**LAST TIME OUT:** Daytona snapped a 3-game losing streak on Sunday afternoon, as the Tortugas defeated the St. Lucie Mets, 7-4, at First Data Field... Game was called after 7 innings and a 30-minute delay due to torrential rain and field conditions...Tortugas took the lead for good in the top of the 4th on a sacrifice fly by 2B **Alejo López** (1-1, 2 R, RBI, 2 BB)...**CF Andy Sugilio** (1-4, R, HR, 3 RBI) added a 3-run blast in the 6th...**LF Drew Mount** (3-3, R, RBI) collected a season-high 3 hits, while **RF Lorenzo Cedrola** (2-4, R) also accrued a multi-hit game...**DH Wagner Lagrange** (2-4, R, 2B, RBI, SO) and **LF Blake Tiberi** (2-2, 2B, RBI, 2 BB) each garnered multi-hit performances for St. Lucie...RHP **Aaron Fossas** (6.0 IP, 6 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 3 BB, 3 SO) tossed his 3rd-straight quality start for Daytona and earned his 1st Florida State League win of the year...Mets RHP **Kyle Wilson** (3.1 IP, 6 H, 3 R, 3 ER, BB, 2 SO) failed to make it out of the 4th and took his 8th defeat in his 1st start back off the injured list...Mets manager **Chad Kreuter** was ejected in the bottom of the 6th for arguing about a non-balk call by HP umpire **Jude Koury**...Mets SS **Cody Bohanek** and Tortugas RHP **Julio Pinto** were ejected in the top of the 7th after a benches-clearing incident.

**TONIGHT'S STONE CRABS STARTER:** Charlotte is scheduled to give the ball to LHP **Michael Plassmeyer** in the series opener on Monday night...Did not receive a decision in his last start on Tuesday night vs. Bradenton (5.1 IP, 5 H, 4 R, 2 ER, BB, 6 SO)...Named Florida State League Pitcher of the Week after punching out a career-high 9 on July 30 at Bradenton (7.0 IP, 4 H, 9 SO)...Took a no-decision in his lone start vs. Daytona on May 14 (4.2 IP, 7 H, 3 R, 3 ER, BB, 3 SO)...**Plassmeyer was transferred from Low-A Bowling Green on May 8**...Composed a 2-1 record with a 1.23 ERA (4 ER in 29.1 IP) and 32 strikeouts in 5 starts for the Hot Rods...Acquired by the Tampa Bay Rays from the Seattle Mariners with **C Mike Zunino** and **OF Guillermo Heredia** in exchange for **OF Mallex Smith** and **OF Jake Fraley** on November 8, 2018...Spent his first pro season with Short-Season Everett in 2018...Named a Northwest League Mid-Season All-Star after tallying an 0-1 mark with a 2.25 ERA (6 ER in 24.0 IP) and 44 K's in 13 appearances (12 starts) for the Aqua Sox...Selected by the Seattle Mariners in the 4th round of the 2018 MLB Draft out of the University of Missouri...Signed for \$425,000.

**FLOATING AWAY:** Daytona's series finale in St. Lucie on Sunday afternoon was cut short due to torrential rain and unplayable field conditions...The Tortugas were granted a 7-4 victory after 7 innings...The rain-shortened victory was Daytona's first game in 2019 to be halted before playing 9 innings due to weather...The last time Daytona had a game halted before 9-full frames could be completed in a non-doubleheader contest was in a 12-1 loss at Lakeland on August 16, 2018...That contest was cut short after 4 1/2 innings due to rain...The Tortugas had not won a game of that nature since they defeated the Charlotte Stone Crabs at The Jack, 2-1, on April 9, 2018...That contest was put to a stop due to rain with 1 out in the bottom of the 6th.

**SWIPER NO SWEEPING:** The Tortugas avoided being swept for the 4th time this season on Sunday afternoon with a 7-4 win at St. Lucie in a 7-inning, rain-shortened ballgame...Daytona has not been swept since they dropped all 3 games for the just 3rd time this season at Jupiter from July 30-August 1...Daytona was also swept for from July 4-7 at First Data Field and had not been swept at all until they dropped all 3 affairs to the Dunedin Blue Jays at Jackie Robinson Ballpark from June 28-30...Prior to that, the 'Tugas hadn't have been swept in a series of 3+ games at home since they dropped 4 in a-row to Lakeland from July 7-10, 2017...Daytona is 4-3 in 7 games when they have the potential to be swept (36-32)...The Tortugas themselves have completed 6 sweeps this season.

**REY OF LIGHT:** The Daytona Tortugas made a pair of roster moves prior to Thursday's series opener in St. Lucie...The Tortugas added OF/IF **Brian Rey** from Low-A Dayton and transferred IF **Yonathan Mendoza** to Double-A Chattanooga...**Rey is a native of Deltona, Fla. and grew up roughly 34 minutes and 26.0 miles southwest of Jackie Robinson Ballpark**...In 66 games for the Dragons, the 21-year-old slashed .281/.326/.464...Overall, Rey was a .281 hitter (.66-236) with 31 runs scored, 16 doubles, 9 home runs, and 40 RBI...The versatile player did not join Dayton until May 16 from extended spring training...From the time of his arrival until his departure, Rey ranked 6th in the Midwest League in slugging (.468) and RBI (40)...He was also tied for 8th in extra-base hits (25) and total bases (108), 9th in OPS (.795), and 10th in batting average (.281)...Throughout the course of the season, Rey left Dayton with 14th 2nd-most home runs (9) on the team...Also was 3rd in extra-base hits (25) and 3rd in doubles (16)...**On July 27 at Fort Wayne, the 21-year-old set a Daytona franchise record with 8 RBI (3-5, 3 R, 2B, 2 HR, 8 RBI, 2 SO)**...Rey was selected by the Cincinnati Reds in the 13th round of the 2018 MLB Draft out of Miami Dade College (Fla.).

**ONE-TWO STEP:** The Tortugas have played a plethora of tight games throughout the course of the 2019 season...Coming into Monday's showdown, Daytona has played in 45 1-run games during the campaign (38.5%)...In those contests, the Tortugas are nearly even, accumulating a 23-22 record...As expected, Daytona is 15-10 in 1-run contests at home and 8-12 on the road...In 2018, the 'Tugas battled in 41 contests decided by a run and went 21-20...The 45 affairs determined by a tally are the most Daytona has played in a single-season since they rebranded prior to the 2015 campaign...Only in 2006 has the Daytona franchise played more 1-run ballgames when they embarked in 48 of them (27-21)...The Tortugas have also contested in 21 games that have been decided by exactly 2 runs (14-7)...Overall, 56.4% (66-of-117) of Daytona's games this season have been decided by 2-runs-or-less.

**FOUR SQUARE:** Daytona's lucky number on offense this season has been 4...Entering Monday's ballgame, when the Tortugas score 4-or-more runs in a contest they hold an impressive 49-15 record (.766)...However, when opposing pitching holds them to 3-or-fewer tallies, Daytona's team record dips to 8-45 (.151)...Wednesday's 3-2 walk-off win over Florida was the first time the Tortugas had won a 9-inning contest when scoring less than 3 runs since a 2-1 win in Fort Myers on July 9...The Tortugas had not lost when scoring that many in a single game since an 8-7 loss at Tampa on July 22...Prior to Sunday's 7-4 win over St. Lucie, Daytona had not scored 4+ runs in a 9-or-fewer inning game since they were victorious at Florida, 8-1, in the 1st game of a twinbill on July 26 (15 G).

**NORTHERN LIGHTS:** The Tortugas have seen vastly different results depending on which division they go up against...Against fellow North Division squads, Daytona enters Monday with an impressive 39-26 record...They are 19-8 in true road games against North Division opponents, excluding the 3-game series against Dunedin that was moved to Daytona due to ballpark renovations at Dunedin Stadium...However, against the South Division, the Tortugas hold a 18-34 clip...Daytona has hit much better against in-division pitching, tallying a .260 average (.557-2144) against the North and just a .231 clip (.407-1759) vs. the South...The Tortugas average 4.68 runs, 8.57 hits, 3.03 walks, and 8.37 strikeouts per contest (65 G) against their division rivals...Versus the South, Daytona's averages dip to 3.13 runs, 7.83 hits, 2.77 walks, and 7.96 strikeouts a game (52 G)...The Tortugas' pitching staff, however, has fared slightly better against the South...Against cross-division opponents, Daytona has a 3.85 ERA (195 ER in 455.2 IP) and yield 8.48 hits, 4.23 runs, 3.08 walks, and 8.00 strikeouts per contest...Taking on the North, the Tortugas hold a 3.90 ERA (246 ER in 567.2 IP) with 8.69 hits, 4.29 runs, 2.72 walks, and 8.60 strikeouts in the average affair.

**LEADING THE BALE:** Several Tortugas are among the Florida State League leaders through their first 117 games...OF **Andy Sugilio** enters Monday 3rd in the league in batting average (.288) and 4th in hits (113)...After missing the season's first 20 games due to injury, SS **José García** has been a doubles machine and currently leads the FSL in that category (30)...He is also tied for 4th in hit-by-pitches (12) and tied for 8th in extra-base hits (36)...OF **Lorenzo Cedrola** is in a tie for 4th in the circuit in triples (7) and tied for 7th in hit-by-pitches (11)...INF **Jonathan India** - who was sent to Double-A Chattanooga on July 22 - is 5th in OPS (.756) and 7th in slugging (.410)...INF **Alejo López** is 2nd in the circuit in hits (117), 4th in batting average (.285), tied for 4th in runs scored (58), tied for 7th in hit-by-pitches (11), and 8th in on-base percentage (.356)...1B **Bruce Yari** has been patient at the plate, as he is 3rd in walks (51) and 5th in pitches seen (1,767)...He is also tied for 7th in RBIs in triples (6)...C **Mark Kolozsvary** is tied for the 4th-most hit-by-pitches (12)...RHP **Austin Orewiler** is tied for the FSL-lead in games started (22) and double plays induced (14)...He is also tied for 7th in the league in wins (7) and is 9th in innings pitched (109.2)...RHP **Mac Sceroler** is 6th in strikeouts (103)...RHP **Ryan Nutof** still paces the FSL in saves (9) - tied with Dunedin's RHP **Brad Wilson**, Charlotte's RHP **Chandler Raiden**, and Clearwater's LHP **Keylan Killgore** - despite a promotion to Chattanooga in mid-June...LHP **Andy Cox** is tied with the Michigan alum for the league-lead in saves...The southpaw has the most saves in the league since his FSL debut on May 17 at Tampa.
