LAST TIME OUT: Earned the victory on Saturday night vs. Palm Beach...Surrendered 4 runs on 6 hits in 5.0 innings of work...Did not walk a batter and punched out 6...Yielded a pair of solo home runs to RF **Chase Pinder** and 1B **Luken Baker** in the top of the 1st...Threw 86 pitches and 58 strikes (67.4%)...Relieved by RHP **Aneury Zabala** in the top of the 6th with Daytona leading, 5-4...Tortugas went on to beat the Cardinals, 6-5.

- 2-3 with a 4.04 ERA (40 ER in 89.0 IP), 24 walks, and 102 strikeouts in 18 starts
