Saturday Recap: RubberDucks squander 7-0 lead in 8-7 loss to Baysox (Bowie 8, Akron 7): The RubberDucks hit four home runs including their first grand slam of the season by Alex Call in a seasonhigh three-homer inning - to build a 7-0, third-inning lead, but the Bowie Baysox rallied with six runs in the third and two in the fifth inning for an 8-7 victory and third straight win at Prince George's Stadium on Saturday night. The RubberDucks remain 11-5 against Bowie this season.

**Ducks visit Baysox:** The RubberDucks and Baysox are playing the fifth of six scheduled series this season, with 10 games scheduled at Canal Park and 11 at Prince George's Stadium. Akron leads the series, 11-2, and since 2005, leads 168-131. Last season, Akron went 13-8 against Bowie, including 8-3 at Prince George's Stadium. Bowie won the last series of the season, 3-1, in Akron. In 2018, Bowie finished fourth in the Western Division, at 67-71.

RubberDucks All-Stars: The RubberDucks had five players selected as All-Stars for the Western Division. The rosters were announced on Monday for the 2019 Eastern League All-Star Game in Richmond on July 10 at 7:05 p.m. They include first baseman Wilson Garcia (will not participate because of right foot sprain), outfielders Connor Marabell and Ka'ai Tom, and pitchers Eli Morgan and Kyle Nelson.

<u>Ducks flying out of the park:</u> The RubberDucks have hit an Eastern League-leading 70 home runs while allowing only 47 home runs (fourth fewest among EL clubs) for a league-best +23 home run differential. In 42 road games, Akron has hit 45 home runs, allowing 27 (+18 differential). Of the RubberDucks' 70 home runs this season, 48 (69 percent) have come in 17 multi-homer games, including 13 in four straight games May 9-13. Akron's six home runs on May 11 in Reading were the most for the club since hitting seven on July 2, 2008, in a 10-6 win at Erie.

Clement's strong return: Since returning from the Injured List on May 9, shortstop Ernie Clement has played 42 games, collecting 52 hits (tied for third in the Eastern League) and going 52-for-167 (.311, third in the EL) with 15 multi-hit games, seven doubles, two triples, a home run, 22 runs, 10 RBI, 12 walks, and a .368 OBP (eighth in the EL). Clement had a 14game hitting streak June 6-19 and a season-long 20-game on base streak June 6-26, in which he was 26-for-79 (.329) with five doubles, one triple, eight runs, two RBI, three walks and a .365 OBP). He was on the Injured List with a right adductor strain April 16-May 8. In six games prior to going on the IL, the Indians No. 15 (MLB.com)/No. 18 (Baseball America) prospect was 3-for-25 (.120).

Monasterio resumes strong season: In his first season in Double-A and the Indians organization, infielder Andruw Monasterio missed 56 games (Injured List April 23-June 20) with a left oblique strain, but he returned to Akron June 21, hitting his first home run of the season in his first at-bat. Before going hitless Friday and Saturday, he reached base in 19 straight games (every Eastern League game he has played since April 5).

Tom's hot stretch: Since April 30, outfielder Ka'ai Tom is leading the Eastern League in batting average (.332), total bases (119), runs (38), onbase percentage (.426), slugging (.598) and OPS (1.024), and is tied for the lead in hits (66), home runs (12) and walks (31). Tom had a 27-game on-base streak May 21-June 18 to tie Binghamton's Sam Haggerty (a RubberDuck in 2018) for the longest on-base streak in the EL this year. During the streak, Tom was 35-for-92 (.380) with seven doubles, seven home runs, 19 RBI, 19 runs and 17 walks for a .491 on-base percentage. Since May 10, he has hit safely in 39 of 47 games (58-for-166, .349 average, 12 home runs, 35 runs, 31 RBI), raising his average from .191 to a team-best .286. Tom leads the EL with 79 hits, 140 total bases, and 47 runs, is second in on-base percentage (.384) and slugging (.507), tied for second in triples (5), third in OPS (.891), fourth in batting average (.286) and walks (41), tied for fourth in home runs (13), fifth in extra-base hits (30), and tied for seventh in RBI (40).

### Tom making case for another Eastern League Player of the Month:

After last month he became the first Akron player to earn Eastern League Player of the Month since Tim Fedroff in May 2011, outfielder Ka'ai Tom has maintained stellar statistics. In June, he leads the league in total bases (56), on-base percentage (.415), SLG (.566) and OPS (.981). He is third in average (.323), tied for third in hits (32) and homers (5), tied for fourth in walks (14) and RBI (17), fifth in extra-base hits (12) and tied for fifth in runs (17). In May, Tom led the league in May with a .434 OBP, .635 SLG, and 1.069 OPS, and tied for the lead with 21 runs. He was second in hits (32) and total bases (61), and tied for second in average (.333). After hitting .177 with one home run in 23 April games, Tom hit .333 (32-for-96) with seven home runs (tied for the team high and third in the league) in 26 May games. Tom was also the EL Player of the Week for May 20-26, when he was 9-for-20, with two doubles, two home runs (May 25 and 26), five runs, four RBI, and a league-best .850 SLG and 1.392 OPS. He is the first, and so far only, RubberDuck this season to win a weekly award. In 2018, he hit .286 in May (his best in any month) after hitting .183 in April.

Garcia's injury halts first Double-A season: First baseman and designated hitter Wilson Garcia was placed on the injured list June 21 with a right foot sprain, interrupting a stellar campaign. In his first season with the Indians organization and in Double-A, he still leads the Eastern League with 23 doubles, is second in extra-base hits (33), tied for second in RBI (46), fifth in total bases (122, second on the club) and slugging (.475, second on the club), and tied for ninth in home runs (10, tied for second on the club). He is also second on the club with a .268 average. Originally signed by the Phillies in 2010, he was traded to the Orioles May 1, 2018, before the Indians acquired him in the December Rule 5 Draft.

League leaders: Akron leads the league in games (81), at-bats (2687), runs (341), hits (645), home runs (70), extra-base hits (208), total bases (1,011) and RBI (313). The RubberDucks average 4.21 runs per game this season, but since June 5, they have scored 79 total runs in the last 25 games (3.16/game, 9-16 W-L), scoring five or more in six games (4-2).

### LAST OUTING (Tuesday, June 25, at Harrisburg, W in 2-1, 11-inning win)

Scott began by retiring the first 12 Senators batters. He gave up three singles in the fifth but stranded the bases loaded, and he worked around another hit in the seventh inning, completing a career-long seven innings and departing with a scoreless tie. Right-hander Jordan Stephens pitched three scoreless innings in relief, and after Akron took a 2-0 lead in the 11th, right-hander Dalbert Siri allowed only a run to earn the save.

#### **Season Highlights**

- Began the season with Lynchburg (A-Adv), making 12 starts before a June 20 promotion to Akron.
- Ranked third in the Carolina League with 74 strikeouts at the time of his promotion.

- Began his professional career on June 18 and made four relief appearances for the AZL Indians (rookie).
- Promoted on July 2 to Mahoning Valley (SS-A) and made five relief appearances for the Scrappers.
- Promoted on Aug. 2 to Lake County (A) and made five relief appearances for the Captains.

## **2019 RUBBERDUCKS FIELD STAFF**

#24 Rouglas Odor, Manager (First Season) - Odor, 51, is the 18th manager in club history. He follows Tony Mansolino, who was promoted to Triple-A Columbus after guiding Akron to a 78-62 record and finish as runner-up in the 2018 Eastern League Championship Series against the New Hampshire Fisher Cats. Last season, Odor managed the Class-A Advanced Lynchburg Hillcats to their fourth consecutive postseason. After posting the Carolina League's worst first-half record of 29-38, the Hillcats rebounded to go 42-28 in the second half, claiming the Northern Division title. They fell to Potomac in the semifinals, three games to two. Odor has a 361-363 (.499) career managing record in 11 seasons.

When Odor was the RubberDucks hitting coach in 2014, he became the first person to wear the uniforms of the Canton-Akron Indians, Akron Aeros, and Akron RubberDucks. He played 197 games for Canton-Akron during the 1991, 1993-94 seasons, and he was the hitting coach for the Aeros' 2012 Eastern League Championship squad.

The 2019 season is Odor's 32nd in the Cleveland organization as a player or coach (19th as a coach). The former shortstop was a 32nd-round draft pick by the Indians in 1988 and played in the minor leagues for the Indians from 1988-94 and for the Milwaukee Brewers organization in 1995. Last season was Odor's first as a manager since 2008. He managed San Felipe in the Venezuelan Summer League for two seasons in 1999-2000, the Burlington Indians for four seasons from 2001-04, the Mahoning Valley Scrappers for two seasons in 2005-06, and the Gulf Coast League Indians for two seasons in 2007-08. Since then, Odor has moved up the ranks as a hitting coach, starting with Class-A Kinston in 2009-10, Akron in 2011-12 and 2014, the High-A Carolina Mudcats in 2013, and Triple-A Columbus in 2015-17.

The Maracaibo, Venezuela, native resides in Winter Haven, Florida, with his wife, Milagros. He has three sons and is the uncle of Texas Rangers infielder Rougned Odor.

#27 Tony Arnold, Pitching Coach (10th Season, not consecutive) — Arnold, 59, rejoins the RubberDucks for his fifth time in Akron after spending last season with Lynchburg. In 2018, the Hillcats pitching staff finished fifth in the Carolina League with a 3.76 ERA, ranked second with 1,190 strikeouts and the 12 team shutouts ranked fourth. Arnold last was with the RubberDucks in 2016-17, helping lead the 2016 team to an Eastern League championship. He previously served in the same capacity in Akron from 1996-99, 2008, and 2011-12. Arnold's 2012 Akron Aeros staff crafted a franchise-record 3.03 ERA and went on to claim the EL championship. In 2016, Arnold became the second man to wear the uniforms of the Canton-Akron Indians, Akron Aeros and Akron RubberDucks, joining Rouglas Odor in that exclusive group.

In 2015, Arnold began as the pitching coach at Lynchburg and finished at Triple-A Columbus, helping the Clippers to the International League title. A former All-American at the University of Texas, Arnold pitched in the major leagues with the Baltimore Orioles in 1986 and 1987.

#2 Justin Toole, Hitting Coach (First Season) — Toole, 32, spent the 2018 season as Lynchburg's hitting coach. This is fourth season coaching in the Indians' organization, serving as the hitting coach for Mahoning Valley in 2016, Lake County in 2017, and Lynchburg. Toole was signed as a minor league free agent by the Indians in 2009 and spent parts of seven seasons with Cleveland from 2009-15. He spent parts of 2010, 2012-15 with Akron, hitting .259 in 180 games, including .275 in 77 games under Odor's hitting-coach tutelage in 2014. The Council Bluffs, Iowa, native played at the University of Iowa and has authored a children's book called "9 in 9," chronicling the lessons he learned while playing all nine positions in a game for the Carolina Mudcats on Aug. 25, 2012. #28 Juan De La Cruz, Bench Coach (First Season) — De La Cruz, 25, is in his second season coaching with the Indians after serving as the hitting coach for the rookielevel Arizona League Indians in 2018. Primarily a catcher in his playing days, De La Cruz was signed as a free agent by the Indians in 2009 and spent eight seasons in the system, reaching as high as Akron in 2017, when he played 12 games as a catcher and first baseman. He was a .216 career hitter in 281 games.

Bobby Ruiz, Athletic Trainer (First Season) — Ruiz spent the past four seasons (2015-18) with Lynchburg. This is his ninth with the Indians.

Paul Synenkyj, Strength and Conditioning Coach (Third Season) — Synenkyj is the lone returning field staff member from 2018. He is in his ninth season in the Indians organization. He holds degrees in physical education from Cleveland State and the University of Akron. Twitter: @PaulSynenkyj
