LAST TIME OUT: Daytona earned their 3rd-straight victory – and their 2nd-consecutive in comeback fashion – as the Tortugas rallied to defeat the St. Lucie Mets, 6-5, in front of 1,858 fans at Jackie Robinson Ballpark on Tuesday night...Daytona took the lead for good in the bottom of the 6th on a solo home run by C **Hendrik Clementina** (4-4, R, 2B, HR, 2 RBI) and a go-ahead, 2-run double from LF **Drew Mount** (2-3, R, 2B, 2 RBI)...RF **Andy Sugilio** (2-4, RBI) also added a multi-hit performance for the 'Tugas...LF **Zach Ashford** (4-5, R, 2B, 2 RBI) led St. Lucie's attack with a career-high 4 hits...DH **Mitch Ghelfi** (2-4, R) and SS **Manny Rodriguez** (2-4, 2B, 2 RBI) garnered multiple knocks for the Mets, as well...RHP **Julio Pinto** (2.0 IP, 3 H, 2 SO) hurled 2.0 scoreless frames for his 2nd win in relief...RHP **Dauri Moreta** (2.0 IP, 5 R, 5 ER, BB, 5 SO) was perfect in the 8th and 9th for his 2nd save...Daytona's RHP **Aaron Fossas** (5.0 IP, 9 H, 5 R, 5 ER, 2 BB) took a no-decision...St. Lucie's RHP **Luc Rennie** (5.2 IP, 8 H, 6 R, 4 ER, BB, 5 SO) was saddled with his 8th defeat.

TONIGHT'S METS STARTER: RHP **Joe Cavallaro** is scheduled to take the mound for St. Lucie in the 3rd game of the series on Wednesday evening...Suffered his 2nd-consecutive loss in his last start on Friday night vs. Jupiter (5.0 IP, 6 H, 3 R, 2 ER, 4 SO)...Earned the victory in his last start against the Tortugas on August 9 at First Data Field (5.2 IP, 4 H, 2 R, ER, BB, 3 SO)...Cavallaro holds a 2-0 clip and a 1.93 ERA (3 ER in 14.0 IP) with 7 BB and 6 K's in 3 appearances (2 starts) against the Tortugas...Holds a 3-2 mark with a 3.31 ERA (13 ER in 35.1 IP) and 33 SO in 7 starts since returning to the rotation on July 19...Has fared better at home than on the road in 2019...At First Data Field, Cavallaro has accumulated a 4-2 clip with a 2.50 ERA (11 ER in 39.2 IP), 1 save, and 36 K's in 14 appearances (4 starts)...On the road, he is 2-3 with a 5.09 ERA (20 ER in 35.1 IP), 2 saves, and 34 SO in 17 outings (3 starts)...Spent time with Low-A Columbia, Double-A Binghamton, and St. Lucie in 2018...Was a South Atlantic League Mid-Season All-Star with Low-A Columbia, managing a 8-2 mark with a 2.09 ERA (18 ER in 77.1 IP) and 83 SO in 13 appearances (12 starts)...Transferred to Double-A Binghamton on July 5 and took a no-decision in his lone start that day vs. Erie (5.0 IP, 9 H, 5 R, 5 ER, BB, 5 SO)...Joined St. Lucie on July 7 and went 2-4 with a 4.84 ERA (24 ER in 44.2 IP) in 9 appearances (8 starts) throughout the rest of the year...Selected by the New York Mets in the 24th round of the 2017 MLB Draft out of the University of South Florida...Signed for \$100,000.

YOUNG, WILD (CARD), & FREE: Entering Wednesday's contest with St. Lucie, the Tortugas are in a virtual tie with the Clearwater Threshers for what would be the final playoff spot in the Florida State League North Division with 5 games remaining in the 2019 regular season...Clearwater holds the tiebreaker over Daytona as a result of winning the season-series (4-8), but Daytona has the tiebreaker over the Lakeland Flying Tigers (11-1), who are currently a half-game back...The wild card comes into play if the Dunedin Blue Jays – who won the first-half crown – wins both halves...Right now, Dunedin is a half-game ahead of the Lakeland for 1st in the second-half standings...Daytona would hold a playoff spot by themselves entering Thursday should they defeat the Mets, Dunedin sweeps their doubleheader from Fort Myers, and Lakeland defeats Clearwater on Wednesday...The wild card is determined by the team with the 2nd-best overall record in the division throughout the entire 2019 regular season...The Fort Myers Miracle were the first-half champions in the South Division, while the Charlotte Stone Crabs clinched the second-half crown on Saturday evening...Daytona has not won a second-half crown since the franchise rebranded prior to the 2015 season...The last time the organization emerged on top in the season's second half was in 2014 when they finished 41-27, 3.5 games ahead of the then-Tampa Yankees...The Tortugas have only once earned a wild-card bid to the playoffs...That came in 2015 when Clearwater won both halves... Daytona was 77-58 overall that season and beat out Tampa by 12.5 games for the playoff spot.

HENDRIK MOTOR SPORTS: C **Hendrik Clementina** is finishing the 2019 campaign with a flourish for the Tortugas...In 20 games over the season's final month, the 22-year-old has tallied a .316 average (24-76) with 9 runs scored, 2 doubles, 4 home runs, 20 RBI, and 4 walks...Clementina has slashed an impressive .316/.354/.500 with a .854 OPS, as well...Even though he was named a Florida State League Mid-Season All-Star, the Willemstad, Curaçao native accrued a .218 mark (36-174) with 9 runs scored, 6 doubles, 5 home runs, and 19 RBI in 46 games during the first half...However, since the All-Star break, Clementina has accumulated a .280 average (44-157) with 21 runs scored, 7 doubles, 9 homers, and 34 RBI with a .280/.335/.497 slashline with a .832 OPS in 43 affairs...Additionally, the slugger's K% has dropped from 27.9% in the first half to 22.5% in the second half...Since the second-leg of the campaign began on June 17, the backstop is tied for 7th in the FSL in home runs (9) and 8th in RBI (34).

JOSÉ CAN YOU SEE: SS **José García** was recognized as the Florida State League Player of the Week on Monday afternoon for the time between August 19-25...Over a span of 6 games, the 21-year-old slashed an impressive .500/.571/.708...Additionally, García compiled 7 runs scored, 2 doubles, a home run, 5 RBI, 3 walks, and 3 stolen bases...The Havana, Cuba native is the 2nd Tortuga to be recognized for a weekly honor this year, joining LHP **Reiver Sanmartín** who was the circuit's Pitcher of the Week from May 20-26...García is the first position player to be awarded since 1B **Ibaniel Isabel** was awarded the league's Player of the Week from August 6-12, 2018...Over the season's final month, the shortstop has been scalding hot...Through 24 games, García has registered a .383 average (36-94) with 18 runs scored, 10 doubles, 3 homers, 15 RBI, 3 walks, and 6 stolen bases...Among players qualifiers during the month, the Pompano Beach, Fla. resident is 2nd in all of High-A in batting average (.383)...He is also 3rd in hits (36), tied for 3rd in doubles (10), tied for 4th in extra-base hits (13), tied for 5th in total bases (55), tied for 6th in OBP (.427), 7th in slugging (.585) and OPS (1.012), and tied for 9th in runs scored (18).

SUMMER WINDS BLOWING IN: Although the month of August has been unkind to Daytona record-wise, there have still been several key performers through the final month's first 26 games...Outside of SS **José García**'s incredible month, IF **Alejo López** has been stellar, tallying a .320 clip (31-97) with 14 runs scored, 2 doubles, 2 triples, 9 RBI, 6 walks, and a pair of steals in 25 games...OF **Lorenzo Cedrola** has also shined with a .296 mark (21-71) with 7 runs, 3 doubles, 3 RBI, 4 walks, and a pair of swipes...OF **Drew Mount** has caught fire, too, tallying a .321 average (18-56) with 7 runs scored, 3 doubles, a triple and 9 RBI in 17 games...Out of the bullpen, RHP **Michael Byrne** has regained his All-American form...The 22-year-old holds a 2-0 mark with a perfect 0.00 ERA (0 ER in 11.0 IP) and 3 saves...Byrne has issued just 5 hits (.135 BAA) with 13 strikeouts and just 1 walk in his 9 relief outings.

THROUGH THE WIRE: The Tortugas have played a plethora of tight games throughout the course of the 2019 season...Coming into Wednesday's showdown, Daytona has played in 51 1-run games during the campaign (38.6%)...In those contests, the Tortugas are essentially even, accumulating a 26-25 record...As expected, Daytona is 18-11 in 1-run contests at home and 8-14 on the road...In 2018, the 'Tugas battled in 41 contests decided by a run and went 21-20...The Tortugas have official surpassed the most 1-run games played in franchise history, outdoing the 2006 campaign when the then-Cubs embarked in 48 of them (27-21)...The Tortugas have also contested in 21 games that have been decided by exactly 2 runs (14-7)...Overall, 54.5% (72-of-132) of Daytona's games this season have been decided by 2-runs-or-less.

FOUR-MIDABLE: Daytona's lucky number on offense this season has been 4...Entering Wednesday's ballgame, when the Tortugas score 4-or-more runs in a contest they hold an impressive 56-16 record (.778)...However, when opposing pitching holds them to 3-or-fewer tallies, Daytona's team record dips to 9-51 (.150)...August 14th's 2-1 triumph over Charlotte was just the 2nd time Daytona had won a 9-inning contest when scoring less than 3 runs since a 2-1 win in Fort Myers on July 9.

TOP-RANKED 'TUGAS: Several Tortugas are among the Florida State League leaders through their first 132 games...OF **Andy Sugilio** enters Wednesday 3rd in the league in hits (133) and batting average (.298), as well as tied for 5th in stolen bases (23)...After missing the season's first 20 games due to injury, SS **José García** has been an extra-base hit machine and currently leads the FSL in that category (46) and doubles (37)...He is also tied for 3rd in hit-by-pitches (16), 4th in slugging (.438), OPS (.780), and total bases (175), 9th in batting average (.280) and hits (112)...OF **Lorenzo Cedrola** is in a tie for 5th in the circuit in triples (7) and 8th in hit-by-pitches (12)...INF **Jonathan India** – who was sent to Double-A Chattanooga on July 22 – is 9th in OPS (.756) and 10th in slugging (.410) and OBP (.346)...INF **Alejo López** is 2nd in the circuit in hits (137), 3rd in runs scored (67), 5th in batting average (.290), tied for 5th in hit-by-pitches (14), and 8th in on-base percentage (.357)...1B **Bryce Uri** has been patient at the plate, as he is 2nd in walks (64) and 4th in pitches seen (2,020)...He is also tied for 8th in triples (6)...C **Mark Kolozsvary** is tied for the 3rd-most hit-by-pitches (16)...C **Hendrik Clementina** enters the day tied for 6th in home runs (14) and 7th in slugging (.414)...RHP **Austin Orewiler** has the FSL-lead in starts made (25) and is tied for the most double plays induced (15)...He is also 6th in innings pitched (121.1) and tied for 8th in the league in wins (8)...RHP **Mac Sceroler** is 3rd in strikeouts (119), 6th in batting average against (.235), and 7th in WHIP (1.15)...RHP **Ryan Lillie** is 8th in BAA (.240)...RHP **Ryan Nutof** – who returned to Daytona from Double-A Chattanooga on Monday – is tied with Clearwater's LHP **Keylan Killgore** for the FSL-lead in saves (10)...LHP **Andy Cox** is tied for the 2nd-most saves (9)...The southpaw is tied for the most saves in the league since his FSL debut on May 17 at Tampa.
