Friday Recap: Bannon's homer edges Baysox past RubberDucks (Bowie 3, Akron 2): The RubberDucks twice took one-run leads on shortstop Ernie Clement's RBI singles, but the Bowie Baysox rallied to tie each time, and designated hitter Rylan Bannon hit a go-ahead, sixthinning solo home run to lead his team to a 3-2 victory and its first back-to-back wins against Akron this season at Prince George's Stadium on Friday night. The RubberDucks remain 11-4 against Bowie this season.

<u>Ducks visit Baysox:</u> The RubberDucks and Baysox are playing the fifth of six scheduled series this season, with 10 games scheduled at Canal Park and 11 at Prince George's Stadium. Akron leads the series, 11-2, and since 2005, leads 168-130. Last season, Akron went 13-8 against Bowie, including 8-3 at Prince George's Stadium. Bowie won the last series of the season, 3-1, in Akron. In 2018, Bowie finished fourth in the Western Division, at 67-71.

RubberDucks All-Stars: The RubberDucks had five players selected as All-Stars for the Western Division. The rosters were announced on Monday for the 2019 Eastern League All-Star Game in Richmond on July 10 at 7:05 p.m. They include first baseman Wilson Garcia (will not participate because of right foot sprain), outfielders Connor Marabell and Ka'ai Tom, and pitchers Eli Morgan and Kyle Nelson.

<u>Ducks flying out of the park:</u> The RubberDucks have hit an Eastern League-leading 66 home runs while allowing only 45 home runs (tied for third fewest among EL clubs) for a league-best +21 home run differential. In 41 road games, Akron has hit 41 home runs, allowing 25 (+16 differential). Of the RubberDucks' 66 home runs this season, 44 (two-thirds) have come in 15 multi-homer games, including 13 in four straight games May 9-13. Akron's six home runs on May 11 in Reading were the most for the club since hitting seven on July 2, 2008, in a 10-6 win at Erie.

Clement's strong return: Since returning from the Injured List on May 9, shortstop Ernie Clement has played 42 games, collecting 50 hits (tied for fourth in the Eastern League) and going 50-for-162 (.309, third in the EL) with 14 multi-hit games, seven doubles, two triples, a home run, 21 runs, 10 RBI, 12 walks, and a .367 OBP (seventh in the EL). Clement had a 14-game hitting streak June 6-19 and a season-long 20-game on base streak June 6-26, in which he was 26-for-79 (.329) with five doubles, one triple, eight runs, two RBI, three walks and a .365 OBP). He was on the Injured List with a right adductor strain April 16-May 8. In six games prior to going on the IL, the Indians No. 15 (MLB.com)/No. 18 (Baseball America) prospect was 3-for-25 (.120).

Monasterio resumes strong season: In his first season in Double-A and the Indians organization, infielder **Andruw Monasterio** missed 56 games (Injured List April 23-June 20) with a left oblique strain, but he returned to Akron June 21, hitting his first home run of the season in his first at-bat. Before going 0-for-4 Friday, he reached base in 19 straight games (every Eastern League game he has played, except the season opener).

Tom's hot stretch: Since April 30, outfielder Ka'ai Tom is leading the Eastern League in total bases (116), runs (37), on-base percentage (.422), slugging (.595) and OPS (1.017), is tied for the lead in home runs (12), is second in batting average (.328) and hits (64), and tied for second in extra-base hits (25). Tom had a 27-game on-base streak May 21-June 18 to tie Binghamton's Sam Haggerty (a RubberDuck in 2018) for the longest on-base streak in the EL this year. During the streak, Tom was 35-for-92 (.380) with seven doubles, seven home runs, 19 RBI, 19 runs and 17 walks for a .491 on-base percentage. Since May 10, he has hit safely in 38 of 45 games (56-for-160, .350 average, 12 home runs, 34 runs, 31 RBI), raising his average from .191 to a team-best .285. Tom leads the EL with 77 hits, 136 total bases, and 46 runs, and is tied for second in triples (5), fourth in on-base percentage (.379), slugging (.507) and OPS (.886), tied for fourth in home runs (13) and bases on balls (38), fifth in extra-base hits (29), seventh in RBI (40), and eighth in batting average (.285).

#### Tom making case for another Eastern League Player of the Month:

After last month he became the first Akron player to earn Eastern League Player of the Month since Tim Fedroff in May 2011, outfielder Ka'ai Tom has maintained stellar statistics. In June, he leads the league in total bases (53), on-base percentage (.407), slugging (.558) and OPS (.974). He is tied for second home runs (5), fourth in average (.316), tied for fourth in hits (30), walks (14) and RBI (17) and fifth in extra-base hits (11). In May, Tom led the league in May with a .434 OBP, .635 SLG, and 1.069 OPS, and tied for the lead with 21 runs. He was second in hits (32) and total bases (61), and tied for second in average (.333). After hitting .177 with one home run in 23 April games, Tom hit .333 (32-for-96) with seven home runs (tied for the team high and third in the league) in 26 May games. Tom was also the EL Player of the Week for May 20-26, when he was 9-for-20, with two doubles, two home runs (May 25 and 26), five runs, four RBI, and a league-best .850 SLG and 1.392 OPS. He is the first, and so far only, RubberDuck this season to win a weekly award. In 2018, he hit .286 in May (his best in any month) after hitting .183 in April.

Garcia's injury halts first Double-A season: First baseman and designated hitter Wilson Garcia was placed on the injured list June 21 with a right foot sprain, interrupting a stellar campaign. In his first season with the Indians organization and in Double-A, he still leads the Eastern League with 23 doubles. He is second in extra-base hits (33), tied for second in RBI (46), fifth in total bases (122, second on the club) and slugging (.475, second on the club), tied for ninth in home runs (10, tied for second on the club) and 10th in OPS (.785, second on the club). He is also second on the club with a .268 average. Originally signed by the Phillies in 2010, he was traded to the Orioles May 1, 2018, before the Indians acquired him in the December Rule 5 Draft.

<u>League leaders:</u> Akron leads the league in games (80), at-bats (2648), runs (334), hits (633), total bases (985), home runs (66) and RBI (306). While they average 4.18 runs per game this season, but since June 5, the RubberDucks have scored 72 total runs in the last 24 games (3.00/game).

#### LAST OUTING (Monday, June 24, at Harrisburg, ND in 3-2, 10-inning loss)

Morgan allowed two hits each in four of the first five innings but allowed only single runs in the first and fifth. Akron tied the game, 2-2, in the sixth inning, and Morgan lasted six innings for the fifth time in his last seven starts. Left-hander Anthony Gose pitched a scoreless seventh, and right-hander Robert Broom pitched two perfect innings before allowing the winning run in the 10th inning of a 3-2 loss.

#### Season Highlights

- Was the Carolina League's first Pitcher of the Week for April 4-14, after 11 scoreless innings and 15 strikeouts with three hits and two walks, beginning two combined shutouts for the Lynchburg Hillcats (A-Adv).
- Began the season with 14 consecutive scoreless innings.
- . Promoted to Akron for his first Double-A callup on May 6 and has allowed two earned runs or fewer in each of his first nine Eastern League starts.

#### 2018

- Went 9-7 with a 3.21 ERA, 1.10 WHIP and 156 strikeouts in 143.1 innings across two levels.
- Made Opening Day start for Lake County (A), and was promoted to Lynchburg (A-Adv) on May 16.
- Earned Pitcher of the Week honors three times, once with Lake County (A) and twice with Lynchburg (A-Adv).
- For second straight year, named Best Changeup in Indians Farm System by Baseball America.
- Named MiLB.com Indians Organizational All-Star (right-handed starting pitcher). Cleveland Indians Director of Player Development James Harris (to MiLB.com,
  October 2018): "Eli is one of those pitchers who gets a lot of swings and misses with his changeup. It's a real weapon for him and he isn't shy about using it. The
  challenge for him will be continuing that success as he moves through the higher levels. We feel he's a starter, and that's how we'll approach things with him moving
  forward, but he's certainly rising up our board quickly."

#### 2017

- Allowed just four earned runs across 35.0 innings for Mahoning Valley, and finished 2nd on the team with 58 strikeouts (14.91 K/9).
- His 1.03 ERA was good for the 3rd-lowest mark in the New York-Penn League (min. 35.0IP).

#### Amateur/Personal

- Pitched three seasons at Gonzaga University, earning First Team All-American from Perfect Game/Rawlings and First Team All-West Coast Conference as a junior in 2017, when he was 10-2 with a 2.86 ERA and 138 strikeouts (second most in program history) in 100 2/3 innings across 14 starts.
- Pitched 14 games (3 starts) as a freshman in 2015, but went 20-5 with 7 complete games and 5 shutouts over 30 starts his sophomore and junior seasons.
- Pitched for four years at Palos Verdes Peninsula High School in Rolling Hills, California.
- Father, Dave Morgan, is the former president of USA Today Sports Media Group, former executive editor for Yahoo Sports, and former deputy sports editor for the L.A. Times, where he spent more than 20 years. In 2008, Dave was named one of the "100 Most Influential People in Sports" by BusinessWeek, a list including commissioners from all the major North American sports leagues, influential team owners and broadcast and digital network executives.

# **2019 RUBBERDUCKS FIELD STAFF**

#24 Rouglas Odor, Manager (First Season) - Odor, 51, is the 18th manager in club history. He follows Tony Mansolino, who was promoted to Triple-A Columbus after guiding Akron to a 78-62 record and finish as runner-up in the 2018 Eastern League Championship Series against the New Hampshire Fisher Cats. Last season, Odor managed the Class-A Advanced Lynchburg Hillcats to their fourth consecutive postseason. After posting the Carolina League's worst first-half record of 29-38, the Hillcats rebounded to go 42-28 in the second half, claiming the Northern Division title. They fell to Potomac in the semifinals, three games to two. Odor has a 361-363 (.499) career managing record in 11 seasons.

When Odor was the RubberDucks hitting coach in 2014, he became the first person to wear the uniforms of the Canton-Akron Indians, Akron Aeros, and Akron RubberDucks. He played 197 games for Canton-Akron during the 1991, 1993-94 seasons, and he was the hitting coach for the Aeros' 2012 Eastern League Championship squad.

The 2019 season is Odor's 32nd in the Cleveland organization as a player or coach (19th as a coach). The former shortstop was a 32nd-round draft pick by the Indians in 1988 and played in the minor leagues for the Indians from 1988-94 and for the Milwaukee Brewers organization in 1995. Last season was Odor's first as a manager since 2008. He managed San Felipe in the Venezuelan Summer League for two seasons in 1999-2000, the Burlington Indians for four seasons from 2001-04, the Mahoning Valley Scrappers for two seasons in 2005-06, and the Gulf Coast League Indians for two seasons in 2007-08. Since then, Odor has moved up the ranks as a hitting coach, starting with Class-A Kinston in 2009-10, Akron in 2011-12 and 2014, the High-A Carolina Mudcats in 2013, and Triple-A Columbus in 2015-17.

The Maracaibo, Venezuela, native resides in Winter Haven, Florida, with his wife, Milagros. He has three sons and is the uncle of Texas Rangers infielder Rougned Odor.

#27 Tony Arnold, Pitching Coach (10th Season, not consecutive) — Arnold, 59, rejoins the RubberDucks for his fifth time in Akron after spending last season with Lynchburg. In 2018, the Hillcats pitching staff finished fifth in the Carolina League with a 3.76 ERA, ranked second with 1,190 strikeouts and the 12 team shutouts ranked fourth. Arnold last was with the RubberDucks in 2016-17, helping lead the 2016 team to an Eastern League championship. He previously served in the same capacity in Akron from 1996-99, 2008, and 2011-12. Arnold's 2012 Akron Aeros staff crafted a franchise-record 3.03 ERA and went on to claim the EL championship. In 2016, Arnold became the second man to wear the uniforms of the Canton-Akron Indians, Akron Aeros and Akron RubberDucks, joining Rouglas Odor in that exclusive group.

In 2015, Arnold began as the pitching coach at Lynchburg and finished at Triple-A Columbus, helping the Clippers to the International League title. A former All-American at the University of Texas, Arnold pitched in the major leagues with the Baltimore Orioles in 1986 and 1987.

#2 Justin Toole, Hitting Coach (First Season) — Toole, 32, spent the 2018 season as Lynchburg's hitting coach. This is fourth season coaching in the Indians' organization, serving as the hitting coach for Mahoning Valley in 2016, Lake County in 2017, and Lynchburg. Toole was signed as a minor league free agent by the Indians in 2009 and spent parts of seven seasons with Cleveland from 2009-15. He spent parts of 2010, 2012-15 with Akron, hitting .259 in 180 games, including .275 in 77 games under Odor's hitting-coach tutelage in 2014.
