LAST TIME OUT: The Tortugas captured their 2nd-consecutive win on Thursday night, as Daytona blanked the Charlotte Stone Crabs, 5-0, in front of 1,551 fans at Jackie Robinson Ballpark...SS José García (1-3, 2 R, HR, 2 RBI) began the night with a 2-run home run to left in the bottom of the 1st...C Hendrik Clementina (2-4, R, HR, RBI, 2 SO) added a solo shot to right in the 6th...2B Alejo López (2-4, 2 R) and RF Andy Sugilio (2-4, SO) each posted multi-hit nights for Daytona...RHP Ryan Lillie (6.0 IP, 2 H, 2 BB, 8 SO) struck out a season-high 8 over 6.0 innings of 2-hit ball en route to his 3rd victory in the Florida State League...RHP Diomar López (2.0 IP, H, 2 SO) and RHP Connor Bennett (1.0 IP, H, 2 SO) completed the 4-hit shutout by striking out 4 over 3.0 innings...Charlotte's RHP Drew Strotman (4.0 IP, 6 H, 3 R, 3 ER, 2 BB, 5 SO) suffered his 1st defeat.

TONIGHT'S CARDINALS STARTER: Palm Beach is expected to give the ball to RHP Álvaro Seijas in the series opener on Friday evening... Earned the win after tossing 6.0-shutout innings in the 2nd game of a doubleheader on Friday night vs. Clearwater (6.0 IP, 4 H, 3 BB, 5 SO)... Has been much better at home than on the road in the Florida State League...At Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium, the right-hander is 2-0 with a 1.06 ERA (2 ER in 17.0 IP) in 3 starts...In visiting parks, Seijas is 0-1 with a 5.23 ERA (12 ER in 20.2 IP) in 4 starts...**Transferred to Palm Beach from Low-A Peoria on July 3...**The 20-year-old compiled a 4-5 record with a 2.93 ERA (26 ER in 80.0 IP) and 71 strikeouts in 14 starts for the Chiefs...**Named a 2019 Midwest League Mid-Season All-Star...**Spent the entire 2018 campaign in Peoria...In 25 appearances (22 starts), Seijas collected a 5-8 mark with a 4.52 ERA (65 ER in 129.1 IP), 1 save, and 84 K's...**Signed by the St. Louis Cardinals as an international free agent on July 2, 2015, out of Maracay, Venezuela...Signed for \$762,500.**

DRAWING A BLANK: Daytona handed the Charlotte Stone Crabs just their 4th shutout loss of the season on Thursday night, as the Tortugas blanked the team with the best record in the Florida State League, 5-0...RHP Ryan Lillie (6.0 IP), RHP Diomar López (2.0), and RHP Connor Bennett (1.0 IP) combined on the 4-hit blanking...The shutout marked the 5th of the campaign for Daytona...**The Tortugas had not shutout an opponent since they blanked the Palm Beach Cardinals – also by a final 5-0 – on May 29 at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium...**LHP Reiver Sanmartin (6.0 IP), RHP Dauri Moreta (2.0), and RHP John Ghzyel (1.0) united on that shutout...**It was Daytona's first blanking at The Jack since they defeated the Lakeland Flying Tigers, 4-0, on May 10...**RHP Austin Orewiler (5.0 IP), RHP Michael Byrne (2.0), and RHP Aneurys Zabala (2.0) connected for that 4-hitter.

SUMMER WINDS BLOWING IN: Although the month of August has been unkind to Daytona record-wise, there have still been several key performers through the final month's first 15 games...**IF Alejo López** has been stellar, entering Thursday hitting at a .380 clip (19-50) with 8 runs scored, 2 triples, and 4 RBI in 14 contests...The 23-year-old is slashing .380/.421/.460 with a .881 OPS so far in August...**SS José García** has also been on a roll, accruing a .340 clip (17-50) with 5 doubles, a home run, 6 RBI, and 2 stolen bases in 13 games...**OF Drew Mount** has accumulated a .308 clip (8-26) in 8 affairs, while **1B Bruce Yari** is tallying a .278 mark (10-36) with 3 runs scored, 3 doubles, a triple, 4 RBI, 7 walks, and a .417 OBP in 11 games...RHP **Aaron Fossas** has spearheaded Daytona's rotation this month, tallying a 1-1 record with a 1.80 ERA (4 ER in 20.0 IP) with just 3 walks and 11 strikeouts over 3 starts...Out of the bullpen, RHP **Michael Byrne** has regained his All-American form...The 22-year-old holds a 1-0 mark with a perfect 0.00 ERA (0 ER in 8.0 IP) and 1 save...Byrne has issued just 3 hits with 8 strikeouts and 0 walks in his 6 relief outings.

THROUGH THE WIRE: The Tortugas have played a plethora of tight games throughout the course of the 2019 season...**Coming into Friday's showdown, Daytona has played in 47 1-run games during the campaign (38.8%)...**In those contests, the Tortugas are nearly even, accumulating a 24-23 record...As expected, Daytona is 16-11 in 1-run contests at home and 8-12 on the road...In 2018, the 'Tugas battled in 41 contests decided by a run and went 21-20...The 47 affairs determined by a tally are the most Daytona has played in a single-season since they rebranded prior to the 2015 campaign...**Only in 2006 has the Daytona franchise played more 1-run ballgames when they embarked in 48 of them (27-21)...**The Tortugas have also contested in 21 games that have been decided by exactly 2 runs (14-7)...**Overall, 56.2% (68-of-121) of Daytona's games this season have been decided by 2-runs-or-less.**

FOUR-MIDABLE: Daytona's lucky number on offense this season has been 4...**Entering Friday's ballgame, when the Tortugas score 4-or-more runs in a contest they hold an impressive 50-15 record (.769)...**However, when opposing pitching holds them to 3-or-fewer tallies, Daytona's team record dips to 9-47 (.161)...**Wednesday's 2-1 triumph over Charlotte was just the 2nd time Daytona had won a 9-inning contest when scoring less than 3 runs since a 2-1 win in Fort Myers on July 9...**Prior to Sunday's 7-4 win over St. Lucie, Daytona had not scored 4+ runs in a 9-or-fewer inning game since they were victorious at Florida, 8-1, in the 1st game of a twinbill on July 26 (15 G)...**Additionally, the Tortugas have scored more than 4 runs in a contest just twice in their last 21 games going back to that date.**

SOUTHERN DISCOMFORT: The Tortugas have seen vastly different results depending on which division they go up against...**Against fellow North Division squads, Daytona enters Thursday with an impressive 39-26 record...**They are 19-8 in true road games against North Division opponents, excluding the 3-game series against Dunedin that was moved to Daytona due to ballpark renovations at Dunedin Stadium...**However, against the South Division, the Tortugas hold just a 20-36 clip...**Daytona has hit much better against in-division pitching, tallying a .260 average (.557-2144) against the North and just a .233 clip (.439-1882) vs. the South...The Tortugas average 4.68 runs, 8.57 hits, 3.03 walks, and 8.37 strikeouts per contest (65 G) against their division rivals...Versus the South, Daytona's averages dip to 3.11 runs, 7.84 hits, 2.70 walks, and 7.86 strikeouts a game (56 G)...The Tortugas' pitching staff hasn't fared much better against the South, either...Against cross-division opponents, Daytona has a 3.84 ERA (210 ER in 491.2 IP) and yield 8.46 hits, 4.23 runs, 3.05 walks, and 7.96 strikeouts per contest...Taking on the North, the Tortugas hold a 3.90 ERA (246 ER in 567.2 IP) with 8.69 hits, 4.29 runs, 2.72 walks, and 8.60 strikeouts in the average affair.

TOP-RANKED 'TUGAS: Several Tortugas are among the Florida State League leaders through their first 121 games...**OF Andy Sugilio** enters Friday 4th in the league in hits (117), 5th in batting average (.287), and tied for 6th in stolen bases (21)...After missing the season's first 20 games due to injury, **SS José García** has been a doubles machine and currently leads the FSL in that category (32)...He is also tied for 3rd in hit-by-pitches (13) and extra-base hits (39), as well as 9th in slugging (.407)...**OF Lorenzo Cedrola** is in a tie for 5th in the circuit in triples (7) and 6th in hit-by-pitches (12)...**INF Jonathan India** – who was sent to Double-A Chattanooga on July 22 – is 7th in OPS (.756) and slugging (.410)...**INF Alejo López** is 2nd in the circuit in hits (125), 3rd in batting average (.294) and runs scored (61), 6th in on-base percentage (.361), 8th in hit-by-pitches (11) and tied for 9th in total bases (152)...**1B Bruce Yari** has been patient at the plate, as he is 3rd in walks (54) and 5th in pitches seen (1,819)...He is also tied for 8th in triples (6)...**C Mark Kolozsvary** is tied for the 3rd-most hit-by-pitches (13)...**C Hendrik Clementina** enters the day 8th in home runs (12)...**RHP Austin Orewiler** has the FSL-lead in double plays induced (15) and starts made (23)...He is also 7th in innings pitched (114.0) and tied for 9th in the league in wins (7)...**RHP Mac Sceroler** is 6th in strikeouts (107), 8th in batting average against (.235), and 9th in WHIP (1.16)...**After Thursday, RHP Ryan Lillie** is 6th in ERA (3.16), 7th in BAA (.233), and 8th in WHIP (1.15)...**RHP Ryan Nutof** still paces the FSL in saves (9) – tied with Dunedin's RHP **Brad Wilson**, Charlotte's RHP **Chandler Raiden**, and Clearwater's RHP **Keylan Killgore** – despite a promotion to Chattanooga in mid-June...**LHP Andy Cox** is tied with the Michigan alum for the league-lead in saves...The southpaw has the most saves in the league since his FSL debut on May 17 at Tampa.
