Cleveland Indians Double-A LHP Sam Hentges (2-11, 5.23)

Carlos Carrasco returns: Cleveland Indians right-hander Carlos Carrasco (currently on the 60-day Injured List) is making his first rehab appearance on Monday, marking his first game action since May 30 in Chicago against the White Sox. This is his fourth appearance for Akron, where he pitched one start each in 2011, 2016 and 2018. Carrasco was evaluated June 2 at the Cleveland Clinic as a follow-up to abnormalities in his Spring Training blood work. He was diagnosed with chronic myeloid leukemia, a treatable form of leukemia, and was later cleared to resume strength and conditioning workouts and throwing activity to tolerance, the Indians announced on July 7.

Sunday Recap: Rosa's home run gives SeaWolves finale over RubberDucks (Erie 3, Akron 2): Erie right fielder Dylan Rosa, a Kent State University alumnus, hit a go-ahead, three-run home run in the fifth inning to help his team win a 3-2 rubber match over the RubberDucks at UPMC Park in Erie on Sunday afternoon. Akron is 5-7 in rubber matches and 11-26 in one-run games, including 2-3 against Erie. The SeaWolves have won each of the first five series between the clubs. Akron has played five straight series rubber matches, winning two, then losing the last three.

Since the All-Star break: Since the Eastern League All-Star break, Akron is 15-21, but a few RubberDucks have posted numbers among the league leaders since the break. Trenton Brooks has 22 extra-base hits (tied for the league lead), 15 doubles (second in the league), 69 total bases (third), a .539 slugging percentage (second) and .872 OPS (fifth). Nolan Jones, called up to Double-A for the first time during the break, has 20 walks (tied for fifth) and 26 runs (tied for third). Connor Marabell has a .306 average (10th). Ernie Clement has nine stolen bases (sixth). Jake Paulson has five wins (tied for the lead), and **Dalbert Siri** has six saves (tied for sixth) in 13 appearances (tied for fifth).

Gonzalez warms up to the EL: Outfielder Oscar Gonzalez, who was promoted to Akron on Aug. 1, has hit safely in eight of his last 11 games, including a six-game hitting streak Aug. 6-13 (8-for-22, three doubles, a home run, five runs and five RBI) after going hitless in his first three Eastern League games (0-for-10). The Carolina League All-Star left Lynchburg with a league-best .319 average, 123 hits and 175 total bases. He had eight home runs, 61 RBI (fourth), 33 extra-base hits (sixth), .455 SLG (fifth) and .797 OPS (second).

Clement's strong return: Since returning from the Injured List May 9, shortstop Ernie Clement has 93 hits (tied for fifth in the Eastern League). Since May 9, he is 93-for-328 (.284, seventh in EL). That includes 27 multi-hit games, 11 doubles, three triples, a home run (at Erie in his first game back), 41 runs, 21 RBI, 21 walks, a .331 OBP, and separate 13and 14-game hitting streaks. He was on the IL with a right adductor strain April 16-May 8. In six games prior to going on the IL, the Indians No. 18 (Baseball America)/No. 26 (MLB.com) prospect was 3-for-25 (.120).

Ducks host Senators: The RubberDucks and Senators are playing the last of three scheduled intradivision three-game series this season, with six games at Canal Park and three at FNB Field. Akron swept a series at home in May and won two of three in Harrisburg in June. The Senators won the first half in the Western Division, with Akron finishing in third place, 7.5 games behind. Last season, Akron went 5-7 against Harrisburg, including 2-4 at Canal Park. In 2018, the Senators finished in third place in the Western Division, at 72-65 overall. Since 2005, Akron leads the series, 104-85. According to Baseball America (pre-2019) and MLB.com (July 2019), top prospects in this series include:

Picking up the pace: The RubberDucks have won 13 of their last 24 games and three of their last seven series. In that span, they have scored 97 runs (4.04/game) and allowed 75 (3.13/game), for a +22 differential.

Jones arrives in Double-A: Third baseman Nolan Jones, ranked by MLB.com as the Indians' No. 1 prospect (July 2019) and No. 2 by Baseball America (entering 2019), made his Double-A debut on July 11, becoming the highest-ranked Indians prospect to appear for Akron this season. A 2019 Carolina League Mid-Season All-Star with Class-A Advanced Lynchburg, Jones led the league in walks (65), on-base percentage (.435) and OPS (.860) at the time of his promotion to Akron. He also led Lynchburg with 48 runs. He played 77 games and hit .286 with seven home runs, 41 RBI, and a .456 slugging percentage. He also played in the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Progressive Field on July 7, starting at third base and grounding out to the pitcher in his only at bat.

Flying out of the park: The RubberDucks have hit nine home runs over the past nine games after hitting just three in the previous 20 games. In the past 29 games, Akron has 12 home runs while allowing 27. Overall, the RubberDucks have 94 home runs (fourth in the Eastern League) while allowing 88 (sixth most in the EL) for a +6 home run differential. In 65 road games, the RubberDucks have hit a league-leading 60 home runs, while allowing 46, tied for fourth most (+14 differential). Of the RubberDucks' 94 home runs this season, 57 (61 percent) have come in 21 multi-homer games, including 13 in four straight games May 9-13. Akron's six home runs on May 11 in Reading were its most since hitting seven on July 2, 2008, in a 10-6 win at Erie. Akron allowed six home runs to Binghamton on July 20, marking its most allowed since May 29, 2009, when Erie hit six in an 11-8 win over the Aeros. The last season Akron led the Eastern League in home runs was 2005, when the Aeros hit 151, led by **Jonathan** Van Every's 27 (tied for second in the league).

LAST START (Wednesday, August 14, vs. Trenton, L in 8-1 loss): Hentges allowed a run in the third inning after a walk and a pair of singles. In the fifth inning, three hits, a walk, two errors and a three-run triple on a fly ball lost in the lights led to six runs. Hentges exited with no outs for left-hander Ben Krauth. The Thunder prevailed, 8-1.

Season Highlights

- In May, had the eighth-best ERA (2.38), eighth-most innings (34) and tied for the fifth-most strikeouts (35) in the Eastern League.
- Entered the season ranked as the No. 6 prospect in the Indians system by Baseball America and No. 10 by MLB.com (both as top left-handed pitcher).
- Added to the Indians 40-man roster Nov. 20, and made his first two career major league spring training appearances, with two scoreless, hitless starts for the Indians Feb. 26 at Colorado (W, 1.0 IP, 0 BB, 0 K) and March 3 vs. Kansas City (2.0 IP, 1 BB, 3 K).

2018:

- Finished second in ERA (3.27) and third in strikeouts (122) in the Carolina League, Mid-Season Carolina League All-Star, MiLB.com organizational All-Star.
- Did not pitch after August 15 due to a left shoulder strain, but his final start was his best, Aug. 15 at Wilmington (6.1IP, 2H, 0R, 2BB, 7SO).
- Over his final 12 starts of the season he posted an ERA of 2.69 (19ER/63.2IP).
- Recorded four starts of at least 6.0 innings and zero runs allowed and fanned 10 on April 17 vs. Frederick.

2017: Began season July 8 with six rehab starts in the Arizona League before being activated at Mahoning Valley on 8/9, finishing the season with five starts (2.04 ERA).

2016: Limited to 14 starts for Lake County (A) due to a left elbow strain, did not pitch after June 23...had left elbow reconstruction (Tommy John surgery) in July.

2015: Led AZL Indians with 59 strikeouts, third-most in the league.

#24 Rouglas Odor, *Manager* (*First Season*) – Odor, 51, is the 18th manager in club history. He follows Tony Mansolino, who was promoted to Triple-A Columbus after guiding Akron to a 78-62 record and finish as runner-up in the 2018 Eastern League Championship Series against the New Hampshire Fisher Cats. Last season, Odor managed the Class-A Advanced Lynchburg Hillcats to their fourth consecutive postseason. After posting the Carolina League's worst first-half record of 29-38, the Hillcats rebounded to go 42-28 in the second half, claiming the Northern Division title. They fell to Potomac in the semifinals, three games to two. Odor has a 361-363 (.499) career managing record in 11 seasons.

When Odor was the RubberDucks hitting coach in 2014, he became the first person to wear the uniforms of the Canton-Akron Indians, Akron Aeros, and Akron RubberDucks. He played 197 games for Canton-Akron during the 1991, 1993-94 seasons, and he was the hitting coach for the Aeros' 2012 Eastern League Championship squad.

The 2019 season is Odor's 32nd in the Cleveland organization as a player or coach (19th as a coach). The former shortstop was a 32nd-round draft pick by the Indians in 1988 and played in the minor leagues for the Indians from 1988-94 and for the Milwaukee Brewers organization in 1995. Last season was Odor's first as a manager since 2008. He managed San Felipe in the Venezuelan Summer League for two seasons in 1999-2000, the Burlington Indians for four seasons from 2001-04, the Mahoning Valley Scrappers for two seasons in 2005-06, and the Gulf Coast League Indians for two seasons in 2007-08. Since then, Odor has moved up the ranks as a hitting coach, starting with Class-A Kinston in 2009-10, Akron in 2011-12 and 2014, the High-A Carolina Mudcats in 2013, and Triple-A Columbus in 2015-17.

The Maracaibo, Venezuela, native resides in Winter Haven, Florida, with his wife, Milagros. He has three sons and is the uncle of Texas Rangers infielder Rougned Odor.

#27 Tony Arnold, *Pitching Coach* (10th Season, not consecutive) — Arnold, 60, rejoins the RubberDucks for his fifth time in Akron after spending last season with Lynchburg. In 2018, the Hillcats pitching staff finished fifth in the Carolina League with a 3.76 ERA, ranked second with 1,190 strikeouts and the 12 team shutouts ranked fourth. Arnold last was with the RubberDucks in 2016-17, helping lead the 2016 team to an Eastern League championship. He previously served in the same capacity in Akron from 1996-99, 2008, and 2011-12. Arnold's 2012 Akron Aeros staff crafted a franchise-record 3.03 ERA and went on to claim the EL championship. In 2016, Arnold became the second man to wear the uniforms of the Canton-Akron Indians, Akron Aeros and Akron RubberDucks, joining Rouglas Odor in that exclusive group.

In 2015, Arnold began as the pitching coach at Lynchburg and finished at Triple-A Columbus, helping the Clippers to the International League title. A former All-American at the University of Texas, Arnold pitched in the major leagues with the Baltimore Orioles in 1986 and 1987.

#2 Justin Toole, Hitting Coach (First Season) — Toole, 32, spent the 2018 season as Lynchburg's hitting coach. This is fourth season coaching in the Indians' organization, serving as the hitting coach for Mahoning Valley in 2016, Lake County in 2017, and Lynchburg. Toole was signed as a minor league free agent by the Indians in 2009 and spent parts of seven seasons with Cleveland from 2009-15. He spent parts of 2010, 2012-15 with Akron, hitting .259 in 180 games, including .275 in 77 games under Odor's hitting-coach tutelage in 2014. The Council Bluffs, Iowa, native played at the University of Iowa and has authored a children's book called "9 in 9," chronicling the lessons he learned while playing all nine positions in a game for the Carolina Mudcats on Aug. 25, 2012. **Twitter: @Tooleyj24, Instagram: @tooleyj24**

#28 Juan De La Cruz, *Bench Coach* (*First Season*) — De La Cruz, 26, is in his second season coaching with the Indians after serving as the hitting coach for the rookie-level Arizona League Indians in 2018. Primarily a catcher in his playing days, De La Cruz was signed as a free agent by the Indians in 2009 and spent eight seasons in the system, reaching as high as Akron in 2017, when he played 12 games as a catcher and first baseman. He was a .216 career hitter in 281 games.

Bobby Ruiz, Athletic Trainer (First Season) — Ruiz spent the past four seasons (2015-18) with Lynchburg. This is his ninth with the Indians.

Paul Synenkyj, Strength and Conditioning Coach (*Third Season*) — Synenkyj is the lone returning field staff member from 2018. He is in his ninth season in the Indians organization. He holds degrees in physical education from Cleveland State and the University of Akron. **Twitter: @PaulSynenkyj**
