### So ABOUT SUNDAY...

The Arkansas Travelers always seemed to have a response to the Naturals offense, scoring each half inning after the Naturals did, and the Travs took game 6, forcing a series split with an 11-10 score.

- **MJ Melendez** capped a five-run third inning with his 13th home run of the season, a three-run shot to right field. He also singled in a run in the 5th.
- **Clay Dungan** went 2-for-5 with 2 runs scored, he tripled and scored in the seventh and scored again in the eighth.
- **Dairon Blanco** went 3-for-5 with a double and two runs scored. He nearly tied the game in the ninth inning, but was robbed in left-center field of what would have been either a home run or at least extra bases by Travelers CF Connor Lein.
- **Angel Zerpa** took the loss in his second start of the week, surrendering eight runs on eight hits over 3.0+ innings, striking out four.
- **Andres Nunez**, **Collin Snider**, **Nolan Watson** and **Carlos Sanabria** combined for six innings out of the bullpen, limiting the Travelers to three runs. Combined, the five pitchers struck out 13, including two from Sanabria in a 1-2-3 ninth.

### YOU WANNA SEE SOME REAL SPEED?

Through 45 games in 2021, the Naturals have stolen 69 bases.

- As a team, the Naturals are 69-for-98 (70%) in stolen base attempts... They lead **both the Double-A Central and all of Double-A**, eight ahead of the San Antonio Missions (San Diego AA), who have 61.
- **Dairon Blanco** is tied for the most in the Double-A Central and all of Double-A with 17 steals... Blanco is tied for 23rd in MiLB (Most: 31, David Hamilton, Wisconsin Timber Rattlers, MIL A+).

### HOMER HAPPY

Northwest Arkansas is one of the premier power teams in all of Minor League Baseball, with 67 home runs as a club in 45 games (1.5 HR/G).

- The Naturals have homered in 35 of 45 games this year (78%), including 18 in a row, between May 28 and June 18, the longest such streak in Double-A and tied fourth-longest in MiLB this season.
- 66 homers is the most in the Double-A Central and second in Double-A. It's 5th-most for a non-AAA team, 15th in MiLB... Also more homers than the Pittsburgh Pirates have this year (58).
- **Nick Pratto** and **MJ Melendez** are tied for the league lead with 13 homers, also tied for 2nd in Double-A and 10th in the minors.

### AND THEY WERE ROOMMATES!

First baseman **Nick Pratto** and shortstop **Bobby Witt Jr.** have been a dangerous 2-3 punch in the Naturals batting order and have a combined 196 total bases, 25 home runs and 65 runs batted in over 44 games.

- Combined, they average 4.45 total bases and 1.47 runs batted in per game, with a home run every 1.76 games.
- The duo of former first-round picks has hit back-to-back home runs three times this season, including three straight with MJ Melendez on Sunday, May 30th against San Antonio.
- They have homered in the same game four times this season.

### AVERAGE GUYS

As a team, Northwest Arkansas has hovered right around .500 all season.

- At best, the Naturals have been three games above .500: 5-2 after their win against Tulsa May 12... At worst, they have three times been two-games under .500, including 19-21 after Tuesday's loss.
- NWA has ended the day at .500 on 15 occasions and been within a game of .500 22 times... They've been at or within a game of .500 for 82% of the season (37 of 45 games), including 17 games and 20 days straight, between May 25 and June 14.

### BIG NICK ENERGY

After a down year at the plate in 2019, **Nick Pratto** has established himself as one of the top first basemen in all of the Minors in 2021.

- Among MiLB first basemen (min. 130 PA), Pratto ranks 2nd in OPS (1.036), home runs (13), total bases (98) and walks (32). He ranks 3rd in slugging percentage (.620), hits (45), triples (2) and RBI (33) among first basemen too.
- In the field, Pratto has proven to be one of the best defensive first basemen in the Minors too. He played every inning at first in the first 31 games of the season (267.1 innings) without an error.
- His 380.1 innings at first are the 7th-most of any player in MiLB at a single position, 2nd for first basemen... ***They are the most innings for any player that has not made an error yet.***
- His 354 chances are 3rd among all first basemen and the most chances for a 1B with a perfect 1.000 fielding percentage (next closest: 251 chances).

### EVERYDAY WE WITT

**Bobby Witt Jr.**, the consensus top prospect in the Royals' organization, and second overall draft pick in the 2019 MLB First Year Player Draft, begins his first full pro season in NWA.

- After hitting just .233 in May, Witt Jr. has been Northwest Arkansas' best player in the month of June, batting .326 (29-for-89) and leads the team in hits, total bases (55), triples (T-3), and runs batted in (10) this month.
- Witt Jr. is a .391 hitter (9-for-23) with a .440 on-base percentage and three home runs when leading off innings.
- Witt Jr. got his first taste of pro ball in 2019 with the Surprise Royals (rookie), recording 43 hits in 37 games, then
- Witt Jr. has made an impression each of the last two seasons in Big League Spring Training... In 2021, he hit .289 with three home runs and seven runs batted in over 14 games.
- Witt Jr. and his father (Bobby Sr.) are the ninth father-son duo selected in the first round of the Draft and the first to both be selected within the first three picks, the highest drafted father-son duo in Major League history.

### NO THOR-DINARY MANAGER

**Scott Thorman** takes the reigns of the Naturals for the 2021 season, the fifth manager in franchise history... Thorman, 50, held the same position with Wilmington (A+) in 2019, winning the Carolina League Championship with the Blue Rocks after capturing a South Atlantic League title with the Lexington Legends (A) in 2018.

- **Seven** 2021 Naturals were on the '18 and '19 teams with Thorman... Pitchers **Robert Garcia**, **Collin Snider** and **Nolan Watson**, plus hitters **MJ Melendez (C)**, **Dennicher Carrasco (INF)**, **Nick Pratto (INF)**, and **Brewer Hicklen (OF)**.
- **13 of the Naturals' 28 active players have previously played for Thorman in the Royals organization.**

### HISTORY WITH THE CARDINALS

Northwest Arkansas' .519 all-time winning percentage against the Springfield (201-186) is the Naturals' second-highest amongst any team in the Texas League/Double-A Central, behind their record against the Arkansas Travelers (.533, 194-170).

- 201 total wins is the most for the club against any one team.
- A .643 winning percentage in home games (126-70) is also the best all-time for the team.
- The Naturals' .416 winning percentage on the road (82-115) is third-worst, however, behind the club's road records against Midland (.292, 21-51) and San Antonio (.324, 23-48).

### NATURALS HARDWARE SHELF

**Three Naturals players have received league awards so far in 2021:**

- RHP Alec Marsh was the inaugural Double-A Central Pitcher of the Week (May 4 to 9) for his 5.0 hitless innings with 9 strikeouts against the Arkansas Travelers.
- 1B Nick Pratto was named the inaugural Double-A Central Player of the Month in May... He hit .310 and led the league in home runs (9), slugging percentage (.731), OPS (1.176) walks (19) and total bases (57). He ranked second in on-base percentage (.446) and fourth in runs scored (17) and runs batted in (17).
- LHP Marcelo Martinez was the Double-A Central Pitcher of the Week (week of May 31 - June 6) for his 5.0 innings of one-run ball with 9 K's against Tulsa. He threw an additional 1.1 innings with two strikeouts in the June 6th game against Tulsa that was suspended in the top of the 2nd due to rain.

**Nick Pratto and MJ Melendez were the Naturals' May Co-players of the month, announced by the Kansas City Royals Player Development on June 3rd... Jonathan Bowlan was Northwest Arkansas' May Pitcher of the Month from Kansas City's Player Development staff.**

- Lewis and his wife, Roslyn, reside in Charlotte, North Carolina, with their daughter, Skye and Son, Lake.



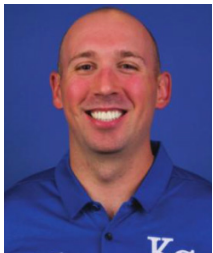
### #6 ABRAHAM NUNEZ • HITTING COACH
