Tuesday Recap: Salazar goes 3 innings on rehab, before SeaWolves top RubberDucks (Erie 5, Akron 3): Cleveland Indians right-hander Danny Salazar allowed one run in the first three innings and departed with a 1-1 tie, while third baseman Nolan Jones homered for a second straight night, but the SeaWolves used a three-run fifth inning to earn a 5-3 win and clinch a series victory at UPMC Park. The RubberDucks have lost three straight road series and five straight series overall (both season highs) and six straight games to Erie (most against any 2019 opponent).

Clement's strong return: Since returning from the Injured List on May 9, shortstop Ernie Clement has played 57 games, collecting 71 hits (second in the Eastern League) and going 71-for-229 (.313, second in the EL) to move to seventh in league with a team-high .291 average with 20 multi-hit games, eight doubles, three triples, a home run, 30 runs, 14 RBI, 14 walks, a .359 OBP and separate 13- and 14-game hitting streaks. He was on the Injured List with a right adductor strain April 16-May 8. In six games prior to going on the IL, the Indians No. 15 (MLB.com)/No. 18 (Baseball America) prospect was 3-for-25 (.120).

<u>League leaders:</u> Akron leads the league in games (95), at-bats (3,174), hits (771), home runs (81) and total bases (1,206), and is tied with Bowie for the lead in runs (399). The RubberDucks average 4.20 runs per game this season, but since June 5, they have scored 137 total runs in the last 39 games (3.51/game, 13-26 W-L), scoring 5 or more in 11 games (8-3).

Salazar makes rehab start: Cleveland Indians right-hander Danny Salazar (currently on the 60-day Injured List) made his second Double-A rehab start with the RubberDucks in Erie on Tuesday, allowing an earned run on three hits with two walks and four strikeouts in three innings. In his first Double-A start on Thursday, he took a loss (2.2 IP, 2 K) and allowed an earned run on two hits and a walk in the third inning, before the Akron bullpen relieved him. Salazar made two rehab starts (June 30 and July 5) this season for the rookie-level Arizona League Indians (0-1, 6.23 ERA, 4.1 IP, 7 H, 3 ER, 0 BB, 11 K), his first regular season action since he was placed on the Injured List for the entire 2018 regular season with right shoulder rotator cuff tendonitis. He has not pitched in the major leagues since the 2017 American League Division Series. After 13 starts for Akron between 2012 and 2013 (6-3, 2.26 ERA, 67.2 IP, 74 K), Salazar has pitched 2013-2017 in the major leagues with the Indians.

RubberDucks All-Stars: The RubberDucks had five players selected as Western Division All-Stars, and four played in the Eastern League All-Star Game, won by the Western Division, 5-0, on July 10 in Richmond. Connor Marabell played the entire game as the designated hitter, going 0-for-4 with a strikeout. Ka'ai Tom went 1-for-2 with a strikeout and was promoted afterward to Triple-A Columbus. Right-hander Eli Morgan allowed one of the two Eastern Division hits but was the only Western Division pitcher to strike out two batters in his scoreless fifth inning. Left-hander Kyle Nelson struck out Binghamton's Braxton Lee to end the seventh inning. Wilson Garcia did not participate (right foot sprain).

<u>Ducks visit SeaWolves:</u> The RubberDucks and SeaWolves are playing the fourth of six scheduled series this season, with seven games at Canal Park and 12 at UPMC Park (Akron's closest trip – 125 miles – and most frequent road opponent). Last season, Akron went 11-8 against Erie, including 7-3 at UPMC Park. Erie finished fifth in the Western Division, at 63-77, last season. Since 2005, Akron is 155-159 against Erie, which has won nine of the first 11 meetings this season (six of eight in Erie).

Jones arrives in Double-A: Third baseman Nolan Jones, ranked by Baseball America and MLB.com as the Indians No. 2 prospect, made his Double-A debut on July 11. A second-round pick in 2016 from Holy Ghost Preparatory School (Bensalem, PA), he became the highest-ranked Indians prospect to appear for Akron this season. A 2019 Carolina League Mid-Season All-Star with Class-A Advanced Lynchburg, Jones led the league in walks (65), on-base percentage (.435) and OPS (.860) at the time of his promotion to Akron. He also led Lynchburg with 48 runs. He played 77 games and hit .286 with seven home runs, 41 RBI, and a .456 slugging percentage. He also represented the Indians in the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Progressive Field on July 7, starting at third base and grounding out to the pitcher in his only at bat.

<u>Ducks flying out of the park:</u> The RubberDucks have hit an Eastern League-leading 81 home runs while allowing only 60 home runs (fourth fewest among EL clubs) for a league-best +21 home run differential. In 49 road games, Akron has hit 51 home runs, allowing 35 (+16 differential). Of the RubberDucks' 81 home runs this season, 52 (64 percent) have come in 19 multi-homer games, including 13 in four straight games May 9-13. Akron's six home runs on May 11 in Reading were the most for the club since hitting seven on July 2, 2008, in a 10-6 win at Erie.

<u>Warming up the bats:</u> Shortstop Ernie Clement's 13-game hitting streak ended on Sunday, but his 16-game on-base streak continues. Outfielder Trenton Brooks also had his longest hitting streak of his first Double-A season snapped Sunday. He had 11 RBI in an 11-game hitting streak (five two-hit games) in which he was 17-for-46 with four doubles, a triple, three home runs and 11 RBI. Outfielder Mitch Longo, also in his first Double-A season, had a seven-game hitting streak snapped on Thursday. He was 12-for-25, with four multi-hit games, three doubles, a home run, two RBI and five walks. First baseman Nellie Rodriguez hit four home runs in eight games June 29-July 6, has 10 this season – tied for second on the club – and has 45 in his Double-A career – his most at any level.

<u>Call named Player of the Week:</u> RubberDucks center fielder Alex Call was named the Eastern League Player of the Week for June 24-30, after he led the league with 22 total bases and was tied for the lead with three home runs (including consecutive games Saturday, when he hit Akron's first grand slam of the season, and Sunday), five extra-base hits, and eight RBI. He hit safely in six of seven games on the road trip, going 10-for-32 with a double, a triple, and four runs. He is the second RubberDuck to be named Player of the Week (Ka'ai Tom was May 20-26).

#### LAST START (Friday, July 12, vs. Bowie, ND in 6-5, 10-inning loss):

Hentges allowed a first-inning run on two hits and a walk, but Akron scored three runs in the bottom of the inning to take a 3-1 lead. He worked out of a bases-loaded jam in the second inning and pitched a perfect third. In the fourth, he hit the leadoff batter, and with one out allowed a walk, double and single to tie the game, 3-3. Hentges gave way to left-hander Ben Krauth, who got the last two outs of the inning. The 3-3 tie remained until the eighth inning in a game Bowie eventually won, 6-5 in 10 innings.

#### Season Highlights

- In May, had the eighth-best ERA (2.38), eighth-most innings (34) and tied for the fifth-most strikeouts (35) in the Eastern League.
- Entered the season ranked as the No. 6 prospect in the Indians system by Baseball America and No. 10 by MLB.com (both as top left-handed pitcher).
- Added to the Indians 40-man roster Nov. 20, and made his first two career major league spring training appearances, with two scoreless, hitless starts for the Indians

   Feb. 26 at Colorado (W, 1.0 IP, 0 BB, 0 K) and March 3 vs. Kansas City (2.0 IP, 1 BB, 3 K).

#### 2018:

- Finished second in ERA (3.27) and third in strikeouts (122) in the Carolina League, Mid-Season Carolina League All-Star, MiLB.com organizational All-Star.
- Did not pitch after August 15 due to a left shoulder strain, but his final start was his best, Aug. 15 at Wilmington (6.1IP, 2H, 0R, 2BB, 7SO).
- Over his final 12 starts of the season he posted an ERA of 2.69 (19ER/63.2IP).
- Recorded four starts of at least 6.0 innings and zero runs allowed and fanned 10 on April 17 vs. Frederick.
- Allowed only four homers in 118.1 innings, while batters hit .230 (46-for-200) off him with runners on and .231 (27-for-117) with RISP.

2017: Began season July 8 with six rehab starts in the Arizona League before being activated at Mahoning Valley on 8/9, finishing the season with five starts (2.04 ERA).

2016: Limited to 14 starts for Lake County (A) due to a left elbow strain, did not pitch after June 23...had left elbow reconstruction (Tommy John surgery) in July.

2015: Led AZL Indians with 59 strikeouts, third-most in the league.

### **2019 RUBBERDUCKS FIELD STAFF**

**#24 Rouglas Odor**, *Manager* (*First Season*) – Odor, 51, is the 18th manager in club history. He follows Tony Mansolino, who was promoted to Triple-A Columbus after guiding Akron to a 78-62 record and finish as runner-up in the 2018 Eastern League Championship Series against the New Hampshire Fisher Cats. Last season, Odor managed the Class-A Advanced Lynchburg Hillcats to their fourth consecutive postseason. After posting the Carolina League's worst first-half record of 29-38, the Hillcats rebounded to go 42-28 in the second half, claiming the Northern Division title. They fell to Potomac in the semifinals, three games to two. Odor has a 361-363 (.499) career managing record in 11 seasons.

When Odor was the RubberDucks hitting coach in 2014, he became the first person to wear the uniforms of the Canton-Akron Indians, Akron Aeros, and Akron RubberDucks. He played 197 games for Canton-Akron during the 1991, 1993-94 seasons, and he was the hitting coach for the Aeros' 2012 Eastern League Championship squad.

The 2019 season is Odor's 32nd in the Cleveland organization as a player or coach (19th as a coach). The former shortstop was a 32nd-round draft pick by the Indians in 1988 and played in the minor leagues for the Indians from 1988-94 and for the Milwaukee Brewers organization in 1995. Last season was Odor's first as a manager since 2008. He managed San Felipe in the Venezuelan Summer League for two seasons in 1999-2000, the Burlington Indians for four seasons from 2001-04, the Mahoning Valley Scrappers for two seasons in 2005-06, and the Gulf Coast League Indians for two seasons in 2007-08. Since then, Odor has moved up the ranks as a hitting coach, starting with Class-A Kinston in 2009-10, Akron in 2011-12 and 2014, the High-A Carolina Mudcats in 2013, and Triple-A Columbus in 2015-17.

The Maracaibo, Venezuela, native resides in Winter Haven, Florida, with his wife, Milagros. He has three sons and is the uncle of Texas Rangers infielder Rougned Odor.

#27 Tony Arnold, *Pitching Coach* (10th Season, not consecutive) — Arnold, 59, rejoins the RubberDucks for his fifth time in Akron after spending last season with Lynchburg. In 2018, the Hillcats pitching staff finished fifth in the Carolina League with a 3.76 ERA, ranked second with 1,190 strikeouts and the 12 team shutouts ranked fourth. Arnold last was with the RubberDucks in 2016-17, helping lead the 2016 team to an Eastern League championship. He previously served in the same capacity in Akron from 1996-99, 2008, and 2011-12. Arnold's 2012 Akron Aeros staff crafted a franchise-record 3.03 ERA and went on to claim the EL championship. In 2016, Arnold became the second man to wear the uniforms of the Canton-Akron Indians, Akron Aeros and Akron RubberDucks, joining Rouglas Odor in that exclusive group.

In 2015, Arnold began as the pitching coach at Lynchburg and finished at Triple-A Columbus, helping the Clippers to the International League title. A former All-American at the University of Texas, Arnold pitched in the major leagues with the Baltimore Orioles in 1986 and 1987.

**#2 Justin Toole, Hitting Coach** (First Season) — Toole, 32, spent the 2018 season as Lynchburg's hitting coach. This is fourth season coaching in the Indians' organization, serving as the hitting coach for Mahoning Valley in 2016, Lake County in 2017, and Lynchburg. Toole was signed as a minor league free agent by the Indians in 2009 and spent parts of seven seasons with Cleveland from 2009-15. He spent parts of 2010, 2012-15 with Akron, hitting .259 in 180 games, including .275 in 77 games under Odor's hitting-coach tutelage in 2014. The Council Bluffs, Iowa, native played at the University of Iowa and has authored a children's book called "9 in 9," chronicling the lessons he learned while playing all nine positions in a game for the Carolina Mudcats on Aug. 25, 2012. **Twitter: @Tooleyj24, Instagram: @tooleyj24** 

**#28 Juan De La Cruz**, *Bench Coach* (*First Season*) — De La Cruz, 25, is in his second season coaching with the Indians after serving as the hitting coach for the rookie-level Arizona League Indians in 2018. Primarily a catcher in his playing days, De La Cruz was signed as a free agent by the Indians in 2009 and spent eight seasons in the system, reaching as high as Akron in 2017, when he played 12 games as a catcher and first baseman. He was a .216 career hitter in 281 games.

Bobby Ruiz, Athletic Trainer (First Season) — Ruiz spent the past four seasons (2015-18) with Lynchburg. This is his ninth with the Indians.

**Paul Synenkyj**, *Strength and Conditioning Coach* (*Third Season*) — Synenkyj is the lone returning field staff member from 2018. He is in his ninth season in the Indians organization. He holds degrees in physical education from Cleveland State and the University of Akron. **Twitter:** @PaulSynenkyj
