrew Walker Lockett...attended Providence HS and led his team to the Florida Class 2A regional finals in 2011 and was named the Florida Times-Union All-First Coast Player of the Year...hit .468, with 18 home runs and 57 RBIs in 2011...had committed to South Florida before signing with the Padres.
