NEW ORLEANS BABY CAKES (27-31) AT LAS VEGAS 51s (25-34)

RHP Pablo Lopez (0-0, 0.00) vs. LHP Aaron Laffey (0-2, 12.60)

THE BABY CAKES – The New Orleans Baby Cakes continue a seven-game road trip tonight with the second of a three-game set against the Las Vegas 51s. The 'Cakes dropped three of four meetings last year at the Shrine, but swept a four-game set in their last visit to Sin City, August 12-15, 2016. This is the final trip to Cashman Field, where New Orleans owns a 27-26 all-time record, and was the site of the 1998 Triple-A World Series win over Buffalo to clinch the city's first national professional championship.

YESTERDAY'S NEWS – The 'Cakes rallied from a 10-1 deficit but fell in the series opener in Las Vegas 11-10. New Orleans allowed a season high eight runs in the third inning and fell behind 10-1. The 'Cakes got multihit performances from Austin Dean, Magneuris Sierra, Isaac Galloway, Jon Rodriguez and Cito Culver. New Orleans matched its season high three home runs in the contest and out-hit the 51s 16-14 in the defeat. Dillon Peters suffered the loss, Chris Flexen pitched into the sixth inning for the win.

ON THE HILL – Pablo Lopez makes his Triple-A debut tonight for New Orleans, he is in his fifth season of professional baseball. The 22-year-old from Venezuela was promoted from Class AA Jacksonville today. He started eight games in the Southern League for the Jumbo Shrimp. He was 1-2, with a 0.62 ERA in eight starts. He allowed three earned runs,

on 30 hits in 43 and 2/3 innings pitched this season. Earlier today he was named to the Southern League All-Star team. Lopez was acquired from Seattle last July in the David Phelps trade, he is ranked the 25th best prospect in Miami organization according to *Baseball America*.

DANDY SANDY – Sandy Alcantara recorded the fourth quality start in his last six outings, during which he is 4-0 with a 3.35 ERA (15 ER/40.1 IP)

and opponents have batted .236 (34x144). Alcantara lowered his season ERA to 3.53, ninth-best in the PCL, and has pitched a league-high 66.1 innings. He also ranks fourth among PCL starting pitchers in batting average against (.240) and fifth in WHIP (1.22).

HOT SOUP – Over his last 33 games, dating to April 26, Eric Campbell is batting .351 (41x118), fourth-best in the PCL in that span, while his .447 on-base percentage trails only Sacramento's Austin Slater (.468). Despite collecting just four hits over the last five games, he drove in eight runs to boost his team-leading total to 31 RBI. In 269 games with Las Vegas over parts of four seasons, Campbell batted .322 (289x897).

DEAN OF HITS – Austin Dean added three more hits yesterday raising his average to .313 in Triple A, he has six hits in his last 17 at bats spanning four games. Dean was hitting .420 (34x81) in 22 games with AA Jacksonville and was named April's Southern League Player of the Month after pacing the circuit in batting average, hits, total bases (53), slugging percentage (.654) and OPS (1.120). His .353 overall batting average places 16th in all of MiLB, and he is hitting .360 (18x50) in 13 games since moving into the leadoff spot.

ALL STARS- A pair of current 'Cakes pitchers were named to The Southern League All-Star Team today, Pablo Lopez and Jose Quijada. A total of six Jumbo Shrimp players were named All-Stars.

MAGNIFICENT MAGGY – Magneuris Sierra collected another extra-base hit last night ands has a hit in six consecuitve games, 9x26. Over his last 13 starts, Sierra is batting .327 (17x52), and his two-hit effort last night was his 16th multi-hit game, tied for the team lead.

ARMS RACE – Over the last eight games, Baby Cakes starting pitchers own a 3.17 ERA (16 ER/45.1 IP) and have six quality starts in that span, with only Dillon Peters falling shy in both of his starts. The 'Cakes starters had a 2.25 ERA (45 ER/180.0 IP) in a 27-game stretch from April 18-May 17 before the staff held a 7.94 ERA in its next 10 games.

TOMAS THE TANK – Tomas Telis has a hit in 15 of his last 19 games, batting .377 (26x69) with nine multi-hit efforts and 12 RBI. Since joining New Orleans on May 4, Telis is tied for 12th in the PCL with a .333 average, with singles accounting for 32 of his 34 hits. Dating back to May 23 last season, Telis owns a .343 batting average (86x251) over his last 65 games with New Orleans.

STEAL AWAY – The Baby Cakes have 45 stolen bases this season, tied for fifth-most in the PCL. Rafael Ortega is 10x10 in stolen base attempts, the most of any player in the league without being caught, and with Isaac Galloway (13) account for one of three sets of PCL teammates to reach double-digit steals, joining Colorado Springs' Keon Broxton (17) and

Nate Orf (11) and Tacoma's Ian Miller (14) and John Andreoli (12).

NEXT OF KIN – Tyler Kinley has yet to allow an earned run in nine relief appearances (10.2 IP) and has given up just two hits in 33 at-bats (.061). Kinley's save on Friday was his second at Triple-A, joining a save for New Orleans in Omaha on June 21, 2016.

LONELIEST NUMBER – The Baby Cakes have played 22 one-run games, going a PCL-worst 7-15, and 33 games decided by one

22 one-run games, going a PCL-worst 7-15, and 33 games decided by one or two runs (12-20), second-most in the league (Round Rock, 34). NOLA has dropped all 12 one-run affairs on the road.

SIR ISAAC – Isaac Galloway homered for the third time in his last six games. Galloway's 13 stolen bases this season are tied for third-most in the PCL, and he has 63 steals in a New Orleans uniform, two ahead of Colin Porter for the most in franchise history. Galloway played in his 331st game with NOLA on Sunday, moving him ahead of Jason Alfaro for seventh place on the club's all-time chart, while he ranks sixth in at bats (1,155) and seventh in runs scored (156).

ROSTER MOVES – New Orleans added pitcher Pablo Lopez today from Class AA Southern League. New Orleans promoted pitcher Ben Meyer to Miami. Its Ben Meyer's first MLB call-up and the sixth 'Cakes pitcher to get called up this season. Odrismaer Despaigne was optioned by Miami to the 'Cakes. He will join the club later in trip.

NAWLINS NOTES – New Orleans allowed eight runs in the third inning yesterday, a season high. The prevoius high was a seven run third against Round Rock on May 19th. Cristhian Adames charted his second three-hit game of the Memphis series on Sunday and fourth of the season ... The 'Cakes went 8x49 (.163) with runners in scoring position vs. Memphis.


