LAST TIME OUT: The Tortugas rallied in the bottom of the 10th to complete their 3rd-straight comeback against St. Lucie, as the Tortugas defeated the Mets, 3-2, in front of 2,377 fans at Jackie Robinson Ballpark...St. Lucie took a lead in the top of the 10th on an RBI ground-rule double from SS Manny Rodriguez (1-4, 2B, RBI, 2 SO)...Daytona walked-off the Mets in the bottom of the 10th, as 2 runs scored on a throwing error via a fielder's choice by CF Lorenzo Cedrola (1-5, RBI)...1B Bruce Yari (3-4, 2B, RBI, BB, SO) led the 'Tugas with a season-high-tying 3 hits...3B Blake Tiberi (2-4, R, SO) accrued a multi-hit night for the Mets...RHP Michael Byrne (1.0 IP, H, R) garnered his 7th win of the season in relief...Despite not giving up a hit, RHP Thomas McClraith (3.0 IP, 2 R, 2 BB, 4 SO) suffered his 5th loss for St. Lucie...Neither the Tortugas' RHP Mac Sceroler (7.0 IP, 3 H, R, 8 SO) or Mets' RHP Joe Cavallaro (6.1 IP, 6 H, R, ER, 3 BB, 4 SO) received decisions despite twirling quality starts.

TONIGHT'S METS STARTER: St. Lucie is set to hand the ball to RHP Colin Holderman for his Florida State League debut on Thursday...The 23-year-old was transferred from Low-A Columbia earlier in the day...Did not receive a decision in his last start for the Fireflies on Saturday evening at Rome (5.1 IP, 7 H, 3 R, 3 ER, BB, SO)...Registered a 3-2 mark with a 4.09 ERA (25 ER in 55.0 IP) in 13 appearances (12 starts) for Columbia...Began the year with the Fireflies and had a stint on the 7-day injured list from May 5 until June 14...Made a pair of rehab starts with Short-Season Brooklyn (0-0, 1.80 ERA, 5.0 IP, 2 H, 4 SO)...Missed the entire 2018 campaign due to injury...Spent the 2017 season with Brooklyn and Columbia, including a rehab outing with the Gulf Coast League Mets...Combined to tally a 2-3 mark with a 5.11 ERA (21 ER in 37.0 IP) with 30 strikeouts in 10 appearances (9 starts)...Selected by the New York Mets in the 9th round of the 2016 MLB Draft out of the Heartland C.C. (Normal, Ill.)...Signed for \$400,000...Had been committed to Mississippi State University before signing his pro contract.

A SERIES OF UNFORTUNATE EVENTS: As a result of Hurricane Dorian's impending landfall this weekend, the Florida State League announced that following Thursday's games, the remainder of the 2019 season - including the postseason - has been cancelled...This marks the 2nd time in 3 years that the FSL's season has been altered due to severe weather...In 2017, the league cancelled its Championship Series due to Hurricane Irma, leaving the Dunedin Blue Jays and Palm Beach Cardinals as co-champions...Prior to that, it last occurred due to Hurricane Ivan in 2004...When that championship series was washed out, it left the Daytona Cubs and the Tampa Yankees as co-title holders...All Daytona fans holding tickets for this weekend's scheduled games against the Jupiter Hammerheads can redeem them at the Tortugas' box office for tickets to any 2020 Daytona home game.

IT'S A WALK OFF: St. Lucie 1B Matt Winaker's throwing error on a fielder's choice off the bat of Daytona's CF Lorenzo Cedrola enabled the Tortugas to walk-off the Mets, 3-2, in 10 innings on Wednesday night...The walk-off victory was Daytona's 6th of the season...It was the 'Tugas first walk-off triumph since 1B Bruce Yari delivered a game-ending, 2-run triple in the bottom of the 9th to give Daytona a 3-2 win over the Florida Fire Frogs on August 7...Daytona had also garnered a game-ending victory when LF Stuart Fairchild brought home the winning run on a sacrifice fly in the bottom of the 10th against the Tampa Tarpons on July 3...The Tortugas have also won on a walk-off RBI single by 2B Alejo Lopez against Fort Myers on May 24, a bases-loaded walk in the 10th to Fairchild vs. Clearwater on May 22...Yari also played a role in Daytona's 1st walk-off winner of the year on April 24 vs. Dunedin, smashing a double with the winning run aboard...An error in right allowed the winning run to score on the play...The Tortugas themselves have been walked-off 6 times in 2019.

HENDRIK MOTOR SPORTS: C Hendrik Clementina is finishing the 2019 campaign with a flourish for the Tortugas...In 21 games over the season's final month, the 22-year-old has tallied a .313 average (25-80) with 9 runs scored, 2 doubles, 4 home runs, 21 RBI, and 5 walks...Clementina has slashed an impressive .313/.356/.488 with a .844 OPS, as well...Even though he was named a Florida State League Mid-Season All-Star, the Willemstad, Curaçao native accrued a .218 mark (38-174) with 9 runs scored, 6 doubles, 5 home runs, and 19 RBI in 46 games during the first half...However, since the All-Star break, Clementina has accumulated a .280 average (45-161) with 21 runs scored, 7 doubles, 9 homers, and 35 RBI with a .280/.337/.491 slashline with a .828 OPS in 44 affairs...Additionally, the slugger's K% has dropped from 27.9% in the first half to 22.5% in the second half...Since the second-leg of the campaign began on June 17, the backstop is tied for 7th in the FSL in home runs (9) and tied for 8th in RBI (35).

JOSÉ CAN YOU SEE: SS José García was recognized as the Florida State League Player of the Week on Monday afternoon for the time between August 19-25...Over a span of 6 games, the 21-year-old slashed an impressive .500/.571/.708...Additionally, García compiled 7 runs scored, 2 doubles, a home run, 5 RBI, 3 walks, and 3 stolen bases...The Havana, Cuba native is the 2nd Tortuga to be recognized for a weekly honor this year, joining LHP Reiver Sanmartín who was the circuit's Pitcher of the Week from May 20-26...García is the first position player to be awarded since 1B Ibandel Isabel was awarded the league's Player of the Week from August 6-12, 2018...Over the season's final month, the shortstop has been scalding hot...Through 25 games, García has registered a .378 average (37-98) with 20 runs scored, 10 doubles, 3 homers, 15 RBI, 3 walks, and 7 stolen bases...Among players qualifiers during the month, the Pompano Beach, Fla. resident is 2nd in all of High-A in batting average (.378)...He is also 3rd in hits (37), tied for 3rd in doubles (10), 6th in OPS (.997), tied for 6th in runs scored (2018), tied for 7th in extra-base hits (13), 8th in total bases (56), and 10th in slugging (.571)

THROUGH THE WIRE: The Tortugas have played a plethora of tight games throughout the course of the 2019 season...Coming into Thursday's showdown, Daytona has played in 52 1-run games during the campaign (39.1%)...In those contests, the Tortugas are essentially even, accumulating a 27-25 record...As expected, Daytona is 19-11 in 1-run contests at home and 8-14 on the road...In 2018, the 'Tugas battled in 41 contests decided by a run and went 21-20...The Tortugas have officially surpassed the most 1-run games played in franchise history, outdoing the 2006 campaign when the then-Cubs embarked in 48 of them (27-21)...The Tortugas have also contested in 21 games that have been decided by exactly 2 runs (14-7)...Overall, 54.9% (73-of-133) of Daytona's games this season have been decided by 2-runs-or-less.

FOUR-MIDABLE: Daytona's lucky number on offense this season has been 4...Entering Thursday's ballgame, when the Tortugas score 4-or-more runs in a contest they hold an impressive 56-16 record (.778)...However, when opposing pitching holds them to 3-or-fewer tallies, Daytona's team record dips to 10-51 (.164)...Thursday's 3-2 triumph over St. Lucie was just the 3rd time Daytona had won a 9-inning contest when scoring less than 3 runs since a 2-1 win in Fort Myers on July 9.

TOP-RANKED 'TUGAS: Several Tortugas are among the Florida State League leaders this season...OF Andy Sugilio enters the season finale 3rd in the league in hits (133), 4th in batting average (.294), as well as tied for 6th in stolen bases (23)...After missing the season's first 20 games due to injury, SS José García has been an extra-base hit machine and currently leads the FSL in that category (46) and doubles (37)...He is also tied for 3rd in hit-by-pitches (17), 4th in slugging (.436) and total bases (176), 5th in OPS (.779), 9th in batting average (.280) and tied for 9th in hits (113)...OF Lorenzo Cedrola is in a tie for 5th in the circuit in triples (7) and 8th in hit-by-pitches (12)...INF Jonathan India - who was sent to Double-A Chattanooga on July 22 - is 9th in OPS (.756) and 10th in slugging (.410) and OBP (.346)...INF Alejo Lopez is 2nd in the circuit in hits (138), 3rd in runs scored (67), 5th in batting average (.289), tied for 5th in hit-by-pitches (14), and 8th in on-base percentage (.356)...1B Bruce Yari has been patient at the plate, as he is 2nd in walks (65) and 4th in pitches seen (2,042)...He is also tied for 8th in triples (6)...C Mark Kolozsvary is tied for the 3rd-most hit-by-pitches (17)...C Hendrik Clementina enters the day 7th in home runs (14) and 8th in slugging (.412)...RHP Austin Orewiler has the FSL-lead in starts made (25) and is tied for the most double plays induced (15)...He is also 6th in innings pitched (121.1) and tied for 8th in the league in wins (8)...RHP Mac Sceroler leads the FSL in strikeouts (127), 3rd in batting average against (.239), 5th in WHIP (1.11), and 10th in innings pitched (117.0)...RHP Ryan Lillie is 8th in BAA (.240)...RHP Ryan Nutof - who returned to Daytona from Double-A Chattanooga on Monday and LHP Andy Cox are tied for the 2nd-most saves (9) in the circuit...The southpaw is tied for the most saves in the league since his FSL debut on May 17 at Tampa.
