HOOKS ENGINEER COMEBACK WIN: Stephen Wrenn's eighth-inning home run off St. Louis right-hander Carlos Martinez capped a late comeback Friday night as the Hooks beat the Cardinals, 5-3. CC is 3-0 on this Texas League North road trip and has won eight of the last nine games. Springfield lefty Genesis Cabrera held the Hooks to a pair of hits over the first six innings.

Trailing 3-0, Wrenn opened the seventh with a double down the left-field line. Carmen Benedetti was next and worked a walk. Abraham Toro then cracked a looping single into right field, scoring Wrenn. Toro went first to third on the play, and later crossed the plate on a grounder to second baseman Andy Young. Young made a wild throw to first base, helping the Hooks put two men in scoring position. Chas McCormick capitalized with a sharply-hit sac fly to right field to tie the game at 3. With Josh Rojas at third and one away, Ryne Birk hit a pop fly caught by catcher Andrew Knizner in foul territory. The Cardinals failed to call time after the out was made, prompting Rojas to charge home for the go-ahead run. Wrenn added insurance with a solo shot to right field in the eighth. It was his ninth home run of the year and his second off Martinez. Hooks starter Brandon Bielak was charged with two runs (one earned) on three hits in five innings of work. Bielak struck out five and walked two. The Cardinals started the scoring with a lead-off home run by Andy Young in the fourth. Later in the inning, John Nogowski reached on an infield single and, thanks to an error, scored on a double by Knizner. Kit Scheetz picked up his third save by striking out two in a perfect ninth.

SOARING HIGH: After last night's victory, the Hooks are now a season-best 30 games above .500 with an overall record of 76-46. Corpus Christi has the best overall record in Double-A.

The franchise's best overall record came in 2015, when the club went 89-51 overall under manager Rodney Linares. Linares won Texas League Manager of the Year.

STEPHEN LOVES SPRINGFIELD: OF Stephen Wrenn has been nearly unstoppable at Hammons Field this season. Wrenn went 2-4 on Friday night with a home run and 2 runs scored. Wrenn's solo homer came against St. Louis right-hander Carlos Martinez in the 8th inning.

In 4 games in Springfield this season, Wrenn is hitting .556 (10-18) with 4 home runs, 8 RBI, and 7 runs scored. The Marietta, GA native is batting .253 with 9 HR and 52 RBI this season.

AMAZING AUGUST ARMS: Corpus Christi's pitching staff owns a 2.85 ERA, .203 BAA, and 1.01 WHIP in 14 August contests, striking out 140 against 35 walks during the stretch.

The Hooks lead the Texas League in team ERA (3.38) and strikeouts (1,178).

TORO ON A TEAR: After IF Abraham Toro hit just .171 in 82 at-bats during July after joining the Hooks, he has bounced back in August. In 12 games during the month, Toro is batting .356 in 45 AB with 1 HR, 8 RBI, and 4 runs scored.

BATS COME ALIVE IN T-TOWN: The Hooks scored 10 runs on 12 hits in Tuesday's win at Tulsa and 6 runs on 10 hits in Wednesday's win. The 10 runs on Tuesday were the most scored by Corpus Christi since an 11-6 triumph over Midland on July 11.

In their series sweep of Tulsa last week at Whataburger Field, the Hooks scored just 9 runs on 18 hits during the 3 games.

DAWSON NAMED PLAYER OF WEEK: OF Ronnie Dawson has been tabbed Texas League Player of the Week, league president Tim Purpura announced Monday. Dawson went 9-for-20 with seven runs scored, one double, two home runs, and three RBIs this past week. The Grove City, Ohio, native was a triple shy of the cycle Saturday night against Springfield.

Selected by the Astros in the second round of the 2016 draft out of Ohio State, Dawson is hitting .333 with a 1.032 OPS in 12 games since being called up from the Carolina League. Of his 15 Texas League hits, seven have gone for extra bases: three doubles, one triple, and three home runs. He was tied for the Carolina League lead with 29 stolen bases at the time of his Double-A promotion.

CESAR TO DL: IF Randy Cesar has been placed on the 7-day disabled list, retroactive to August 11. Cesar was removed from Friday night's game after 2 at-bats. Cesar leads the Hooks with a .313 batting average in 103 games this season, collecting 10 home runs and 59 RBI.

ENCARNACION ARRIVES: The Astros have promoted 1B Luis Encarnacion to Corpus Christi from Tri-City of the New York-Penn League. Encarnacion is currently 0-6 with 3 strikeouts in 2 starts with the Hooks.

Encarnacion, signed by the Astros as a minor league free agent this past March, was hitting .204 with 7 home runs and 25 RBIs in 34 games for the Valley Cats. The 21-year-old out of San Juan de la Maguana, Dominican Republic, was released by the Phillies during spring training.
