- 27 year old made his Cardinals debut on 6/5 vs. SA (3.2 IP, 10H, 10R, 1BB, 3K) after signing with St. Louis as a Minor League free agent on 5/30/21
- Veteran southpaw has pitched for the Fargo-Moorhead (ND) Redhawks in the independent American Association since 2019
- In 29 starts since 2019 with Fargo-Moorhead, has gone 12-8 with a 3.41 ERA, allowing just 64 earned runs on 169 hits while striking out 195 in 169.0 IP
- In 2019, led RedHawks and was 2<sup>nd</sup> in American Association with 87 Ks in 69.2 IP, striking out 10+ in four starts with career-high-tying 12 Ks on 8/18/19
- Played with former Springfield RHP Kevin Herget (2015-17) and current Cardinals LHP Kevin McGovern this season at Fargo-Moorhead
- Pitched in the Mariners and Braves systems from 2012 – 2018, going 31-41, 3.99 ERA, 160G/141GS, 705.2IP, 588H, 369R, 431BB, 680K
- Affiliated pro honors include Florida State League Midseason All-Star (2017), Midwest League Midseason and Postseason All-Star (2013), Arizona League Postseason All-Star (2012), MiLB.com Organization All Star (SEA, 2015) and California League Pitcher of the Week (6/2/14)
- Acquired by Atlanta with OF Alex Jackson on 12/9/16 as “player to be named later” in deal that sent RHP Rob Whalen and RHP Max Povse to Mariners
- Originally selected by Seattle in the 3<sup>rd</sup> round of the 2012 draft out of Winter Haven (FL) High School
- Dominated during junior and senior HS seasons, going 18-3 with a 0.70 ERA and 257 strikeouts in 160 innings
- High School teammate at Winter Haven of Orioles 1B/OF Trey Mancini; former MLB outfielder Jordan Schafer, who spent 2016 in Tulsa and 2017 in Memphis as a pitcher, is also an alumni of Winter Haven HS (class of 2005)
- Has also served as pitching coach for Webber International University, an NAIA program located in Babson Park, FL
- Resides in Florida with his wife, Gina, and their two children

### Cardinals' Chirps...

- **Last game...** The Drillers once again rallied late to swipe away a win from the Cardinals, closing Sunday's series finale at ONEOK Field with a walk-off grand slam from CF Jeren Kendall for the 6-3 win. For the second time in the series, LHP Kevin McGovern dominated the Drillers with 6.0 shutout frames, allowing just two hits while striking out eight. Springfield seized the lead on a run-scoring error in the 6<sup>th</sup>, before adding an RBI single from DH Ivan Herrera in the 7<sup>th</sup>. The Drillers tied it with two runs on an error in the 7<sup>th</sup>, but the Cardinals jumped back in front on an RBI double by C Aaron Antonini in the 8<sup>th</sup>. However, a pair of walks and a hit batter loaded the bases in the 9<sup>th</sup>, before Kendall sent the final blow out to right for the walk-off.
- **Gorman goes to Memphis...** The St. Louis Cardinals have announced that INF Nolan Gorman has been promoted to AAA-Memphis. The Cardinals #2 prospect and the #30 prospect in all of baseball, Gorman was off to a terrific start to his debut Double-A season, batting .288 with 11 home runs, 27 RBIs and 26 runs through 43 games this year. Just 21 years old, Gorman ranked among the league's best in home runs (6<sup>th</sup>), hits (t-4<sup>th</sup>) and total bases (5<sup>th</sup>, 90). He was named the Double-A Central Player of the Week for 6/8-6/13, hitting .346 (9x26) with an astounding seven home runs, 12 RBIs and eight runs in the six games that week, including setting Springfield's all-time regular season single game record with three home runs in one game on 6/12 vs. Arkansas.
- **Malcom comes to Springfield...** In conjunction with INF Nolan Gorman heading to Triple-A, St. Louis has promoted INF Malcom Nunez to Springfield from High-A Peoria. Only 20 years old, Nunez is ranked by MLB.com as the Cardinals #13 prospect. The Havana, Cuba native was hitting .285 with three home runs, 10 doubles and two triples in 35 games with the Chiefs.
- **Whitley begins MLB Rehab...** The Cardinals have also announced that RHP Kodi Whitley has joined Springfield for a Major League Rehab Assignment, starting tonight at Hammons Field. The 2019 Springfield Cardinal has gone 0-0 with a 4.80 ERA in 16 big league appearances since debuting with St. Louis on 7/26/20. He has been on the IL since 5/30/21.

On base in 18 of 22G in AA – .227 (15x66), 4 HR, 3 2B, 12 RBI, 14 BB... 3-hit game (3x4) on 5/28 @ WCH (tied career high)... Threw out three base stealers on 5/23 vs. NWA (3x3 CS)... Spent 2019 with Rookie-Level Johnson City (25 G, .219 AVG., .387 OBP, 4 2B, 1 3B, 5 HR, 14 RBI, 18 R, 18 BB)... Threw out 48.1% (13 CS/27 SB ATT) of attempted base stealers... First pro hit was grand slam in third career game (6th inn., 7/6/19)... first multi-HR game at Elizabethton (8/10/19), going 3x3 and adding a triple... 18th round pick in 2019 out of Middle Tennessee State... led Conference USA with 24 caught stealing in 2019... hit .249 with 12 HR, 62 RBI over three years at MTSU, leading team in walks (29), doubles (14), runs (36) and RBI (34) his junior season... Born in Caracas, VZ and is bilingual in English/Spanish... resides in Hollywood, FL

**LUKEN BAKER** – Previous road trip – .209 (9x43), 4 HR, 2 2B, 7 RBI, 9 R, 11 G... 6G hit streak, 5/29-6/4 – .318 (7x22), 2 HR, 9 RBI... 10 multi-hit games... First career grand slam in 1<sup>st</sup> on 5/30 vs. WCH... 7G hit streak (11x25), 5/18-5/26... Currently ranked as #14 STL prospect by MLB.com... Finished 2019 with a team-high 43 extra-base hits for High-A Palm Beach, including 5G with 2 2B...ranked among FSL leaders in 2B (2nd), XBH (3rd), BB (7th) and TB (7th)... Named STL MiLB Player of Month for May - .317 (26x82), 7 HR, 19 RBI, 3 2B, 13 R in 21G between SPR and High-A Peoria... 9G on-base streak to start AA career, 5/18-5/29 (14x36, 5 BB)... Currently ranked as #15 STL prospect by MLB.com... Played outfield and pitched at East Carolina University, batting .341 with 12 HR and 91 RBI over 116 games and going 13-5 with a 3.47 ERA in 137.2 IP (139 K), adding nine saves... played for 2019 Collegiate National Team... received 2019 USA Baseball International Performance-of-the-Year award for walk-off home run against Japan... three-time North Carolina 2A All-State Team (2015-17) in high school... struck out only eight times over final three years of high school baseball.

Currently ranked as #26 STL prospect by MLB.com... Played collegiately at South Alabama... Named 2017 Sun Belt Conf. Tournament Most Outstanding Player in 2017, batting .438 with championship-clinching walk-off single for Jaguars' first championship since their 2005 team, featuring David Freese... Hit .311, 15 HR, 41 2B, 7 3B, 19 SB in 173G at South Alabama... Born in Wurzburg, Germany and planned to play for Team Germany in 2020 World Baseball Classic Qualifiers prior to them being canceled due to COVID-19... 7<sup>th</sup> round pick in 2018 out of University of South Alabama

**NICK DUNN** – 6G hit streak, 6/17-25 – .389 (7x18), 1 HR, 1 2B, 3 RBI... Hits in 14 of last 18G – .283 (17x60), 1 HR, 2 2B, 6 RBI, 4 BB... first AA HR was solo shot in 2nd on 5/8 vs. WCH... Finished his first full pro season in 2019 with 29 multi-hit games and seven three-hit games for High-A PB... Had 11G hit streak with Peoria, 5/23-6/11 – .400 (18x45), 6 2B, 2 3B, 7 RBI... On base in 28 of 35G with Peoria (Hits in 25G)... Currently ranked as #13 STL prospect by MLB.com... Participated in 2020 STL Alternate Training Site at Hammons Field... Split 2019 between Low-A Peoria (.183, 5 RBI, 21 G) and Rookie-Johnson City (.254, 2 HR, 13 RBI, 37G)... Is 9th Wheaton Lyon in program history to sign a pro contract in baseball, with most notable alumni being OF Chris Denorfia (class of '02), who played 10 years of MLB (05-15) Raposo earned First Team All-State as a senior at Johnston (RI) Senior High School
